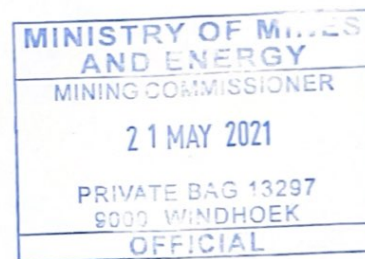

**APPLICATION FOR AN EXCLUSIVE PROSPECTING LICENCE No: 8290**

I refer to your above-mentioned EPL application lodged on 31 July 2020.

In terms of section 69(2)(c)(i) and (ii) of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act, No. 33 of the 1992, the Minister can only award the EPL if he is satisfied that the applicant has both the financial and technical resources to carry out the envisaged exploration activities.

To this end, we require a letter duly signed by the Managing Director of the applicant or the applicant's financier, in which the amount of money earmarked for this project is clearly stated. We further require proof from either the applicant or their financier, indicating that they have such amount of money in their accounts. This proof can, for instance, be in the form of a bank statement.

Regarding the technical resources, you are required to provide us with CV's of your experts who would be deployed to carry out the envisaged exploration program. These CV's should be accompanied by letters of consent from the same experts, indicating their willingness and availability to be part of the envisaged exploration activities.

This information should be submitted within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, failing which it will be assumed that you are no longer interested in this licence and the application will be refused.
