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## 1. PUBLIC CONSULTATION PROCESS

### 1.1 Introduction

Public Participation Process (PPP) is an integral part of the EIA process as outlined in Section of 27(1) (h) of the Environmental Management Act and Section 32 of Environmental Assessment Regulations. This was also one of the requirements of the EIA scoping as specified by the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism (MEFT) for the gravel extraction for road building and backfilling materials by Smart Plant Rental (SPR) on the Farm Triangle No. 47 situated on the outskirts of the City of Windhoek.

Generally, the public participation process is a platform which affords an opportunity to the stakeholders, who are classified either as Interested or Affected Parties (IAP's) to the proposed development. Through the PPP, such IAPs are given an opportunity to express their views, comments and or to voice any concerns which they might have with regard to the proposed development. In broader terms, the objectives of the public participation are, amongst others the following:

- ✚ To increase awareness and public confidence and in so doing to maximize benefits and minimize risks.
- ✚ To ensure transparency and accountability in decision-making and therefore less conflict, since decisions to undertake development projects are deemed to have been made through consensus.
- ✚ To secure approval from stakeholders which gives some form of assurance and a sense of partnership with the envisaged project and prevents unnecessary disputes and costs associated with litigations.

### 1.2 Greenfield Operation

It was evident during the field observations that gravel extraction had taken place along the banks of the KWR as on Farm Triangle #47 in the past. However, the project proposed by SPR is a greenfield operation in the sense that the extraction will be confined to secondary gravel deposited (the oldest gravel) on the higher elevations than the present day river channel. Extracting a maximum of 10 000 m<sup>3</sup>, the proposed gravel extraction is quite small. The public consultation process was therefore conducted with that understanding in mind.

## 2. PROJECT ANNOUNCEMENT

The project was announced as described below:

### 2.1 Newspaper Adverts

The project and the EIA process were announced in the local newspapers on the dates as shown in **Table 1** below in line with the provisions of EMA.

## 2.2 EIA Notices

In addition to newspaper adverts, written notices/posts were also prepared and printed on an A3 paper and placed at the entrance to Farm Triangle as shown in **Figure 1**.

## 2.3 Registration for the EIA

IAP's were also asked to register for the EIA and to request for the Background Information Document (BID) on the project from the EIA Consultant. Only two persons registered for the EIA and were provided with a BID. The names and communication held with those who responded to the EIA are attached as **Annexure 1**.

## 3. IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY STAKEHOLDERS

One of the objectives of the PPP is to identify all possible stakeholders to the EIA. Listed in **Table 2** below, are the names of public officials representing Organs of State who have a direct bearing to the listed activity being assessed.

Neighbouring farms were not consulted for the following reasons:

- The gravel extraction site is located on Farm Triangle 47 and there are no people living within a radius of at least 4 km of the gravel extraction site.
- The gravel extraction is not confined to the banks of the KWR but to the secondary gravel deposited up steep away from the river.
- The scale and scope of the extraction of 10 000 m<sup>3</sup> per year is not expected to have any impacts on neighbouring farms.

Hello Joel,

Thank you for the BID, I appreciate it.

My major concern is what impact this activity will have on trees on the floodplains and riparian fringe of the river. Although they expect the abstraction to be limited, in effect, once these activities begin they seldom remain so constrained. The cumulative effects of this type of mining are starting to be of concern. My feeling is that a vegetation study should be done to delineate no-go areas for now and in the future, as well as to contribute to the EMP. Most of these enterprises think that if they leave a small cone of sand around the base of a tree it will survive, which is not the case. This needs to be addressed in the EMP, and it will best be done by on-the-ground mapping.

# Five players to watch at the women's Rugby World Cup

The women's Rugby World Cup begins Saturday in New Zealand with the hosts and England, who are on a record 25-match winning streak, among the favourites.

AFP Sport highlights five players to watch in the tournament which ends on 12 November:

### Portia Woodman (NZL)

The 31-year-old wing bagged seven tries in New Zealand's 95-12 warm-up drubbing of Japan.

Japan couldn't get close to the flying Woodman, nor could her teammates. "It's tiring trying to keep up with her," said Black Ferns captain Ruahei Demant.

The daughter of former All Black Kawhena Woodman, she scored 13 tries when New Zealand won the 2017 Rugby World Cup, eight of them in a 121-0 thumping of Hong Kong.

Woodman won rugby gold with New Zealand at the Tokyo Olympics and became the first woman to reach 200 tries in the World Sevens Series.

### Emily Scarratt (ENG)

The 32-year-old centre or full-back will be playing her fourth Rugby World Cup, having recovered from a broken leg last September to be top scorer in this year's Six Nations, with 39 points.

She warmed up for New Zealand with two tries in a 73-7 demolition of Wales in England's final warm-up match.

A talented all-round sportswoman, she once turned down a US basketball scholarship and made her England debut in 2008 after leaving school and was named World Player of the Year in 2019.

Scarratt scored 16 points when England won the 2014 Rugby World Cup final against Canada.

### Jasmine Joyce (WAL)

The 26-year-old wing has pace to burn and dazzling footwork, as she proved in impressive performances for Great Britain at the Tokyo Olympics.

Joyce scored tries in the quarterfinal win over the US and semifinal defeat to France as Britain finished fourth in the women's sevens.

As one of only 12 Wales players awarded a fulltime contract this year, Joyce underwent shoulder surgery in May to be "in the form of my life for the Rugby World Cup."

### Laure Sansus (FRA)

An attacking scrum-half with a sharp eye for a break, the 28-year-old shone during the Six Nations.

She scored six tries in three starts, touching down twice each against Ireland, Scotland and Wales, to be named player of the tournament.

Sansus, who sparked France to a 21-0 win over Italy by scoring the opening try recently, plans to retire after the Rugby World Cup with a winner's medal.

"This is what we fight for every day. A trophy means performing well at the Rugby World Cup," said the 28-year-old.

### Arabella McKenzie (AUS)

After helping Australia win Sevens gold at the Youth Commonwealth Games in 2017, McKenzie was just out of her teens when she made her full test debut two years later.

The 23-year-old will face club teammate Kendra Cocksedge when hosts New Zealand play Australia in the opening game at Eden Park.

McKenzie matured this season partnering Cocksedge for Christchurch-based Matatu in Super Rugby.

Australia lost twice to New Zealand last month, but McKenzie took heart from the narrow 22-14 defeat in Adelaide when she kicked two conversions.

"They're world-class but we'll be looking to put our best foot forward," she said.
