## 4. PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Premises shall be solely utilised for general warehousing, handling of international cargo (for exports and imports) and handling metals and minerals (in breakbulk) such as (but not limited to) Copper Cathodes, Anodes, Concentrate, Blisters, Cobalt Hydroxide, Fertilizer in bags, Sulphur in bags, Magnesium Oxide, Sodium Metabisulphite, Sodium Hydrosulphide, and Caustic Soda (all bagged) (hereinafter the "Business") and for no other purpose whatsoever, unless the Landlord's prior written consent is obtained:

The minerals that will come from Zambia, Botswana, DRC will be transported by trucks. The cargo will be offloaded and stored in the Rubbhalls to safeguard the cargo.

Most of the minerals will be loaded in containers and exported by ship, but Copper Concentrate can be shipped out in bulk.

This operation will start with the bleeding of the copper concentrate bags in the tipper truck; bleeding will happen in the warehouse to prevent contamination of the environment. Once the tipper truck is fully loaded, the tipper will be covered with a Tarpaulin to prevent spillage.

This truck will shunt the bulk from the warehouse to the vessel, where the cargo will be loaded on board.

Project cargo will be mostly coming out of the vessel, since this cargo comes in different varieties and sizes it is difficult to describe the process. Most mining equipment will be stored outside since it is big in size.

Chemicals will be mostly imported from other continents. This cargo is bagged and will be stored in the covered warehouse. The chemicals will be loaded on trucks, these trucks must be equipped with the necessary signs before loading.

We adhere to the regulations of handling the chemicals to protect our employees and the environment. No open fire and smoking are allowed on the premises, and this will be indicated with the necessary signage.

## 5. REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW PREMISES

#### 5.1. Premises

Reload's premises in Namport will be 12.767 SQM. We will erect 2 Rubbhalls of both 1000 SQM on the premises.

We will level the lower laying part of the premises to make space for future constructions. The ablution block will be renovated for the staff and a container office will accommodate the office staff. A security house will be installed at the entrance to have visibility on the incoming trucks and personnel.

Our current staff of thirteen employees will be increased with a minimum of 8 employees once the warehouse is operational.


