

# Swanu leadership dispute heads for mediation

Those involved in the ongoing leadership dispute of Namibia's oldest political party, Swanu, have decided to try and reach an amicable solution in their squabble.

"The parties believe that the matter can be settled and request that the case be referred to Court Connected Mediation," reads a joint status report by both parties.

Yesterday, Windhoek High Court Judge Thomas Masuku granted the order for the matter to be referred for mediation, scheduled for 27 February. The court ordered the parties to report to it on the outcome on 16 March.

In 2021, Swanu approached the High Court with claims Charles Katjivirue and his faction convened a national congress and elected themselves as leaders of the party,

contravening Swanu's constitution.

The disputed national congress took place on 21 August 2021, and Katjivirue was elected as party president.

The party claims Katjivirue, supported by fellow party members Alpha Kangueehi, Kairanderua Katjari, Katuu Tjingaete, Sam Tjikuzi, Patricia Tjaronda, former president Rihupisa Kandando, and Apolonia Kangueehi, had no authority to convene the congress as per party's constitution.

Swanu's current leadership, with the assistance of lawyer Edwin Coetzee, approached the court seeking an order to stop Katjivirue and his counterparts from their "unlawful conduct" of utilising the party's letterhead, emblems and colours - in their misinformation campaigns against the party. They also wanted Katjivirue and his group

to be restrained from holding themselves as elected office bearers of Swanu and may not elect the party from its offices situated on Rama Street, Katutura, Windhoek.

In their special plea, Katjivirue et al claim that those (the current leadership) who instituted a court case against them lack *locus standi* and authority to lodge the matter and

in addition to that, the party did not exhaust local remedies provided in its constitution.

They further claim the application does not make sense, as those who instituted it do not seek to set aside the outcome of the elections where they were elected but seek orders to stop them from performing their duties.

A 27-year-old man, who in a jealous rage stabbed to death his former ex-girlfriend and her boyfriend, was sentenced to serve 37 years imprisonment by the Oshakati High Court.

In sentencing, acting Judge Erich Kesslau said Patrick Shuya Mesho's actions were premeditated and fuelled by jealousy and spite. Kesslau sentenced Mesho to serve 30 years in prison for the murder of his ex-girlfriend Ronnica Mashale who was 24-years old at the time of her death on 1 February 2017. On the murder of Mashale's boyfriend, Fredi Jona (31), the court sentenced him to 25 years imprisonment.

On the charges of assault by threat and assault with the intent to do grievous bodily harm, the court imposed six months and two years imprisonment, respectively. The assault

charges are in relation to the attack he carried out on Kemba Elaine and Lafalaza Nalufu.

The court further ordered that the 18 years imposed on the second murder and those imposed on the two counts of assault, will be served concurrently with the custodial sentence imposed on the murder of Mashale. This gives a total of 37 years imprisonment.

"Considering that the crimes were premeditated, committed in the cruelest of manner, and without 'sacrificing the accused on the altar of deterrence', I am of the opinion that the accused is a danger to society and that a lengthy custodial sentence is appropriate,"

said Kesslau. According to Kesslau, Mesho did not show any remorse for his actions and his version had inconsistencies.

Last year, Kesslau convicted Mesho on two counts of murder, a count of common assault, and assault with the intent to cause grievous bodily harm. The incidences occurred in Katima Mulilo.

According to Mesho's statement, he denied guilt on the basis that, prior to the incident, he was under emotional stress as he had smoked cannabis and consumed traditional homebrew. He claimed that his memory was blank to a point where he has no

recollection until after his arrest later that day. Mesho further said that he and Mashale had a relationship and have been living together in her house. However, when he returned home after being away for some time, he found her in bed with Jona.

He was then informed by Mashale that their relationship was over, and that caused him 'sadness'. Moments later, he went to a certain bar in the area of the Cowboy compound where he found Mashale and Jona accompanied by a female friend Nalufu.

Mashale left to the back of the bar assumingly to visit the toilet when he followed her and stabbed her all over her body with a knife and returned to the front of the bar and started stabbing Jona on his head and back and seriously injuring him.

Witnesses testified, thereafter, Mesho once again disappeared to the back of the bar and found Mashale lying across the street.

It is indicated that she was wounded, lying face down and gasping for air, but that didn't stop Mesho from cruelly stabbing her again four times in the back.

Mashale died on the spot.

According to the witnesses, Mesho returned to the bar and started chasing customers who were trying to take Jona to the hospital. While others managed to escape, a certain "Flora" who was carrying a two-year-old child yelled at him, which prompted Mesho to turn on her and lifted the knife at her in a threatening manner, however, he stopped after Flora begged him.

He then again turned to Mashale's friend and stabbed her with the knife in her shoulder. Mesho was arrested thereafter.
