Brazil star Dani Alves must remain in custody — court

Barcelona — Former Barcelona and Brazil star Dani Alves will remain in custody pending his trial for allegedly raping a woman as he is considered a high flight risk, the Provincial Court of Barcelona decided on Tuesday.

"There is an elevated risk of absconding, linked on the one hand to the high sentence that could be imposed because of the present case, the serious evidence of criminality against him and large financial resources that would allow him to leave Spain at any time," the court said in a statement.

The court believe taking the 39-year-old's passport would not prevent him from leaving Spain "by air or sea or even by land without documentation."

If he were to return to Brazil, his homeland, the court believes he would not be handed over to Spain as the South American country does not usually extradite its citizens.

The public prosecutor's office opposed his release.

On 2 January, a young woman alleged that Alves had raped her in the bathroom of a nightclub in Barcelona at the end of December.

The player, who initially denied knowing her, changed his story several times but later said they had consensual relations, according to sources close to the case.

Alves is on trial for the alleged crime of sexual assault - which in the Spanish penal code includes rape.

The investigating judge ordered on 20 January that he be remanded in custody without bail, taking into account, among other things, the contradictions in his initial statements and the high risk of absconding.

Alves was sacked by his club Pumas Unam in Mexico after his arrest.

In a highly successful career, Alves made 408 appearances for Barcelona, with 391 of those coming in his first spell from 2008-2016.

During that initial stint, he won six La Liga titles, three Champions League crowns and four Copa del Rey trophies.

At last year's World Cup in Qatar he became the oldest player to represent Brazil at football's showpiece tournament.

According to him, the move can be an example to other neighbouring countries to achieve the same goal in the future for free movement of people and goods.

Opelo said the agreement demonstrates the unwavering commitment of the two governments in implementing a uniquely progressive aspect of the strategy of bilateral cooperation between the two countries.

"The agreement will thus serve to eliminate barriers to the free movement of people, goods, and services thereby strengthening trade between the two neighbouring countries," he said.

"As member states of the Southern African Development Community (SADC), this agreement between Botswana and Namibia will also contribute to the objective of the SADC treaty which calls on SADC member states to develop policies aimed at the progressive elimination of obstacles to the free movement of people, goods and services."

Additionally, Opelo noted that the use of national identity cards for cross-border travel will enhance the momentum for economic and regional integration and further promote safe and orderly migration.

"This development will become even more impactful on people's lives as Mamuno/Trans-Kalahari border post attains a full-fledged status of a one-stop border post operating on a 24-hour basis currently," he added.

The MOU will further foster social cohesion among the citizen of the two nations who share profound historical, cultural and economic bonds in addition to the values of democracy, self-determination as a people, human rights, peace, rule of law and good governance, amongst others.

Namibia and Botswana's agreement forms part of the broader African Agenda 2063 which aims to remove barriers to Africans' freedom of movement, employment, and residence on their continent, which is the free mobility of Africans within it.

letter with their demands to the health ministry, but received no response.

This was before their latest attempt through the labour ministry.

According to the spokesperson of the volunteers, Isai Festus Shakua, they have tried engaging Nangombe’s office through a letter in which they had set out their demands. This, he says, was after the volunteers’ contracts ended last year in December after a month’s extension.

“We visited the Ministry of Labour and submitted our complaints against the Ministry of Health and Social Services, and a meeting is to be set up between the volunteers and the ministry in a month’s time of which this matter should be addressed and both parties reach a proper solution,” he said.

“The Ministry of Health and Social Services continues to recruit some volunteer workers and leave others behind,” Shakua said, stressing that their main demand is for all of them to be employed permanently.


