## INTRODUCTION

Mobile Telecommunication Limited (PTY) LTD intends to achieve the objective of improved telecommunication connectivity, and continue to expand network coverage in the remote areas of Namibia with the aim of bringing development close to the people in line with the decentralization approach. MTC intends to install and operate a 80m guyed mast telecommunication tower in Okarundu Opstal No:2, Karibib district, Erongo region.

In this respect Junior Baiano Industrial Consultants (JBIC) cc have been appointed to carry out an Environmental Assessment study to obtain an environmental clearance certificate as per the requirements of the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism in terms of infrastructure development.

The study will incorporate biophysical, ecological and socio-economic baseline investigations relating to the proposed project.

In terms of the Namibian environmental Impact Assessment Regulations of 2012, an Environmental Clearance Certificate is to be obtained before the project can proceed.

This is because under the Government Notice 29 of 2008, Section 10 INFRASTRUCTURE states that

(g) Communication networks including towers, telecommunication and marine telecommunication lines and cables.

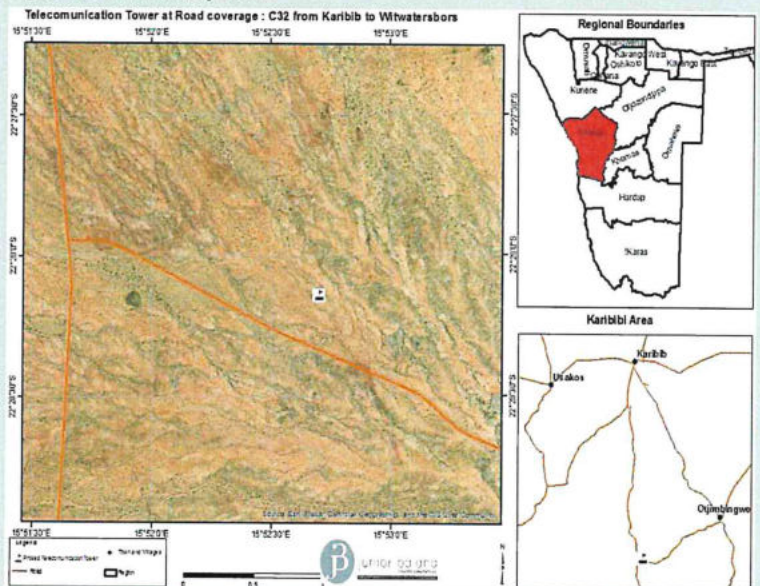
The proposed infrastructure will have minimal impacts on the natural resources, i.e. water, fauna and flora.

As a result, from 2015 to 2019 the country has spent on average N\$115,2 million every year importing washed potatoes.

The total annual domestic potato consumption for the country is estimated to be 40,670 metric tonnes. With 10 328 metric tonnes being consumed through the formal market and 262 metric tonnes exported while 7 177 metric tonnes are estimated to be consumed through the informal market.

Out of the 19 special fresh produce, there are other 8 that will also be imported on a pro-rata basis (on percentage allocation), because the farmers' data have indicated that their harvest is not adequate.

The eight to be imported on pro rata are beetroot, butternuts, carrots, English cucumber, coloured and green pepper, jam tomatoes, and lettuce.

The border is open for the importation of watermelon, sweet melon, sweetcorn, pumpkin, and gem squash, according to the notice.

and Angola. It is regrettable that the Kalimbeza is without normal production on the 229 hectares of land in Kabbe North Constituency.

Therefore, investment in green scheme re-evaluate should not be an issue of debate but rather on how to improve the performances of various irrigation schemes across the country by addressing the various challenges encountered.

Generally, the government is now aware of the significant role of irrigation development and its efficient utilisation of food security and economic growth.

Moreover, as is widely accepted, if Namibia is to witness sustainable green schemes resuscitate and poverty reduction it will need to learn from other countries such as China, the United States, and India whilst in Africa we can learn from Sierra Leone, Ethiopia, and South Africa amongst others.

The Ministry of Agriculture, Water, and Land Reform should recognize the importance of flexibility in the timing and design of reform processes to achieve practical and effective policy changes.

Governments should prepare future reforms, via continued research, education, and governance efforts, to help take advantage of reform opportunities when the timing is right.

Additionally, there is light at the end of the tunnel as Namibia Training Authority encouraged the National Policy on Work-integrated Learning for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET).

In order to meet this challenge, the agricultural sector in Namibia needs serious reforms and an increase in public investments in agriculture.

To reach these goals the development of skills and knowledge plays a key important cross-cutting and value-adding strategy.

On the basis of a review and revaluation activities of Green Scheme irrigated agriculture projects in these regions, the general situation appears to be that monitoring and evaluation are having far less impact on the management process than expected or even possible.

One of the main reasons for this sad state of affairs is that monitoring and evaluation are being imposed from Senior Managers who are based in Windhoek to the farm managers.

In conclusion, this requires a great deal of courage to stay the course in the face of setbacks and to make decisions that may be unpopular with short-term-oriented stakeholders.

Effective partnerships between the government and private sector in critical areas of infrastructure and long-term investments would expedite development.

Therefore, faced with this difficult task, the easy option for policymakers would be to maintain the status quo.

But better policies for green schemes hold tremendous promise for meeting the challenge of food security and nutrition, livelihoods, and environmental sustainability.
