INTRODUCTION

Olupale Investments intends to develop a mine in Otjiwarongo district as the EPLs mineral deposit stretches along the Damara belt known to be rich in Gold, hence the need to conduct an Environmental Assessment on the area covered by EPL 8148, 8326 & 8056 respectively. The intended proposed mineral exploration activities on the same EPLs are aimed at unearthing the minerals deposit to enhance the Namibian economy and improve the likelihoods of our people. The group of minerals are: Dimension stone, Base & Rare metals, Industrial minerals and precious metals

In this respect Junior Baiano Industrial Consultants (JBIC) cc have been appointed to carry out an Environmental Assessment study to obtain an environmental clearance certificate as per the requirements of the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism in terms of infrastructure development.

The study will incorporate biophysical, ecological and socio-economic baseline investigations relating to the proposed project.

In terms of the Namibian environmental Impact Assessment Regulations of 2012, an Environmental Clearance Certificate is to be obtained before the project can proceed.

- To assess the significance of issues and concerns raised;
- Review the legal and policy framework and its relevance to this project;
- Describe general and socio-economic environment of the project to determine impacts and suitability to the project site.
- Identify and assess impacts related to the continued operations.
- Compile an Assessment Report and Management Plan (EMP) which includes recommendations and methods to minimize the identified negative environmental impacts of the proposed project.
- To identify existing environmental conditions and associated environmental sensitivities within and adjacent to the project area that may potentially be affected, i.e. Environmental sensitivity and monitoring procedures.

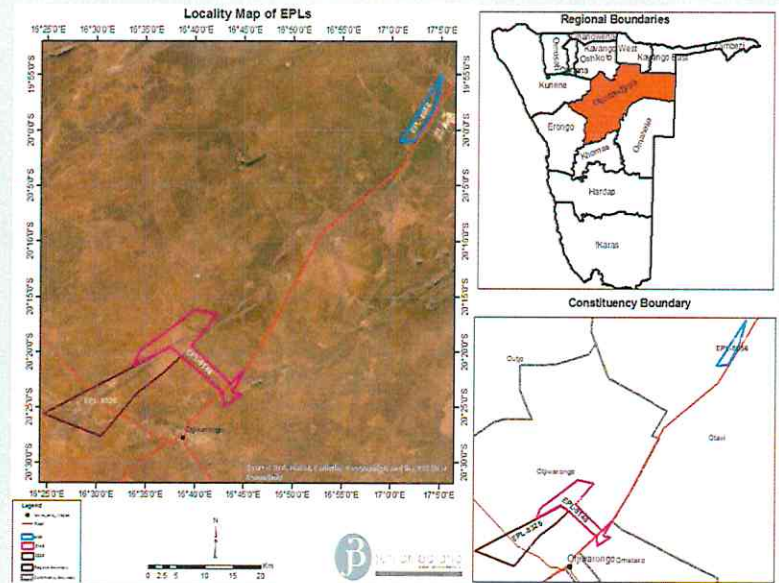

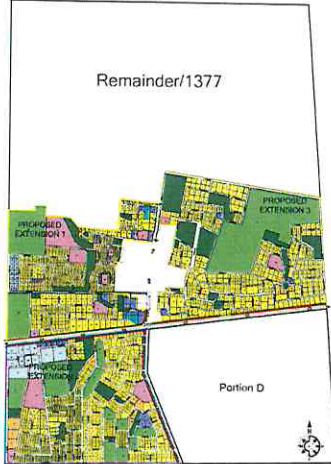

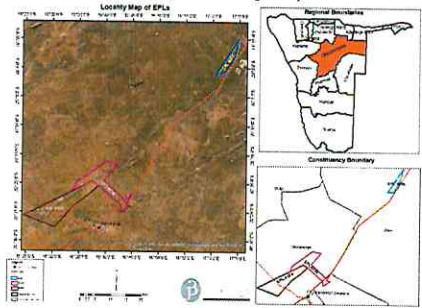

Many public enterprises (PEs) are failing to prepare and submit annual reports to the Ministry of Finance and Public Enterprises and portfolio ministries as per prescribed time frames.

In 2021, 33 PEs did not submit their annual reports, while the figure in 2022 stood at 40, according to the Ministry of Finance and Public Enterprise.

Namibia has 21 commercial public enterprises, 38 non-commercial and 11 financial institutions and extra-budgetary funds.

According to the ministry, in 2021, 12 out of 21 commercial public enterprises submitted annual reports whilst only seven out of 21

