RE: RENEWAL OF ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR THE PROPOSED ESTABLISHMENT OF CLAY PROCESSING FACILITIES FOR CERAMICS, POTTERY WARE, AND BRICKS AT TONORO VILLAGE (KAVANGO WEST REGION), IOMA (ZAMBEZI REGION) AND IHEKE YA NAKELE (OSHANNA REGION).

The Ministry of Mines and Energy hereby requests your esteemed Ministry to renew the environmental clearance certificates for three project sites in Kavango west, Zambezi and Oshana regions for the purpose of establishment of clay processing facilities for ceramics, pottery ware and bricks.

Environmental clearance was granted previously in 2015 with the assistance of environmental consultants; Urban green (see attached certificates granted for the period of three (3) years). projects. We therefore request your Ministry to renew the certificates in order to allow implementation to commence.

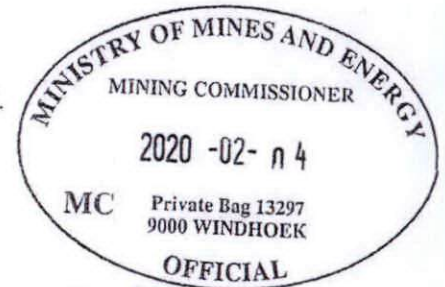
Kindly take note that the certificates should be addressed to the Ministry of Mines and Energy and not to the Ministry of Works and Transport as was previously done.


