In accordance with: Heritage Impact Assessment conducted on Exploration Prospecting License (EPL) 7876, for the exploration of Base and Rare metals, dimension stones, industrial minerals and precious metals. It is located approximately 30km Northwest of Omatjete along the D2344 road to Uis in the Erongo Region.

The following conditions (imposed in terms of section 55(9) of the Act.) apply to this permit:

- a) Consent should be granted for EPL 7876
- b) A buffer zone of 100m is to be created and maintained around all burial sites found within the proposed EPLs.
- c) All burial sites which are not fenced off, should be properly fenced off.
- d) Proper community consultation should be done before the commencement of exploration activities with regards to the mountain in Ozondati in EPL 7876.
- e) As per section 55 (9) (a) the activity authorised by this consent is to be supervised by a person with appropriate professional qualifications or experience in the identification and conservation of heritage.
- f) The consent holder is to report back to the National Heritage Council every six (6) months on compliance with the conditions of this consent.
- g) This Consent does not exempt the holder from any conditions that may be imposed by owners, hosts or any other relevant authorities in consultation with NHC who have a stake in the project area.
- h) NHC shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities related to this permit.
- i) This Consent is subject to the provisions of the National Heritage Act (Act 27 of 2004). Should any of the conditions contained herein conflict with the Act; the provisions of the Act as per section 55 (10) shall prevail.
- j) Adopt the Chance Find Procedures.
- k) This consent is renewable, upon submission of an application at least two months before the current permit lapses
