England: Bulgaria criticises plan to leave pitch over racist abuse

England players' plan to leave the pitch if they are racially abused during Monday's Euro 2020 qualifier in Sofia has been called "offensive" by Bulgaria's Football Union.

The game will be played in a partially closed stadium following Bulgaria fans' racist behaviour at games in June.

In a letter to European football's governing body Uefa, BFU president Borislav Mihaylov called England's plans "the unjust branding of local spectators as people inclined to discriminatory behaviour".

England forward Tammy Abraham said on Wednesday that the players are prepared to "all come off the pitch together" if they are "not bappy".

Bulgaria supporters were found guilty of racist behaviour against Kosovo and the Czech Republic in their Euro 2020 qualifiers.

Uefa ordered that 5,000 of the 46,340

seats at the Vasil Levski stadium in Sofia be blocked off for the game with England and 3,000 against the Czech Republic next month.

Mihaylov wrote: "The Bulgarian public has in no way committed any recent infringements that deserve it to be stereotyped as 'racist' or 'hostile'."

"I am sure you will agree that these accusations are not only unjust but are continuous attempts to disrupt the atmosphere before a very much anticipated game of football. "We are aware of the recent problems with racist behaviour in all tiers of English club football and with England's ongoing battle with hooliganism. "Although we sincerely applaud the FA's initiative for the English fans to report trouble within the visiting crowd, we are extremely shocked at all efforts to involve and even mark out the Bulgarian spectators as potential troublemakers."

England manager Gareth Southgate said last month that he would talk to his

players before the Bulgaria game.

Mihaylov added: "Following the communication with Greg Clarke (FA chairman) I was informed that Mr Southgate's concerns were mainly due to the fact that Bulgaria received a Uefa sanction for racist chants in 2011.

"Even though I view these comments as disregarding of all the work that the BFU has done over these eight years, I truly believed that our federation's immediate reaction would result in a more constructive handling of public and media matters in the eve of the game in Sofia."

Uefa's three-step protocol for racial abuse ends with the officials abandoning a match if announcements inside a stadium do not stop the problem.

In August, Bulgarian club sides PFC Levski Sofia and PFC Lokomotiv Plovdiv were punished by Uefa for racism during Europa League games.- BBC SPORTS

Black by popular demand: Isuzu reintroduces X-Rider Black

Port Elizabeth - Isuzu South Africa's limited edition D-Max X-Rider Black has been reintroduced to the market, but unlike the regular X-Rider - which made the transition from special edition to permanent fixture in the range - the Black edition will only be offered for a limited period.

Isuzu's product communications manager Nandi Matomela said: "the X-Rider Black was reintroduced for a limited period after high demand from customers since the run out of the previous edition".

As previously reported, the X-Rider Black edition is set apart by an exclusive 'Black Meet Kettle' exterior paint job, while the 18-inch alloy wheels, sports bar, side steps, front bumper guard and roof rails also follow the black theme, the latter also getting matt treatment. Essentially everything on the outside is painted black, except for the red Isuzu badges on the grille and wheel caps.

Same goes for the cabin, where black leather seats are contrasted with red stitching and the red Isuzu badge on the steering wheel stands out from

the dark grey dashboard with piano black trim elements, and you'll also find red 'X' badges on the inner door panels and 'X-Rider' logos embroidered on the headrests.

A 20.3cm touchscreen infotainment system with Bluetooth connectivity is fitted as standard, according to Isuzu. Safety kit includes dual front airbags (but no side and curtain airbags), ESC stability control with traction control and ABS brakes.

To make it a more affordable option than other sporty looking bakkies such as Ford's Ranger Wildtrak, the Isuzu D-Max X-Rider models are powered by Isuzu's 2.5-litre D-Teq turbodiesel, rather than the brawnier 3-litre unit. The 2.5-litre motor produces 100kW at 3400rpm and 320Nm from 1800 revs. The X-Rider Black also gets a factory fitted towbar and tonneau cover. As with other D-Max models, the edition is sold with a five-year/120 000km warranty, and five-year/90 000km service plan.

The Isuzu D-Max X-Rider Black is available only in 4x2 double cab guise, priced at R462 000.

New budget-car brand Mureza to debut in SA

Mureza will unveil its Prim8 crossover at the Automechanika trade show

A new budget car brand called Mureza is to make its South African debut at the Automechanika trade show at Nasrec's Expo Centre this week.

Isando-based Mureza Auto Company will unveil its first model, a hatchback called the Prim8 (pronounced Primate, a name the company might want to rethink). Powered by a 1.5l petrol engine, the car will have a target price of between R180,000 and R200,000 and will be sold with a three-year warranty.

Mureza also plans a half-ton pick-up, a sedan and high-riding mini-SUV off the Prim8's X100 platform, and the local development of a range of one-ton pick-ups and a panel van under the Tusker model name.

The Prim8 will initially be assembled from semi knock-down kits in Rosslyn, outside Pretoria, and later at the Willowvale assembly plant in Zimbabwe and in the former Hyundai plant in Botswana.

Despite its keen pricing, the range-topping version of the Prim8 crossover is to have a comprehensive specification list that includes cruise control, parking sensors, navigation, a reversing camera, four airbags, electronic stability control, ABS brakes and tyre pressure monitoring, among other features.

Mureza Auto Company is funded by backers in the UAE and has a joint venture with the Iran-based SAIPA Group for platform-sharing and the supply of components. The company plans to eventually design and manufacture vehicles locally.

The initial local content target is 40% with significant increases in the short to medium term, according to Mureza CEO Tatenda Mungofa from Zimbabwe, part of

a group of Africans from various countries who are driving the project.

He says Mureza models will be sold through used-vehicle outlets supported by online selling, instead of setting up new-car franchised dealerships. "SA is seen as the hub of the automotive business in Africa and it is for this reason that we are using this country as our headquarters and first assembly plant," said Mungofa.

"We are looking at co-operating with smaller component suppliers who are not yet able to handle big production runs and our business will help them grow their businesses.

"We are also looking for local entrepreneurs to get involved with the various facets of our business to give it a true African flavour."

He is looking to create up to 1,000 jobs at the Rosslyn plant with production to grow from 10 to 35 cars a day.

"Mureza means 'flag' and we want to be the flag wavers for an indigenous African motor industry. We want to be like Henry Ford who replaced horses with affordable cars. In our case it will be replacing imported used cars with affordable cars made in Africa," said Mungofa.

Thulisa Sosibo, co-founder of the company, says the Prim8 will go on sale here in the first week of December. She would not disclose the investment value of the new venture.

This year's Automechanika show runs until September 21, and is co-located with the Futuroad Expo of commercial vehicles and the Scalex logistics expo.

The show will display products and services of more than 600 local and international exhibitors from 27 countries. There will be a number of new trucks launched, including a new brand called Maz, a truck and machinery manufacturer from Belarus. -businessday