Locality, geology and supporting infrastructure – EPL 8056, 8148 and EPL 8326

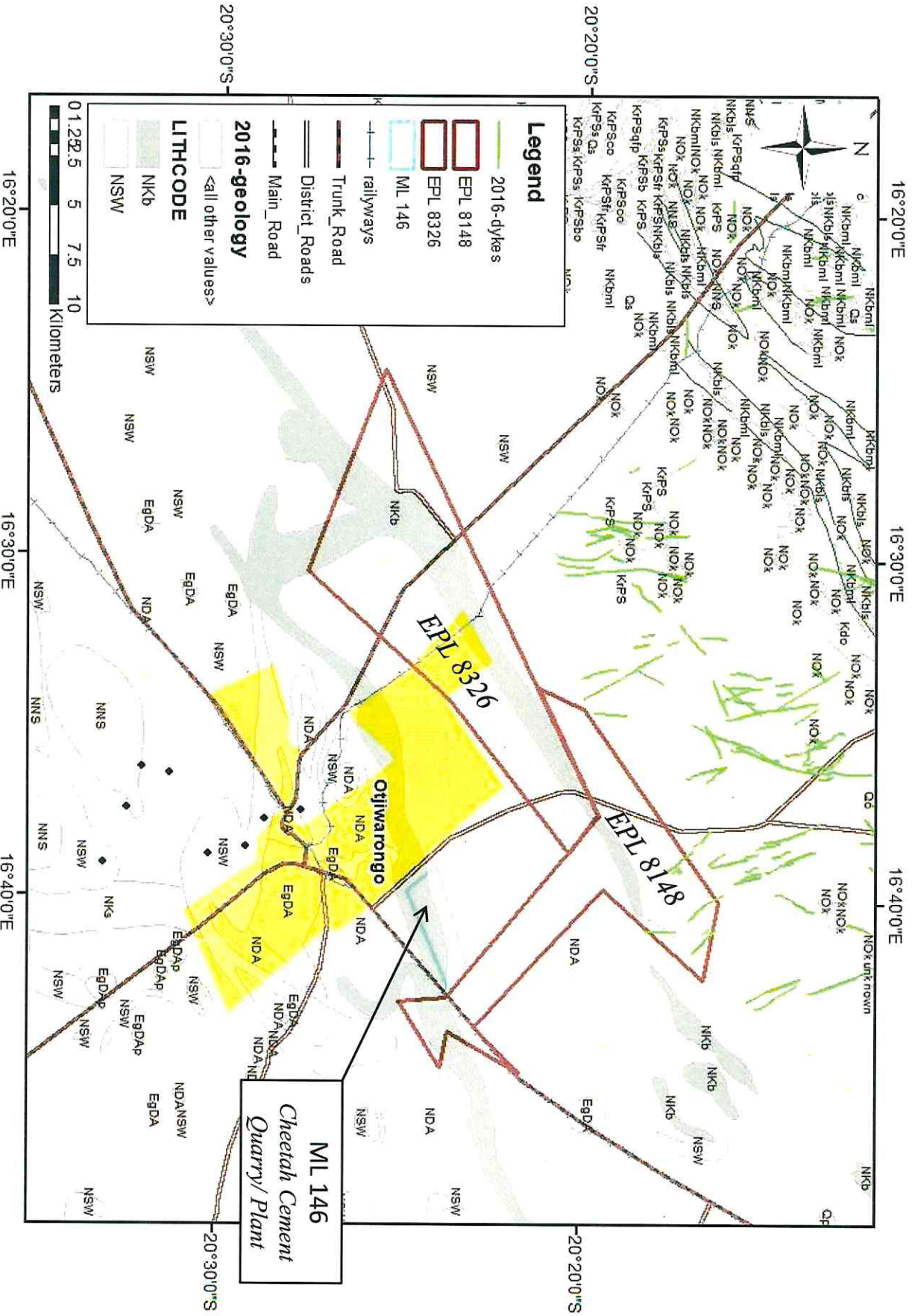

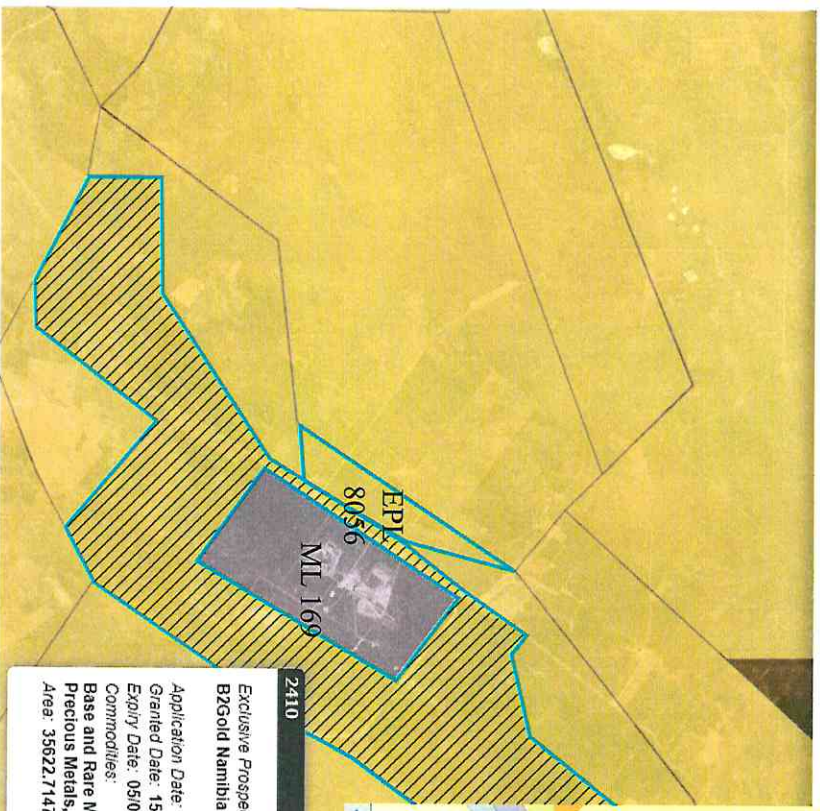
Regional Geology overview of the 3 licenses



All three prospecting licenses are hosted in the North-east trending Damara Orogenic Belt which is host to the Otjikoto, Navachab and Twin Hills Gold Deposits. The EPLs are hosts to calc-silicates which are similar in origin and structural make up as the three known gold deposits listed above. The 2 EPLs closer to Otiwarongo are also proxima to an existing Cement factory, and are all strategically located in close proximity to key rail and road infrastructure such as the B. national highway which both connect to the Walvis Bay Bulk Terminal and Harbour.

