The public consultation meeting was attended by 17 people, including one (1) environmental consultant and one (1) archaeologist from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS)- **Please refer to the attached attendance register.**

Note: *EPL 8981 covers Mining License 107*

1. INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

The meeting was opened by the environmental consultant by introducing the team and stating the purpose of the consultation meeting with the parties affected by the proposed prospecting and exploration activities on EPL 8981. The meeting attendance register was circulated for the attendees to sign and add their contact details, so that they could be added to the list of interested and affected parties (I&APs) and receive further information on the ESA process.

2. MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

2.1 Brief Description of the Project

Mr. Stefanus Johannes explained the EIA process to the attendees, and the reason for their invitation to the meeting (with reference to the Environmental Management Act (EMA) No. 7 of 2007 and its 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations on Public Consultation). Mr. Johannes further explained the importance for the proposed project of requiring an ECC and attendee's role in the EIA process.

2.3 Presentation of Potential Project Impacts

To ensure transparency towards the public and understanding of proposed works by the attendees, the Environmental Consultant also presented the pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts.

2.4 Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session)

Mr. Johannes provided the meeting attendees with the opportunity to raise their concerns/issues and/ or comment on the proposed project activities. The issues and comments recorded are presented in **Table 1** below.

Furthermore, Mr. Johannes informed the attendees that the draft meeting minutes, Environmental Assessment Report (EAR) and Environmental Management Plan (EMP) will be shared with them for their review and further comments. These documents will be made available through emails provided on the attendance register.

Once the review of the reporting is completed, the documents will be finalized and submitted to the Environmental Commissioner at the Department of Environmental Affairs and Forestry (DEAF) for evaluation and consideration for an ECC.

Issues and concerns against EPL Bid 8981 by Oa Ta Ra Development (Pty) Ltd (Proponent)

Introduction

Mrs A. Goussard (Owner, Farm Bloukrans) would like this opportunity to thank the representors of Excel Dynamic solutions for the friendly and professional manner they visited the farm with the two representatives of Farm Bloukrans (Theo Meyer and Willie Junius), to whom the owner of Farm Bloukrans gave full proxy to accommodate the visit.

For clarification regarding concerns the Owner would like to bring under attention that the Proponent is currently in possession of a mining licence within the EPL Bid 8981 area.

Some concerns and questions raised by Farm Bloukrans and other related to the EPL Bid 8981 were addressed during the community session held by Excel Dynamic solutions in Aussenkehr Community Hall, dated 18th April 2023. Several of these concerns were indicated during the visit to the Farm Bloukrans and were noted and recorded by both Farm Bloukrans representatives and Excel Dynamic Solution.

A summary of these concerns is addressed in the rest of the document and aims at giving a clear view from the Owner of Farm Bloukrans regarding the current situation and proposed EPL bid 8981.

Opposing points:

The Owner refers back to the background information document distributed by Excel Dynamic Solution under point 3.3.

Sewage

Mobile chemical ablution facilities will be provided on site. Sewage waste will be disposed of appropriately as per instructions of the facility manufacturer.

The proponent has not supplied adequate sanitary facilities to its workers since the farm was owned by the Goussard family. It is evident as workers toilet paper and plastic bags is lying around, and would indicate that the toilet facility is not used as intended. Furthermore, by the condition of the facility it would seem that little to no maintenance has been done since mining started in 2000 on the farm. No indications, logs or references of maintenance has been supplied. The owner foresees no change in the future regarding this behaviour, see fig. 1, fig. 2, fig. 3 and attached video 1.

Solid waste

Sufficient waste bins containers will be made available at exploration sites and campsites for waste storage and later disposal at the nearest approved waste facility.

Solid waste is lying around existing mining claim 107, refer to fig 4. The condition of the waste indicates that it has been exposed to weather elements for an extremely long time. They are mining since 2000 on farm Bloukrans and the owner foresee no change in this behaviour.

Positive impacts

Socio economic development: employment creation and transfer of skills

The Owner would like to take the opportunity to make a correction on the minutes send out to all affected parties the point was made by Theo Meyer (Bloukraans representative) and not Renaldo Brand on this point. We still stand on the point made on the minutes made.

We do not believe that the proponent has the ability to create any job opportunities and is only applying for EPL 8981 and EPL 8793 (EPL 8793 according to the mining portal pending ECC) to lock land and preventing any claim miners to mine for themselves.

Produce a trained workforce and small businesses in the area

The proponent is mining at this stage with hired diesel mining equipment with their own trained workforce which is already existing. To this fact the proponent in our opinion will not train operators for operating prospecting/mining equipment and will not train artisans for maintaining prospecting/mining equipment and will hire in an already existing trained workforce. We would also like to understand how the proponent will produce any small businesses in the area.

Deviations on the memorandum of agreement for prospecting or mining activities on mining licence 107 which the proponent is the holder of. This agreement is in terms of Section 52 of Act No. 33 of 1992: Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act 1992 (hereinafter referred to as the act)

1. The miner shall be granted access to and egress from the property and shall, wherever possible, make use of existing roads on the property. The miner is responsible for the upkeep of any existing roads used for mining purposes.

In Default of contract:

The proponent only once maintained the road used for mining purposes and used the farm owner's equipment without any consent. This road leads from farm Bloukraans through the Ais-Ais national park to the D0316. The road on the National Park side is in a horrible state.

