
INVITATION TO COMMENT ON THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT FOR THE SUBDIVISION OF ERF 62, REHOBOTH EXTENSION 1 INTO 12 ERVEN AND REMAINDER AND THE CREATION OF A STREET.

Mr. William Izaacs has appointed Nghivelwa Planning Consultants a Town and Regional Planning and Environmental Management Consulting Firm to carry out the necessary procedures for the Subdivision of Erf 62, Rehoboth Extension 1 into 12 Erven and Remainder and the creation of a street. According to the Environmental Management Act (No 7 of 2007) the subdivision of land and creation of streets needs an environmental clearance from the Environmental Commissioner before it can be approved.

We have thus been appointed to attend to and complete an Environmental Scoping Assessment and an Environmental Management Plan (EMP) in order to obtain an Environmental Clearance Certificate for the Subdivision of Erf 62, Rehoboth Extension 1 into 12 Erven and Remainder and the creation of a street, as per requirements of the Environmental Management Act (No 7 of 2007) and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (GN 30 in GG 4878 of 6 February 2012), Listed activities.

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

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
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
