**ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING ASSESSMENT (ESA) FOR THE PROPOSED MINERAL EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES ON EXCLUSIVE PROSPECTING LICENSE (EPL) NO. 8506 LOCATED NORTHEAST OF UIS SETTLEMENT IN THE ERONGO REGION, NAMIBIA**

**PROJECT PROPONENT: CODEBREAK INVESTMENTS (PTY) LTD**

**Date:** Tuesday, 01 November 2022

**Time:** 13h30

**Venue:** Farm /Khomxadare Gathering Tree (inside the EPL), Daure-Daman Traditional Authority



The Consultation Meeting was attended by thirty people (30) people, which included representatives from the Daure-Daman Traditional Authority, Erongo Regional Council (Daures Constituency and Uis Settlement offices), some community members from the farms covered by the EPL, and three Excel Dynamic Solutions (EDS) Consultants. The signed attendance register is **attached hereto**.

**INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS**

The meeting was officially opened with a prayer by a member of the community and welcoming done by Ms. Fredrika Shagama (EDS Environmental Consultant). The Secretary of the Daure-Daman Traditional Authority, Ms. Adelma Uises and Mr. Mauritius Goseb (from the Constituency Office) provided translations from English to Nama-Damara Language and vice-versa throughout the meeting.

The printed copies of the Background Information Document (BID) and meeting attendance register were circulated for self-reading and the attendees to register (for addition into the list of interested & affected parties (I&APs)), respectively.

## MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

- **Explanation of what an ESA is, its Process and the Public Role in the Process:** The purpose of the meeting was given to the attendees with reference to the Environmental Management Act (EMA) No. 7 of 2007 and its 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations on Public Consultation. Ms. Shagama further explained what an ESA is and that the proposed exploration activities are one of the listed activities in the 2012 EIA Regulations of the EMA that cannot be undertaken without an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) from the Environmental Commissioner. She further clarified that the Proponent (Codebreak Investments) has not been granted the rights to explore in the area yet, pending an ECC. Therefore, the Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) has only gave the Proponent a provisional grant (intention to grant the license).
- **Brief Description of the Project:** Ms. Shagama informed and showed meeting attendees the area covered by the EPL, i.e., the !Aemas, /Haruxa-Ams and /Khomxadare Farms of the Daure-Daman Traditional Authority. She further presented a summary of the proposed prospecting and exploration methods and stages to give the attendees an idea of what the project will entail. She also indicated that the Proponent applied to be granted for the rights to prospect & explore for Base & Rare Metals, Dimension Stone, Industrial Minerals, and Precious Metals as per the EPL potentials on the mining cadastre portal which is accessible here <https://portals.landfolio.com/namibia/> upon entering the EPL number and click "search".
- **Presentation of Potential Project Impacts:** The Environmental Consultant (Ms. Shagama) also presented the potential pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts associated with the proposed project activities.
- **Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session):** After the Environmental Consultant's presentation, the meeting attendees were given an opportunity to raise their concerns/issues and or comments for consideration in the Environmental Assessment Report and its Environmental Management Plan (EMP). The issues and comments recorded are presented in **Table 1** below.

Once they find economic feasible commodities, they would then continue to apply for a mining license before mining.</p> <p>-(b) Yes, there will be opportunities for the locals for the work they are capable of.</p> <p>-(c) The exploration duration depends on many factors such as preparatory arrangements (paperwork), investments/funds availability, time required to test samples and provide results from each stage (mapping, soil sampling, trenching, and drilling), etc. Exploration for copper and gold for instance can even take up to 7 years or more.</p>

	<p>Proponent spending money to search for commodities and possibly not much for socio-economic. Therefore, these seem unrealistic.</p> <p>-(b) A critical analysis needs to be done on the negative impacts, for instance there are archaeological sites on Farm !Aemas.</p>	<p>However, we believe the positive impacts can still come from exploration, even if it is at a small-scale level to improve the community lives through some social plan. For instance, locally owned SMEs can be hired to clear exploration sites, procure services such as waste removal and even catering services to the exploration team and other goods and services required onsite.</p> <p>-(b) Usually the Ministry of Mines and Energy does not issue the rights to mine or explore the same commodity groups for an EPL owner and mining claim holder. **Conclusion and Closing Remarks by Environmental Consultant (EDS):** Ms. Shagama thanked the attendees for their crucial input through comments and raising their concerns. She indicated to the attendees that all their comments, concerns and inputs had been noted down for consideration and addressing in the Environmental Report and EMP.

Furthermore, Ms Shagama informed the attendees that the Meeting Minutes will be prepared and shared for review and further questions/ comments. The details of the next meeting will be communicated via the Traditional Authority and Daures Constituency office for timely radio announcements.