2. The miner shall, in agreement with the owner, provide all employees with a visible means of identification. A maximum of six employees shall occupy the premises, unless otherwise agreed in writing. The miner will inform the owner as to the number of employees and/or contractor's work force which will be on the property

In Default of contract:

From the start of this agreement the proponent never provided employees with visible means of identification. On 24/04/2023 the proponent had a workforce of seven and including the contractor workforce. Notice was not given as in terms of the agreement the proponent has to compensate the owner.

3. The miner shall provide adequate sanitary facilities and such facilities shall be maintained in a hygienic condition.

In Default of contract:

The proponent does not supply hygienic facilities and toilet paper is lying around the badly maintained sanitary facilities.

4. The miner shall remove all refuse from the property to an indicated refused dumpsite as indicated by the owner.

In Default of contract:

Plastic bags and toilet paper are lying around and badly maintained sanitary facilities. Food cans is lying around old workings.

5. All claims should be marked clearly according to the act.

In Default of contract:

It was also noted by the representors of Excel dynamics that one mine marker is not maintained and was lying on the ground the markings on the board is also old and faded (see fig 5). The other three markers are not visible.

6. Employees of the miner and/or the Miners contractor shall not, except for the purposes of access or egress, proceed beyond the boundaries of the work/site area without the written authorization of the Owner.

Suspected Default of contract:

On Sunday 16th of April the Owner received a call from the owner's supervision employee on the farm Bloukrans and the employee reported there was an unknown vehicle on the farm moving between the owner's equipment. As the employee went closer to investigate the

vehicle drove away. The employee explained that the vehicle turned Onto the D0316 heading towards the B1 and he described the vehicle. The owner, who resides close by to the D0316 and B1 T-junction, immediately proceeded to the T-junction where a photo was taken of the vehicle to much surprise the person driving was MR H.M Bremmer who signed the agreement between the proponent and the land owner, the passenger could not be identified (see fig 6). As it was already late she only went to Bloukrans the next morning to follow the tracks to investigate where entrance was gained. Tracks were followed to the border fence of Middelpos where the fence was pushed down and driven over to gain access (see fig 7,8 & 9). GPS co-ordinates (GPS S 28°07'32,2" E 17°44'22,3") was taken at the place where the incident occurred by Excel Dynamics as well as coordinates GPS S 28°07'32,2" E 17°44'22,3".

7. Rehabilitation on completed claims must be affected immediately and without delay.

In Default of contract:

Old workings are still open and not rehabilitated. Flora is growing in the old pits which is a clear indication of how long these pits are open (see fig. 10 &11) where no rehabilitation has taken place.

8. Reporting - The miner will at the end of each month submit to the owner a report similar to the report sent to the mining office.

In Default of contract:

No report received to date from the start of the agreement.

Closing statement

The Owner and her late husband through employment took care of nine families on Farm Bloukrans through mining activities. Eight of the ten claims of her late husband, Deon Goussard were approved in her name, and she can now carry on the legacy of her husband in the community. The owner and these families are dependent on this income, where for some this is their sole income and livelihood. All of this will come into question if she cannot register any new claims in due future on Farm Bloukrans due to the registration of a proposed EPL.

The owner has already lost one claim on Farm Middelpos which her late husband prospected legally and claimed legally. When she wanted to register her claim she was informed by mines offices that permission is required from the EPL holder on Farm Middelpos, who is the same entity (the Proponent) with a mining licence currently on Farm Bloukraans and now applying for an EPL on almost the whole of Farm Bloukrans. The EPL holder (Oa Ta Ra) refused to sign of her claims on Middelpos. Compounding the distrust already from the owner's point of view is that the proponent never engaged into discussion with the owner regarding the EPL application or even consulting with her on Farm Bloukrans. The owner has no faith that future claims will be signed of if the proposed EPL is approved due to resistance already encountered.

The owner of Farm Bloukrans through legal representatives engaged an agreement for prospecting and mining activities with the proponent on his mining licence 107. This agreement was only signed by the proponent in November 2022 and the proponent had to compensate the owner a lump sump of the 5 months on which he mined after the death of her husband without consulting with her.

The owner of Farm Bloukrans submitted claims on the 11th of August 2022 and the proponent who is Oa Ta Ra, submitted an EPL application on the 29th of August 2022. This implies a very strong sign of attempting land locking and no consideration or fair competition on mining activities in the region. Furthermore, the

proponent already has mining rights on 1172 ha on Farm Bloukrans, of which only a small portion (+-10 hectares) has been prospected and mined on since 2000. In the minutes of Excel Dynamics Solutions, it is stated that the intention of the proponent will be small scale prospecting and mining. The accumulated area between the EPL on Middelpoos and the proposed EPL on Farm Bloukraans is +- 40000 hectares. This seems to be nothing more than land locking on Picture Jasper and Blue Agate found in these areas, if the proponent could only mine such a small portion since 2000. This has a direct influence on opportunities for both the owner and community and is counterproductive of royalty income towards the state on mining of minerals.

Surrounding current mining activities by the proponent on Farm Bloukrans, the owner is pursuing legal advice on giving notice to the proponent regarding deviations from the signed agreement between the parties. Along with this the owner is of opinion that the total disrespect of moving around on the farm by the proponent, the dishonouring of prospecting agreements, the disregard of the environmental, mining and prospecting acts will not change in future.

The owner of Farm Bloukrans thus strongly opposes the granting of EPL 8981 with the above in consideration.
