1. Introduction

The minutes reflect the discussions that took place Liselo sub-khuta in Liselo communal area in the Zambezi region, that was held on the 15 December 2020. The meeting was organized by the consultant & the business proponent **Pumba Bricks & Construction cc** who intends to develop a brick making project facility in Zambezi region in the area of Liselo under Katima Urban Constituency. Different Ministries and Stakeholders were informed and invited to the meeting. A total number of Thirteen (13) people attended the meeting as per the attached attendance register. Due to the low turnout number of people that attended the meeting. The consultant for Nyepez consultant facilitated the meeting as no one was nominated to facilitate the meeting proceedings

- No apology gives. Different ministries or stakeholders were invested and signed the invitation letters as acknowledgment of receiving the invitation but did not give any apologies

2. Registration of Participants

The people who attended the Public Scoping Consultations were mainly from the community and traditional authority and headmen from Liselo communal area

3. Introduction of Participants

The Consultant chaired and facilitated the meeting. No community member was willing, volunteered or was nominated by the present members to facilitate the meeting. Participants to the Public Consultation of the Scoping Phase

introduced themselves indicating the organization that they were representing. Most of the participants indicated to the meeting that they were aware of the proposed brick making project as most of them came from the Liselo area. Their view was that the project was welcome as it will and support the on-going developments in the area and to the people of Liselo area and the region.

Support to the community

The business investors of Pumba brick & construction cc were present at the meeting to be able to respond to all questions or matters which were to be raised at the meeting. the consultant (Nyeppez consultant) informed the audience or stakeholders of the socio-economic benefits the project is bringing and the community and the region at large. The Consultant gave examples of employment creation, training, effective and efficient, infrastructure development, Tourism Liselo area marketing and financial contributions as some of the benefits that communities will benefit to the development.

Project Location & Land use

The Consultant informed the participants of the locality of the project, where he explained that the project is situated alongside the gravel road adjoining to the Trans-caprivi highway road, near other existing residential and businesses properties hence the developer intends to add yet another commercial brick supply chain to the local residents for property and infrastructure development in the area. He informed the members that the land belonged to Pumba brick & construction cc as be the signed consent letter from Mafwe Traditional Authority.

Thus, due to high demand of new construction development in Liselo and the town of Katima Mulilo the proponent intends to contribute to the brick supply to both private and public for construction material supply by the company. The Proponents of Pumba brick & construction cc explained that the proposed land use proposed was welcomed by the Liselo Sub-khuta as well as the Mafwe traditional authority and consent letter for leasehold customary land right.

Comments and questions from members participants

Mr Obrien Sinkolela (Secretary Liselo sub-khuta) – welcomed the initiative in Liselo and the entire region as a good achievement and explained the importance attending the meeting that, such initiative of a brick making project not far from the residents of liselo was an important and crucial initiative as there was high demand of clients and customers or local residents who intend to develop and construct their properties. The development initiative is in line with the ministry of environment forestry and tourism which strive to achieve sustainable community-based developments and environment preservation and protection of natural resources. He thanked and welcomed the proposed development to continue as it will uplift the livelihood of people in the Zambezi region.

Mr Rick Sipapela – (community member) – Thanked Nyepuz Consultants for organizing such meetings and for consulting the grassroots level, as such kind of participatory meeting will always prevent land disputes and conflict among communities living or residing in the same area. From the community point of view, he explained that the Liselo area was the only area of urban growth on the outskirts of Katima Mulilo town and as such more developments were observed in the area as most land in the town is already occupied.

He indicated that there was no wildlife existence in the area as a result of the increased developments (*see picture in scoping report*). Therefore, he welcomed the initiative saying it is a vital project that will uplift the development level, livelihood of local residents of Liselo and the Zambezi region and will contribute to the GDP revenue generated at the lodge through tax fees. He however cautioned the preservation of vegetation and for proponents to avoid clearing of forest for no purpose.

Mr Andreas Mueze & Mr Sepo Funwell (senior headmens -Liselo sub khuta) - explained and thanked the public for attending an important meeting which concerned the development of Liselo area under Liselo jurisdiction. He confirmed that the business proponents Pumba brick & construction cc followed the right procedure when land was allocated for the project. He explained that the developer approached the Liselo sub-khuta to inform them of his decision to develop a brick making facility on the land allocated by the traditional authority measuring 1.5 hectares. He further expected that the business should mostly employ local residents of Liselo area which is of importance as it contributed to poverty reduction, hence the reason why the Liselo sub-khuta & mafwe traditional authority accepted this business proposal in the area.

All representative members agreed that the brick making project must continue as there was a need of cost cutting factors from residents of Liselo to access the market of brick for construction locality and there were no adverse impacts or problems that they foresee for the development to be implemented, thus the project proposal was highly welcomed.