EPL 8056

EPL 8056 is located directly to the west of EPL 2410 and Mining License (ML) 169 which host the B2 Gold Otjikoto Gold Mine. 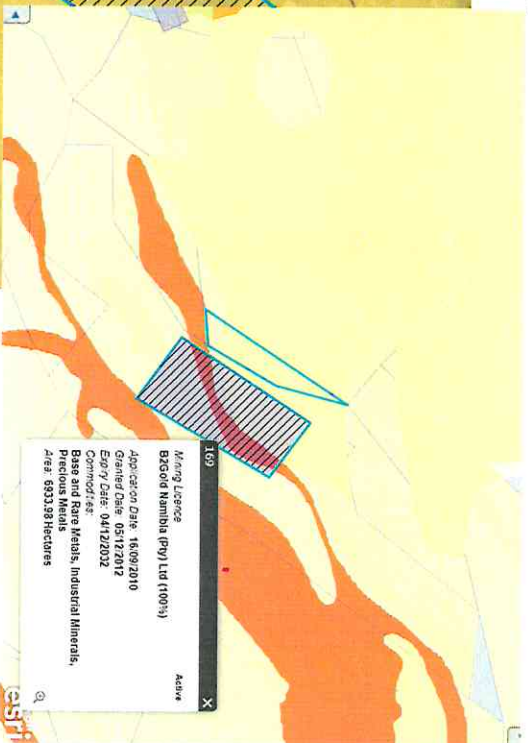

