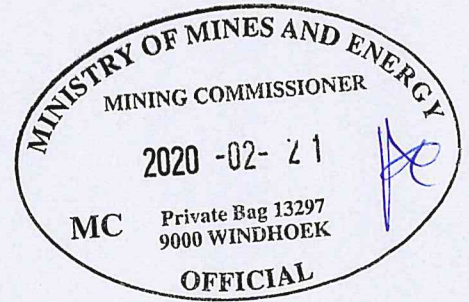

### 1. The environmental clearance certificate is for:

- Proposed Exploration / Prospecting and Possible Mining Activities in the Mining Claims (MCs) Nos. 71675-71684 Omaruru District, Erongo Region, North Central Namibia

#### Details of the activity(s) covered by the environmental clearance certificate.

Mining Claims (MCs) Nos. 71675-71684 holder intends to implement an exploration programme aimed at searching or prospecting for possible economic dimension stones groups (granite) within the MCs area for possible mining / quarrying. The exploration activities to be undertaken as assessed in this environmental assessment are as follows:

- (i) Initial desktop exploration activities;
- (ii) Regional reconnaissance field-based activities;
- (iii) Initial local field-based activities;
- (iv) Detailed local field-based activities including drilling of exploration boreholes, and;
- (v) Prefeasibility and feasibility studies to be implemented on a site-specific area if the local field-based studies prove positive. If the feasibility is positive, test mining and mining operations will be implemented covering construction, operation (mining and processing) and rehabilitation, decommissioning and final rehabilitation and aftercare.

**Title of Activity:** Proposed Exploration / Prospecting and possible mining activities for dimension stones in the Mining Claims (MCs) Nos. 71675-71684, Omaruru District, Erongo Region, North Central

**Nature of Activity:** Minerals exploration / prospecting and possible mining of dimension stone (granite).

**Location of Activity:** Mining Claims (MCs) Nos. 71675-71684 covers the western part and mountainous area of the Otjivero Communal land, Omaruru District of the Erongo Region, in the north-central Namibia.

**Scale and Scope of Activity:** The proposed sale of the exploration and possible mining will cover the following activities:

- (i) Initial desktop exploration activities (review of existing information and all previous activities in order identify any potential target/s in the MCs Area);
- (ii) Regional reconnaissance field-based activities such as regional mapping, aerial survey and existing data analysis and sampling to identify and verify potential targeted areas based on the recommendations of the desktop work undertaken under (i) above;

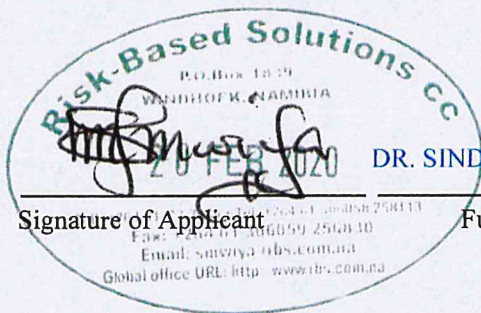
- (iii) Initial local field-based activities such as widely spaced geological mapping, sampling, surveying and possible trenching and drilling in order to determine the viability of any delineated local target;
- (iv) Detailed local field-based activities such very detailed geological mapping, trenching, bulk sampling, surveying, detailed drilling and laboratory test in order to prepare a feasibility report, and;
- (v) If the feasibility is positive, test mining and mining operations with a stone processing facility will be implemented covering construction, operation (mining and processing) and rehabilitation, decommissioning and final rehabilitation and aftercare.

The MCs allows the holder to undertake exploration and mining activities without applying for Mining License (ML). Once granted, the MCs will need to be renewed every two (2) years.

The scope of the field-based support and logistical activities will be dependent on the scale of proposed exploration and possible mining activities to be undertaken. The proposed exploration and possible mining activities will be supported by existing tracks and campsites / farmstead as well as existing accommodation in the local area as may be applicable. In the absences of existing tracks, the field team will create such new tracks with the permission of the land owner/s and depending on the scale of exploration / possible mining activities. In the absences of existing suitable campsite / farmstead, a temporary camp site will be setup at suitable locations in line with the EMP provisions within the MCs area. The size of the exploration / mining camp will be of very limited footprints during the exploration phase but may be expanded for the subsequent mine development phases in an event of a discovery.
