

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

The Consultation Meeting was attended by thirty people (30) people, which included representatives from the Daure-Daman Traditional Authority, Erongo Regional Council (Daures Constituency and Uis Settlement offices), some community members from the farms covered by the EPL, and three Excel Dynamic Solutions (EDS) Consultants. The signed attendance register is **attached hereto**.

INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

The meeting was officially opened with a prayer by a member of the community and welcoming done by Ms. Fredrika Shagama (EDS Environmental Consultant). The Secretary of the Daure-Daman Traditional Authority, Ms. Adelma Uises and Mr. Mauritius Goseb (from the Constituency Office) provided translations from English to Nama-Damara Language and vice-versa throughout the meeting.

The printed copies of the Background Information Document (BID) and meeting attendance register were circulated for self-reading and the attendees to register (for addition into the list of interested & affected parties (I&APs)), respectively.

MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

- Explanation of what an ESA is, its Process and the Public Role in the Process: The purpose of the meeting was given to the attendees with reference to the Environmental Management Act (EMA) No. 7 of 2007 and its 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations on Public Consultation. Ms. Shagama further explained what an ESA is and that the proposed exploration activities are one of the listed activities in the 2012 EIA Regulations of the EMA that cannot be undertaken without an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) from the Environmental Commissioner. She further clarified that the Proponent (Codebreak Investments) has not been granted the rights to explore in the area yet, pending an ECC. Therefore, the Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) has only gave the Proponent a provisional grant (intention to grant the license).
- Brief Description of the Project: Ms. Shagama informed and showed meeting attendees the area covered by the EPL, i.e., the !Aemas, /Haruxa-Ams and /Khomxadare Farms of the Daure-Daman Traditional Authority. She further presented a summary of the proposed prospecting and exploration methods and stages to give the attendees an idea of what the project will entail. She also indicated that the Proponent applied to be granted for the rights to prospect & explore for Base & Rare Metals, Dimension Stone, Industrial Minerals, and Precious Metals as per the EPL potentials on the mining cadastre portal which is accessible here https://portals.landfolio.com/namibia/ upon entering the EPL number and click "search".
- **Presentation of Potential Project Impacts:** The Environmental Consultant (Ms. Shagama) also presented the potential pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts associated with the proposed project activities.
- Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session): After the Environmental Consultant's presentation, the meeting attendees were given an opportunity to raise their concerns/issues and or comments for consideration in the Environmental Assessment Repot and its Environmental Management Plan (EMP). The issues and comments recorded are presented in Table 1 below.

1.	Mr. Mauritius Goseb: I am concerned about the poor meeting representations of some community members from the other two farms/villages. Since, the Proponent is also not here today, maybe we should ensure that the other community members are also well represented and give their views on the project.	Ms. Fredrika Shagama (EDS Environmental Consultant): Noted. The meeting invitation was communicated, but we have taken note of this, and we will try again and do better in the next meeting.
2.	Mr. M. Amingo Honneb: (a) The Xinfeng Mining Company operating just east of here, came like they are doing exploration but the next thing we are hearing they are mining. There are many trucks transporting materials that what we are made to think that they are samples. Will Codebreak not do the same? -(b) Will there be job opportunities for the locals? -(c) What is the timeframe for the prospecting and exploration works?	 Ms. Fredrika Shagama: (a) We cannot really speak for Xinfeng as we are not fully aware of their operations, and if they are wrongly mining on an EPL or not. However, for Codebreak, we believe that they will do the right thing by exclusively conducting prospecting and exploration activities on this EPL. Once they find economic feasible commodities, they would then continue to apply for a mining license before mining. -(b) Yes, there will be opportunities for the locals for the work they are capable of. -(c) The exploration duration depends on many factors such as preparatory arrangements (paperwork), investments/funds availability, time required to test samples and provide results from each stage (mapping, soil sampling, trenching, and drilling), etc. Exploration for copper and gold for instance can even take up to 7 years or more.
3.	Mr. Mauritius Goseb: (a) There is also a concern on the potential. positive impacts of the EPL because usually this is more of the	Ms. Fredrika Shagama : (a) You are right that exploration phase is more of the Proponent spending money to get little to nothing.

No.	Comment / Issue / Question or Concern	Name of Responder & Response:
	Proponent spending money to search for commodities and possibly not much for socio-economic. Therefore, these seem unrealistic. -(b) A critical analysis needs to be done on the negative impacts, for instance there are archaeological sites on Farm !Aemas.	However, we believe the positive impacts can still come from exploration, even if it is at a small-scale level to improve the community lives through some social plan. For instance, locally owned SMEs can be hired to clear exploration sites, procure services such as waste removal and even catering services to the exploration team and other goods and services required onsite. -(b) Usually the Ministry of Mines and Energy does not issue the rights to mine or explore the same commodity groups for an EPL owner and mining claim holder. This is probably to avoid conflicts. The problem is mainly just commitment and implementation from most proponents or project owners.
4.	Mr. M. Amingo Honneb: If the Proponent gets the ECC and associated paperwork to explore in the area, can the community come up with a "shopping list" or proposals of what they would like to be assisted with while Codebreak is conducting works in the area? And can the Traditional Authority also be assisted in some way for their office, for instance? We will need Codebreak to clearly indicate this to us.	Ms. Fredrika Shagama : The Proponents will need to draw up a Social Plan in a form of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) even if they are just exploring. There should be something that they can assist the communities with, even if it is small, but significant.
5.	Mr. Hans Tsaraeb: Is there a possibility that directly affected people (farmers) will need to be relocated for safety and health reasons?	Ms. Fredrika Shagama: (a) This is unlikely during the exploration phase but, should the work advance to the mining license stage (for the actual mining), the existing lawful procedures for relocation of affected communities will be followed prior to relocation.

6.	 Mr. Mauritius Goseb: The issue of exploration trenches, I would like to request the Proponent to ensure that the disturbed areas are rehabilitated as far as possible because some exploration people leave open trenches which is unsafe. Furthermore, a Trust Fund or an Insurance Policy Account should be created for the Proponent to put a certain percentage aside for rehabilitation after exploration. A committee that includes Traditional Authority should be set up to oversee this proposal The condition is that the EPL should be granted, and Rehabilitation Fund is established soon after and prior to the work. 	Ms. Fredrika Shagama: (a) This is noted. We will also incorporate this into the EMP (under social management)
7.	 Traditional Councillor Hanna !Awaras: (a) Codebreak should come talk to the communities and properly consult to engage the communities directly. The next meeting should be communicated again well in advance with the Traditional Authority and Office of the Constituency Councillor for announcements. (b) The meeting re-arrangement can be done to still have one meeting. It just needs to be properly communicated to hold it in the afternoon. 	Ms. Fredrika Shagama: Noted, Honorable.
(a)	Mr. Mauritius Goseb: My recommendation is that Codebreak should come meet the people in the area. The time and venue should be communicated, as mentioned by Traditional Councillor Araes. The three village communities can still meet at the same place. However, you should also revise the time of the meeting	Ms. Fredrika Shagama: Noted, Mr. Goseb. We will do that.

<u>Conclusion and Closing Remarks by Environmental Consultant (EDS)</u>: Ms. Shagama thanked the attendees for their crucial input through comments and raising their concerns. She indicated to the attendees that all their comments, concerns and inputs had been noted down for consideration and addressing in the Environmental Repot and EMP.

Furthermore, Ms Shagama informed the attendees that the Meeting Minutes will be prepared and shared for review and further questions/ comments. The details of the next meeting will be communicated via the Traditional Authority and Daures Constituency office for timely radio announcements.

The meeting was adjourned at 15h40.