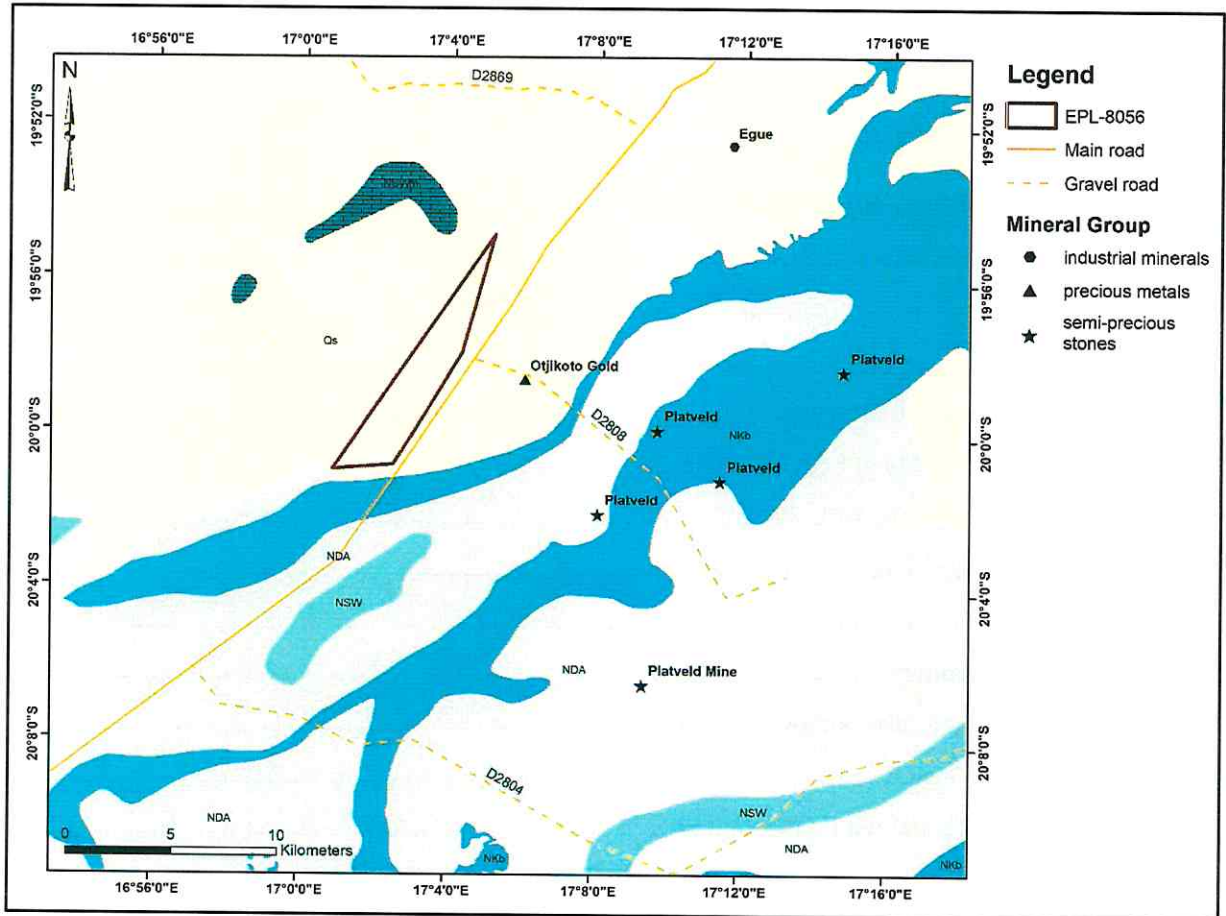

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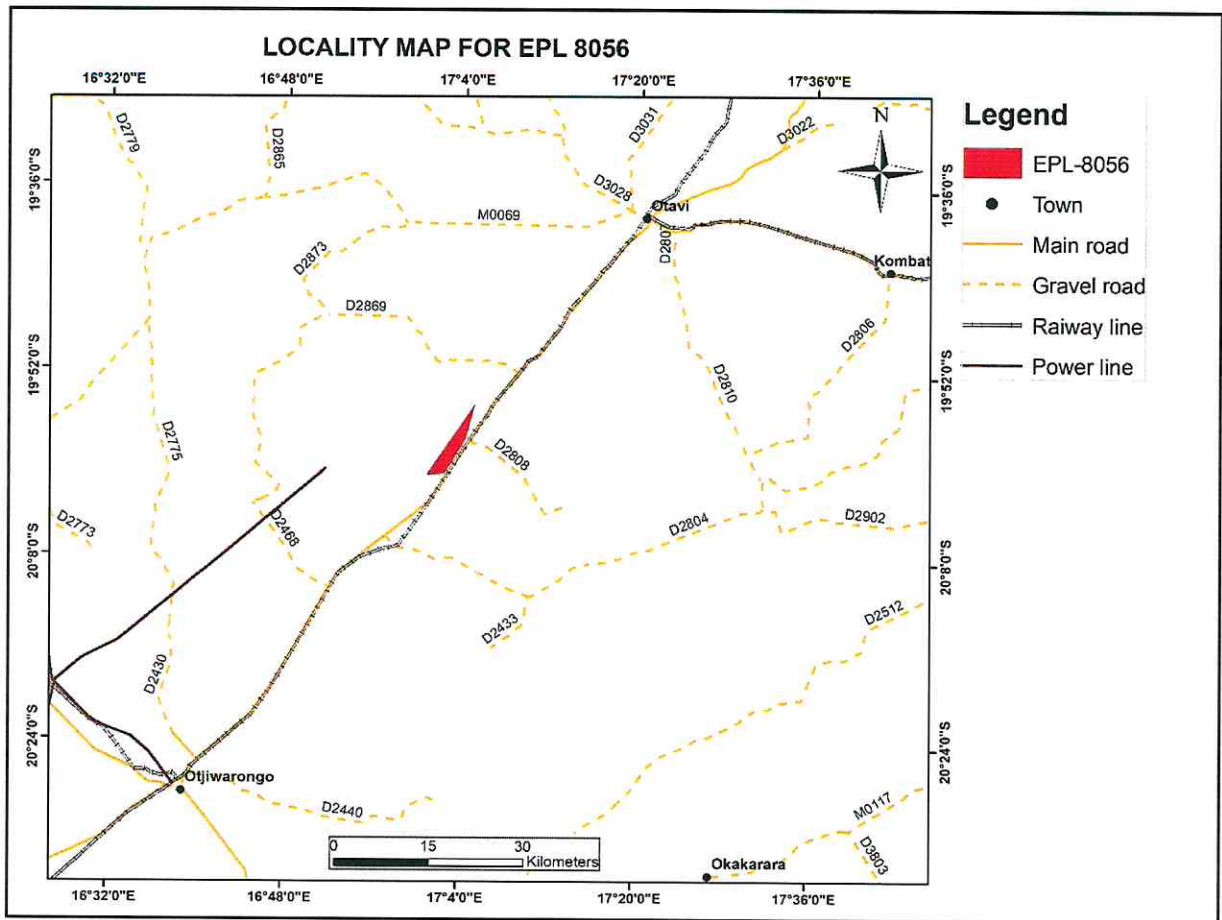


Figure 1: Location map for EPL 8056 showing roads, railway, power line infrastructure and nearby towns.

