<u>Re: Renewal of Environmental Clearance Certificate for Okatji Marble's Mining Claims</u> 65425 and 65426 and Existing Mining operations

Okatji Marble CC obtained their Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) dated 25 April 2017 (Annexure A) for the Mining Claims 65425 and 65426 and existing mining operations. The ECC is valid for three years (until 2020) and as such Okatji Marble has appointed GCS Water and Environmental Engineering to apply for the renewal of the ECC.

Okatji Marble cc (Okatji Marble hereafter) currently runs marble mining operations on Mining Claims 65425 and 65426, 12 km east of Karibib in the Erongo Region (see Annexure B for locality). The mining claims are located on Okatjimukuju, Farm 55, part of which is located within the Non-Exclusive Prospecting License 3269.
