ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT AND ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE RENEWAL OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR THE CLOSURE OF PORTION A OF ERF 2588 (MULDERINE STREET) AS STREET, THE CREATION OF PORTION B OF ERF 2590 AS STREET AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF FACILITIES AND STORAGE AND HANDLING OF PETROLEUM PRODUCTS ON ERVEN 2589 AND 2590, WALVIS BAY

In terms of Section 24 (2) of the Act, the Ministry must prepare an environmental plan for the 'listed activities' as per the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (GN 30 in GG 4878 of 6 February 2012).

The Ministry of Mines and Energy is herewith requested to prepare and submit an environmental plan in the prescribed form and manner as per the requirements of Section 24 (2) of the Environmental Management Act 2007 (Act No. 7 of 2007) and to submit it to the Environmental Commissioner for final review and resolution. The attached EIA and EMP should form the basis of your assessment.