1.2. Exploration rights to EPL No. 8056

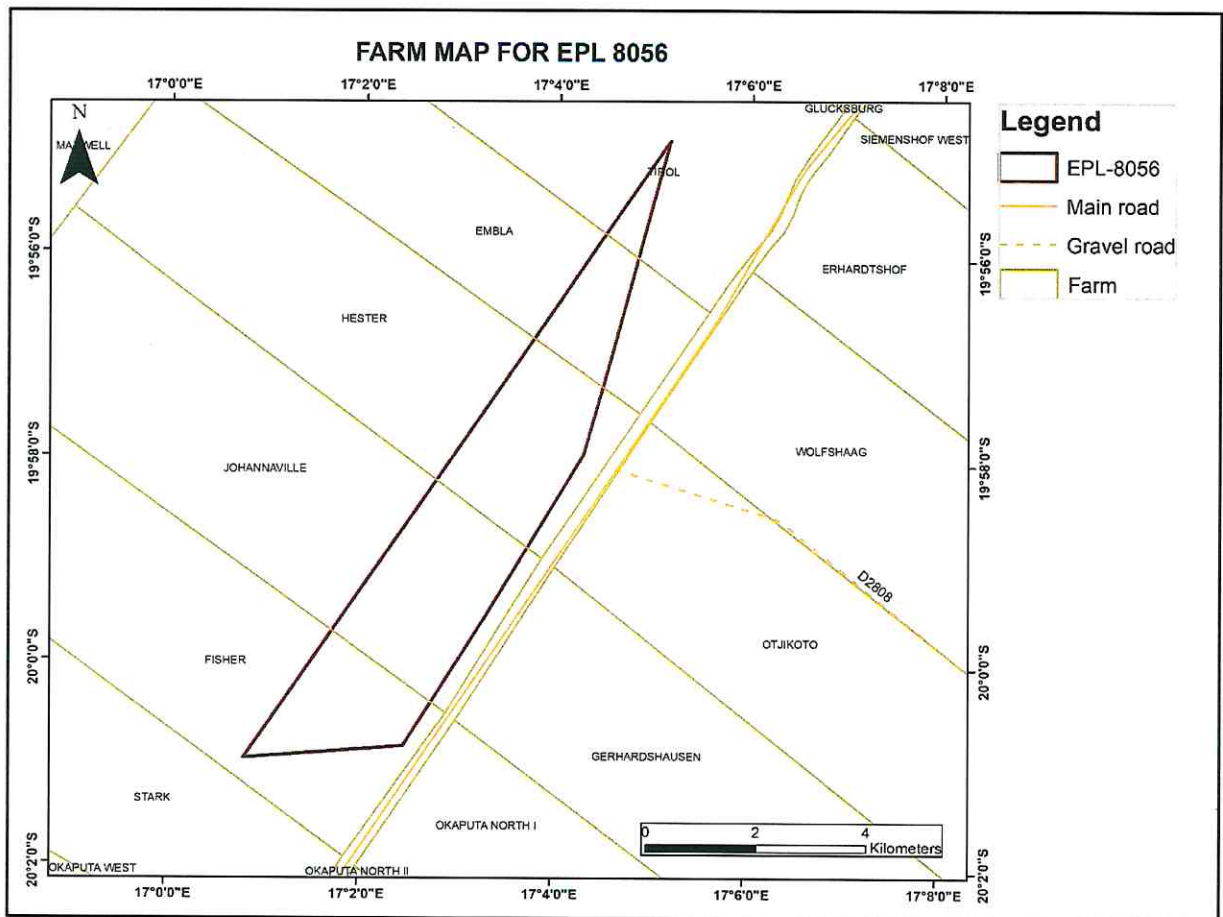


Figure 2: Farm map showing, farms covering EPL 8056.

1.4. Climatic condition

The general climate of the region in which the property is located is considered semi-arid. The climate does not seasonally restrict field activities hence; field operations could be carried out throughout the year. Most of the rain falls between December and March, June to August are considered dry rainfall months (Figure 4). Maximum temperatures range between 23.4 °C to 32°C per month with a maximum in October (Figure 4).

Zone and the northern Central Zone (Figure 3). In the Northern Zone, the siliciclastics of the basal Nosib Group are overlain by carbonates, schists and minor coarse clastic rocks of the Swakop Group. Two glacial horizons, i.e. the Chuos and Ghaub diamictites, subdivide the Swakop and Otavi Groups into subgroups (Table 1), providing distinct lithological and geochronological markers. The highest stratigraphic unit of the Damara Super-group is formed by the siliciclastic Mulden Group, which represents a molasses facies restricted to the northern part of the orogen. After the deposition of Damara sediments, a variety of granitic bodies were emplaced during or after the deformational and metamorphic events throughout the Orogen. According to Corner (2000), the lower units which include diamictites, psammitic rocks and volcanics (Nosib Group and lower Swakop Group) may be strongly magnetic whereas the pelitic and carbonate sequences of the Swakop Group tend to be magnetically quiet.

2.2. Local geology surrounding EPL 8056.

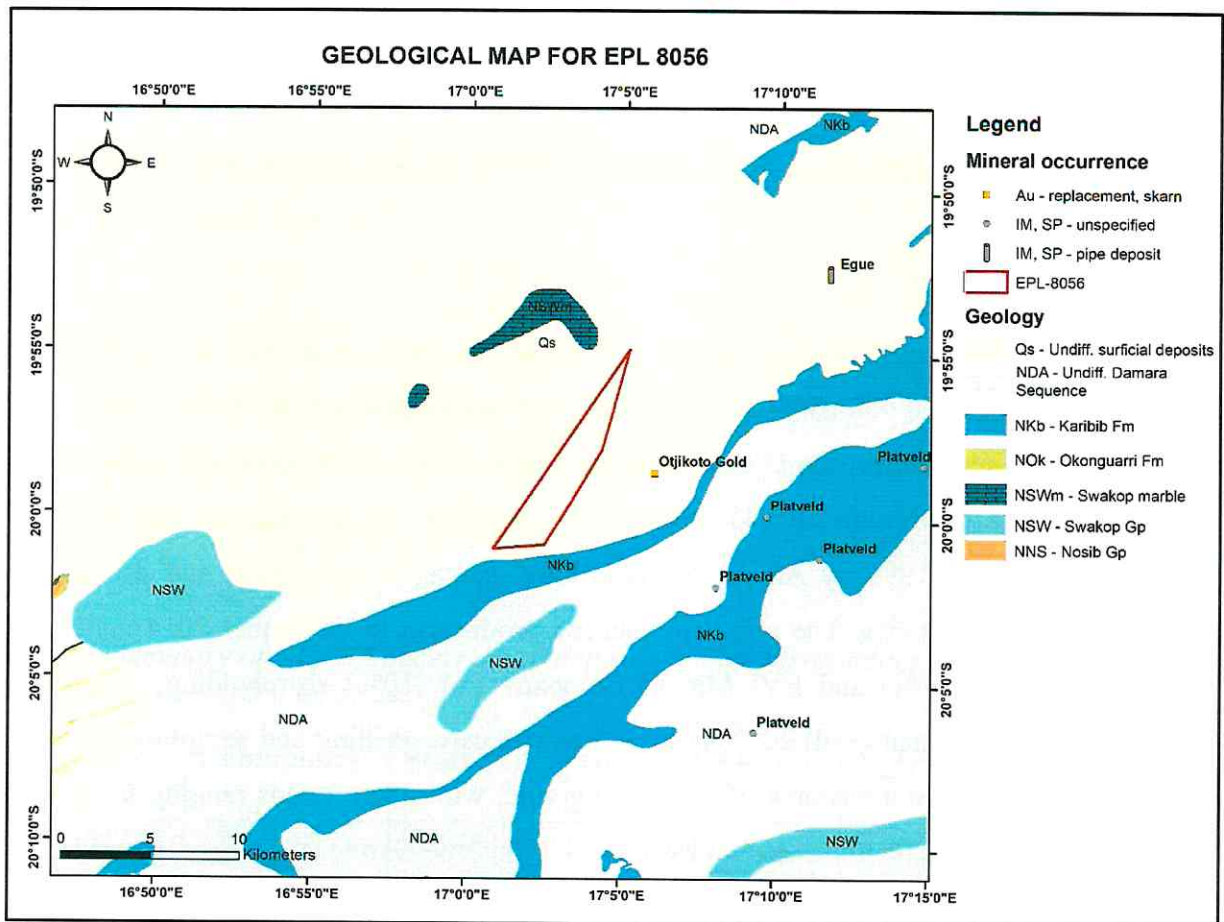


Figure 6: Local geology map for EPL 8056. Notice the Otjokoto Gold Mine located east of EPL 8056.

