MEMO: CONSENT FROM NATIONAL HERITAGE COUNCIL - MÖWE BAY STATION (REF: APP - 001704)

With regards to the requirement for "Consent from the National Heritage Council" specified in the verification of the subject application, please note that Lund Consulting Engineers undertook an Infrastructure Status Assessment and confirmed that "All buildings earmarked for demolition prior to construction of new buildings, are very old, of prefabricated nature and in a dilapidated state. Most of these buildings were built in the late 1980's or early 1990's with some renovations done after 2010. **None of the buildings are of historical significance**" (see Appendix E of the EIA Scoping Report).

The Infrastructure Status Assessment report has been submitted to the National Heritage Council and their response will be provided to the Department on receipt.
