

Exécutive summary

This report has assessed the archaeological and heritage implications of the proposed development which is located approximately 20 kilometres (km) near Uis in the Erongo Region. This study was conducted as part of the specialist input for the Environmental Application process i.e. Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) and thus, which will serve to inform the Environmental Scoping Assessment Report (ESA) and Environmental Management Plan (EMP) for the proposed project.

The site visits were conducted on the 28th of March 2023, and the following issues were identified from an archaeological and heritage point of view;

Grave and burial sites: As reported herein, graves and burial places were recorded !Aemas Bank Village only, the recommended measures are put in place to ensure graves, burial places and associated features are preserved in-situ and no disturbance should occur near or within these sacred places of cultural and social significance.

Rock outcrops and boulders: Interesting and unique features were recorded where granitic boulders and outcrops are located, from archaeological and heritage points of view, these features are important in understanding the past landscape utilization in its entirety, and thus the recommendation made here is to protect them in-situ and preserved in their natural state as they are.

In summary, it is the Author's considered opinion that the overall impact of the proposed project on archaeology and heritage resources is expected to be low given the fact that the adherence to the recommendations made herein, and implementation of chance finds is incorporated into the project environmental and management plan. Nonetheless, the Project Proponent is made aware of how to properly protect and preserve the visible archaeological materials, and heritage resources of the area. Also, the Project Proponent is advised to be cognizant of the provisions of the National Heritage Act, No 27 of 2004 regarding the prompt reporting of archaeological finds including the adoption of "Chance Find Procedures".

Therefore, it is recommended that the proposed development should comply and adhere to the conditions that the recommended mitigation measures put forth herein

(Section 16.2), and strictly Chance Find Procedures are implemented as part of the EMP and based on approval from the Authority. The recommended mitigations contained herein are for Archaeological and Heritage Impact Assessment only, nonetheless authorization applies and the proposed development project may only proceed based on the review and ultimately the approval from the National Heritage Council of Namibia.
