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(GOAT) rivalry set for new chapter

ENCORE ... Lionel Messi and Cristiano Ronaldo will face each other again in an exhibition match tomorrow.

A NEW chapter in the celebrated rivalry between Cristiano Ronaldo and Lionel Messi will unfold tomorrow when they meet in an exhibition match as the Portugal forward gears up for his first game in Saudi Arabia since joining Al Nassr. After a glittering career in Europe that saw him win four Champions League titles with Real Madrid and two Scudettos at Juventus, Ronaldo signed for Al Nassr, describing it as the "right

moment" to share his experience in Asia. The Saudi club is the latest stop in Ronaldo's career that began in 2002 at Sporting CP before the forward spent two spells at Manchester United, the last of which ended on a bitter note as he exited following his acrimonious split with the club. Ronaldo and Messi, who have dominated football's debate about the greatest of all time (GOAT) for the best part of 10 years, will face off on the pitch tomorrow for the first time since December 2020 when Juventus beat Barcelona 3-0. Ronaldo will lead Riyadh ST XI, a team made up of players from Al Hilal and Al Nassr, against Messi's Paris St Germain in the exhibition contest where nothing is at stake, but fans are still excited by the prospect of watching the two stars clash.

The highly anticipated showdown, which will take place at the King Fahd Stadium in Riyadh, reportedly had more than two million online ticket requests. The bidding for a VIP "Beyond Imagination" ticket to the match has already topped 10 million riyals (about NS44.7 million) in an auction that was set to end yesterday. The game has also captivated fans as it comes just over a month after Messi helped Argentina win the 2022 World Cup, the missing piece in his vast trophy collection. Ronaldo also made headlines during the tournament, becoming the first player to score in five World Cups, but he ended up in tears after Portugal were knocked out in the quarter-finals by Morocco. While tomorrow friendly will be Ronaldo's first in Saudi Arabia, the 37-year-

old's first competitive appearance will come in the Saudi Pro League on Sunday when Al Nassr host Al Ettifaq. Last month, he signed a two and a half year contract with Al Nassr, estimated by media to be worth more than 200 million euros, but has had to wait to play because of a two-match ban by England's FA for knocking a phone out of a fan's hand in April. The exhibition game will also feature other key PSG players such as Kylian Mbappe, Sergio Ramos and Neymar, while Saudi internationals Salem Al-Dawsari, who scored in the shock group-stage win over Argentina, and Saud Abdulhamid will play too. French newspaper L'Equipe reported on Monday that PSG will earn just over 10 million euros (around NS182.3 million) for the game. -SuperSport

DELAY IN THE PAYMENT OF YOUTH SECURITY SERVICES (YSS) GUARDS DECEMBER SALARIES

1. BACKGROUND
The National Youth Service (NYS) would like to provide factual information and clarify issues concerning the delayed salary payments of YSS guards, which were due on the 15th of January 2023...

2. DELAYED SALARY PAYMENTS
YSS relies on remittances from its clients for income, and from which guards remuneration is paid. Up to mid-2022, the monthly pay date for YSS guards was the 10th. However, given the delays in payment of invoices by some clients, the date was changed to the 15th of each month...

3. PETITION
During this event, the guards seized the opportunity to present a wholesale petition to NYS management, of which feedback was subsequently provided. In response to the demands, the guards were advised that the issues raised in their petition are matters of negotiation and legal nature, which ordinarily should and will be addressed through appropriate fora.

4. CONCLUSION
NYS, on behalf of YSS, regrets the unfortunate delay of salaries occasioned by circumstances beyond our control. In the same vein, while we sympathise with our guards for the delayed salaries, YSS does not condone the illegal conduct of the guards, as it is contrary to the principles and values of the Service and in contravention of the relevant provisions of the country's labour legislation.

On the 12th of January 2023, YSS realised that the client payments received will not cover the full payroll of the guards, and as such, a notice was issued to the guards and their representative trade unions, informing them of the possible delay in the payment of salaries.

By Monday, 16 January 2023, 60% of the payroll had been collected with a remaining shortfall of 40%. Given this situation, the guards were given an option to either be paid 60% of their salaries or wait for the full salaries on the 18th of January 2023...

On the morning of Tuesday, 17 January 2023, the guards gathered at the NYS Head Office, demanding to be paid their full salaries. Despite their gathering, YSS was already in motion to collect the shortfall, which was secured the same day, however same was only transferred the next day, 18th January 2023.

On Wednesday, 18th January 2023, all salaries were processed and paid. The guards that bank with the same bank as YSS received their money the same day, while the rest received theirs the following morning.

It should THEREFORE be noted that the guards' salaries were not paid as a result of the guards illegal industrial action, nor did YSS deliberately withhold the guards salaries as alleged and speculated. The salaries were paid on receipt of payment of invoices by the clients, which in any event would have been paid on the 18th of January, albeit the unfortunate delay.

NYS, on behalf of YSS, regrets the unfortunate delay of salaries occasioned by circumstances beyond our control. In the same vein, while we sympathise with our guards for the delayed salaries, YSS does not condone the illegal conduct of the guards, as it is contrary to the principles and values of the Service and in contravention of the relevant provisions of the country's labour legislation.

Under the circumstances, NYS management and the Board wishes to extend their sincere apologies to paid-up clients and stakeholders, for the inconvenience caused by the illegal industrial action.

1. INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS
