This Ministry reserves the right to attach further legislative and regulatory conditions during the construction and operational phase of the project.

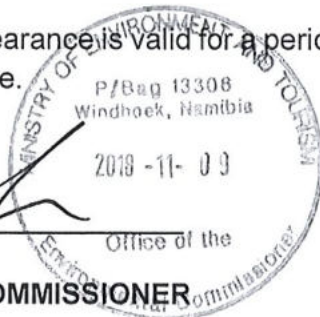