The EPL 8056 is located west of the active Otjikoto Gold Mine. The project area is entirely covered by Quaternary sediments, consisting of sand gravel and calcrete (Figure 6). However, in the area surrounding the EPL, the Swakop Group rocks of the Damara Super group are exposed together with largely undifferentiated units of the Damara Sequence. These units have a general NE-SW trend direction (Figure 6). The Swakop Group has a total thickness of 15 km in the Northern Zone and overlies the siliciclastic Nosib Group which forms the base of the Damara Supergroup. Rocks of the Nosib group are exposed southwest of EPL 8056 (Figure 5).

The Swakop Group in this area is subdivided into the Ugab, Usakos and Navachab Subgroups by the two interbedded glacial horizons (i.e. Chuos and Ghaub Formations, Table 2, Figure 5) which represent important distinct lithological and geochronological markers within the schists and marbles of the upper Damara Supergroup (e.g. Martin, 1965; SACS, 1980; Miller, 1983; Henry et al., 1986). Of the three subgroups, only the Navachab Subgroup, represented here by the Karibib Formation and the Usakos Subgroup (Okonguarri Formation) are exposed around EPL 8056. The Chuos Formation is characterised by iron rich horizons, boulders of various sizes, generally rich in quartzitic matrix and forms excellent magnetic highs on aeromagnetic maps. Furthermore, a magnetite ironstone reported on Farms Rheinau 51 and Otjikango 50 is presumed to form part of the Chuos Formation (Miller, 2008).

The Okonguarri Formation represents a succession of carbonate and siliciclastic turbidites between the Chuos and Ghaub Formation in the Northern Zone (Table 2). The Formation is correlated with the Arandis Formation of the Central zone and its type area is the Okonguarri Antiform SW of Outjo and here the unit reaches a thickness of over 4600 m (Guj, 1974). In the Okonguarri Antiform, the formation comprises of an interbedded succession of siliciclastic, calcareous and dolomitic turbidites. In the area surrounding EPL 8056, the Okonguarri Formation outcrops south-west of EPL 8056, over the farm Dornwald and consists of schist, subgreywacke and impure quartzite that are locally interbedded with arenaceous limestone and marble layers. The quartzites are locally brecciated and massive whereas the pelitic rocks are well-bedded and commonly display sedimentary features such as graded bedding, cross-bedding and slumping. Rocks range from fine-grained brownish-grey to black pelitic quartzites and subgreywackes to medium- to coarse-grained quartz-albite-biotite schist with garnet and amphibole porphyroblasts grown during regional metamorphism. Carbonate interbeds consists of massive to bedded arenaceous medium- to

silicates and diamictites. Gold mineralization at the Otjikoto Gold Mine is hosted within the Okonguari Formation of the Swakop Group. The Okonguari Formation is observed outcropping west of EPL 8056 (Figure 5) with a general NE-SW trending direction and possible extensions of this unit into the EPL are possible because the license area is entirely covered by Quaternary sediments.

3. MINERAL ECONOMICS

3.1. Mineral Potential within the vicinity

- Gold: Hosted by veins within the Okonguarri Formation (Swakop Group) of the Damara Super-group.
- Copper – Silver: Occur in quartzites of the Chuos Formation, dolomites of the Tsumeb Subgroup and arenites of the Mulden Group.
- Copper: Occurs within the Hüttenberg and upper Elandshoek Formations of the Tsumeb Subgroup.
- lead-zinc-vanadium: Hosted within the Gauss and Auros Formations of the Abenab Subgroup.

