RON Keeps Repo Rate Unchanged

The annual inflation rate stood at 4.5% in July 2023, where food and non-alcoholic beverages are the main contributors (2.0 percentage points); alcoholic beverages and tobacco (0.9 percentage points).

Food and non-alcoholic beverages, which accounts for 16.5% of the consumer basket, registered an annual inflation rate of 10.5% during July 2023, compared to 8.4% obtained during July 2022.

The food sub-category accounts for 14.8% of the consumer basket in the NCPI. Within the food subcomponent, Bread and cereals account for the highest weight of food items that consumers purchase, having a weight of 4.8%, followed by meat (3.5%); sugar, jam, honey, syrups, chocolate, and confectionery (1.4%);

Vegetable inflation increased by 18.1% in July 2023 compared to 6.6% recorded a year ago.

The increase in the annual inflation rate for this subcategory was mainly observed in cabbage from -26.7% to 54.3%, and spinach from -37.0% to 9.0%.

Beetroot prices increased at the rate of 30.5%, onions from 7.2% to 45.7%, and broccoli, cauliflower from 2.8% to 36.6%.

Analysis of the average retail prices of selected products for July 2023 revealed that consumers in Zone 2 paid the highest price for an egg pack of six at N\$22.13, followed by Zone 3 at N\$21.29, while consumers in Zone 1 paid the lowest price of N\$19.83.

For pure sunflower (750ml), consumers in Zone 1 paid the lowest price at N\$32.18 while the highest price was paid by consumers residing in Zone 2 at N\$34.90. Email: erastus@thevillager.com.na
