Bona 2027 facilities audit begins

SOUTH African facilities audit company Ruben Reddy Architects is running the rule over Botswana and Namibia's joint bid for the Africa Cup of Nations (Acon) 2027.

The team, led by Ruben Reddy, has already covered Gaborone, Lobatse, Francistown and Maun.

Its final destination is Kasane, which will be visited this week. Reddy says after Kasane, site visits will be over and they will look at the gap between Confederation of African Football (CAF) compliance and what is on the ground.

"We have done audits of all the sites. We will then come up with a report so that the gap is clear for everyone to see. We will attach costs to it so that the government and various ministries are aware of what funding is needed to meet those requirements. We will then visit Namibia, and that will complete

our task with the joint bid," Reddy says. Reddy says the existing gap is not a challenge, because there is still time to fix it.

He says he cannot divulge costs until the report has been completed.

There were gaps in other countries that hosted major competitions, such as the Fifa 2010 World Cup in South Africa, he says.

"From my experience I do not think we are dealing with impossibility here. It is possible. There are always state-controlled procurement systems. Those systems are run by people, and that can be changed," he says.

Botswana and Namibia bid committee chairperson Ashford Mamelodi says it is impossible for Botswana or Namibia to host Afcon alone due to the costs involved.