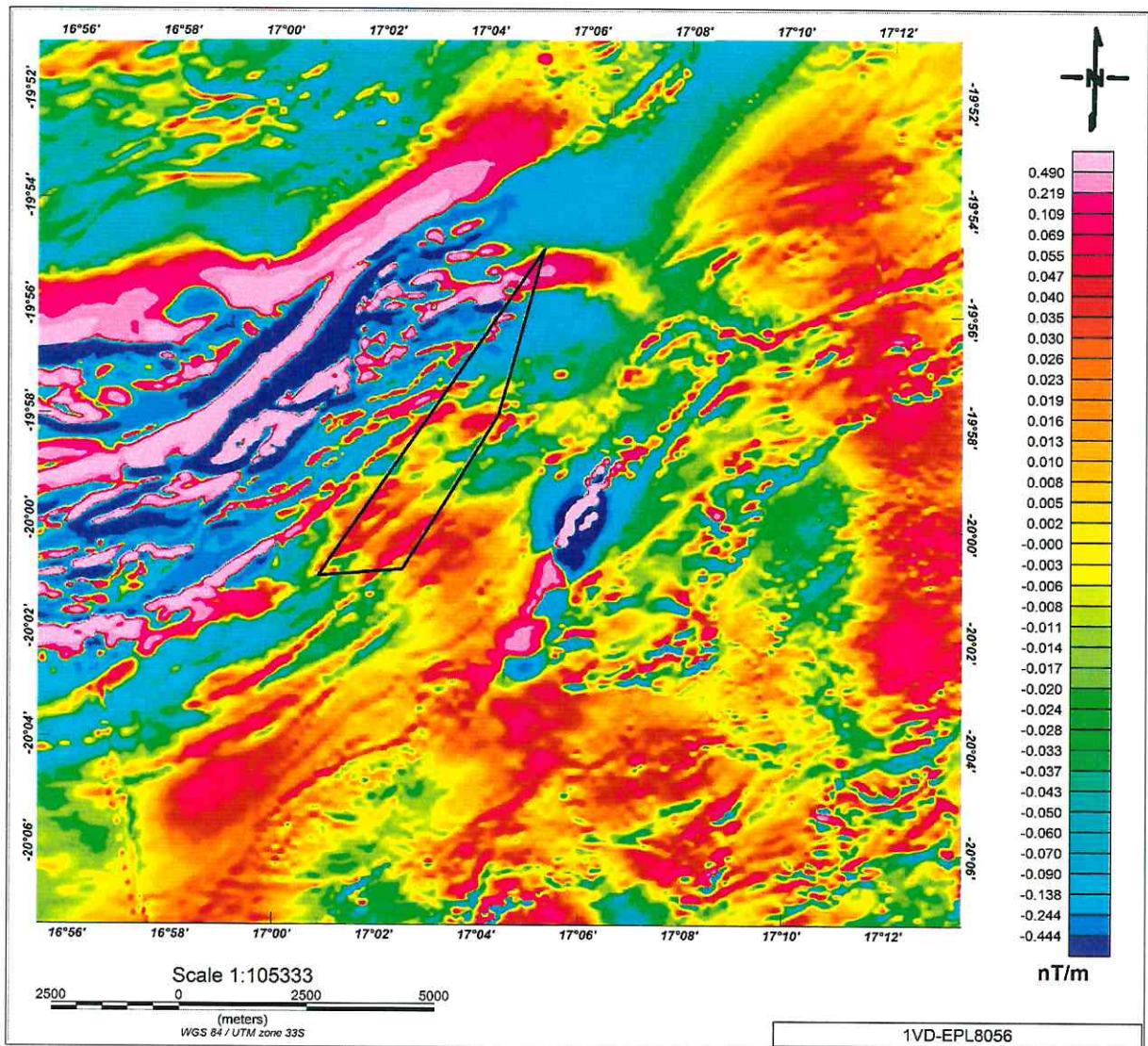


Figure 8: First Vertical Derivative Map (data source Geological Survey of Namibia)

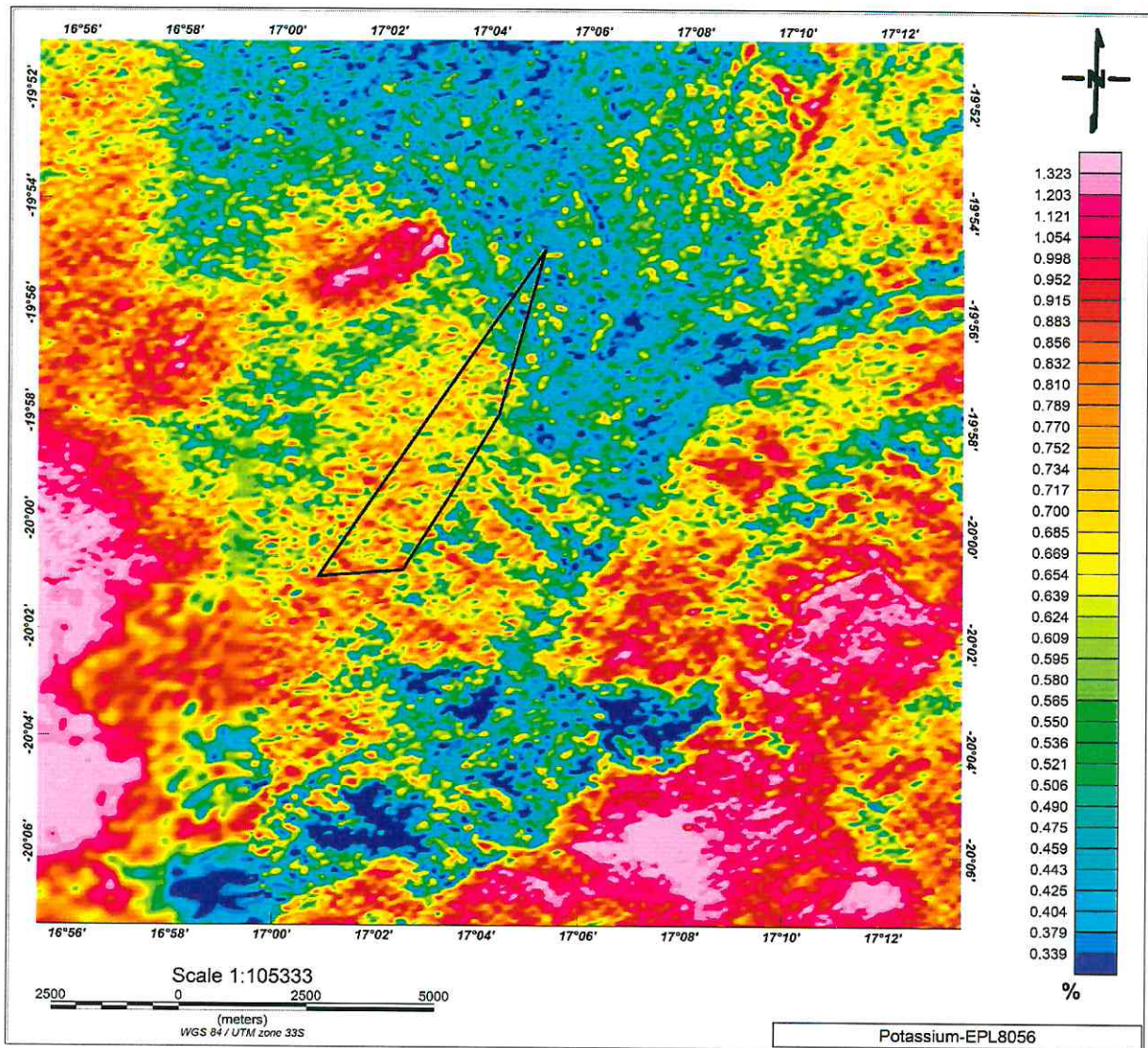


Figure 10: Potassium Radiometric Map (data source Geological Survey of Namibia)

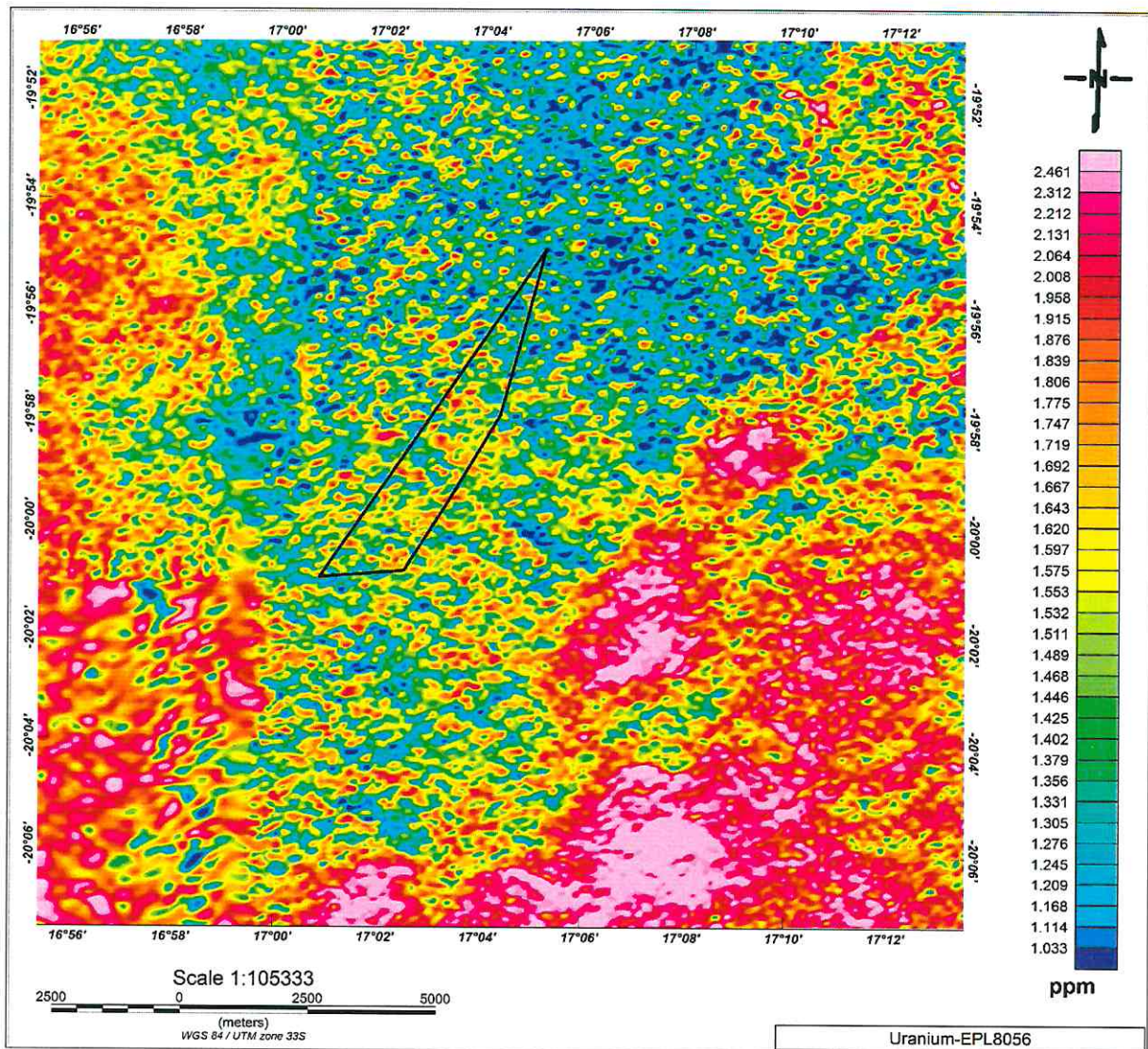


Figure 12: Uranium Radiometric Map (data source Geological Survey of Namibia)

5. INTERGRATED DATA AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR EXPLORATION

Integrated geology, geophysics and historical data of known mineral occurrences within the vicinity, shows that the property has potential to host Base Metals, Precious Metals and Industrial Minerals. The mineral potential within the licence is inferred, based on the surrounding geology and previous exploration work since the project area is entirely covered by Kalahari Group sediments. EPL 8056 is located a few kilometres from the Otjikoto Gold deposit. This demonstrates that the area is inherently prospective and there are possibilities by which this can be improved. Additional to this is the fact that the Otjikoto deposit is hosted within the Okonguarri Formation which is observed outcropping southwest of EPL 8056 with
