# Ole Gunnar Solskjaer hopes Eric Bailly return adds steel to shaky United defence

**M**ANCHESTER – Ole Gunnar Solskjaer is hoping the return of Eric Bailly will shore up Manchester United's leaky defence after they shipped three goals in their Premier League opener against Crystal Palace.

United's centre-back partnership of Harry Maguire and Victor Lindelof came under fire following their display against Palace, with the 3-1 defeat highlighting the club's need for a more dynamic presence in the heart of the defence.

A knee injury limited Bailly to 11 appearances last season but the Ivorian looked assured in United's 3-0 victory against Luton Town in the League Cup on Tuesday.

"Eric is fit again, a big big plus and looking forward to seeing him develop and play more games. We've been waiting him to be fit and play more regularly," Solskjaer told reporters ahead of Saturday's trip to Brighton and Hove Albion.

"I think last season proved to us how we can defend at our best, last week wasn't fantastic, we conceded sloppy goals, but I think our defensive record from last season with Eric and Harry shows how good a partnership they were."

Saturday's game will be the first of a double header against Brighton, with United set to visit the Amex Stadium for their League Cup fourth-round tie next week.

"We have to take it one game at a time, the Premier League first and all our focus is on that. We had a bad start last week and we want kick on and play a better game," Solskjaer added.

# Wrestling remains in the shadows

**D**ESPITE wrestling being a sport code on its own under the Namibia Professional Boxing, the code is far from being professionalised because there is no track record of professional wrestling in the country.

Wrestling operates under the Namibia Professional Boxing and Wrestling Control Board (NPBWCB) which is currently spearheaded by former Minister of Health, Dr Bernard Haufiku who is the board's chairperson.

Another body responsible for wrestling in the country is the Namibia Wrestling Federation (NWF) however the body is only in charge at an amateur level.

Executive Director in the Ministry of Sport, Youth and National Service, Sihute Katamba has therefore urged those with knowledge of professionalising wrestling to approach the ministry in order for the code to be professionalised like boxing.

Although the Directorate of Sport has over the years been giving the NPBWCB close to NS1 million annually, the code has not been receiving a single cent from the portion of the money.

In the past, there have been reports of mismanagement at NPBWCB, resulting in the government cutting funding of the board since 2016.

"There is no record of professional wrestling or wrestlers in Namibia and there was never a request for establishment of a professional wrestling body. If there are any professional wrestlers, they must approach the Ministry for us to assist with the setting up of the relevant body."

"The fact that there is no record of professional wrestling or wrestlers in Namibia meant that professional wrestling as a code is redundant. How do we fund a code or body that is non-existent?" said Katamba.

Amateur wrestling continues to do wonders for the country with


sensation Romeo Goliath having won a silver medal at the All-Africa Games in Algeria early this year.

The most successful wrestler to come out of Namibia is Nicolaas 'Nico' Jacobs as he competed in the men's heavyweight category and claimed a bronze medal in the 96 kg division at the 2003 All-Africa Games in Nigeria, and later became the first Namibian wrestler to compete at the 2004 Summer Olympics in Greece.

Naatele Sem Shilimela was the second Namibian wrestler to compete at the Olympic Games after his appearance at the 2012 Games in London in the 55 kg event.



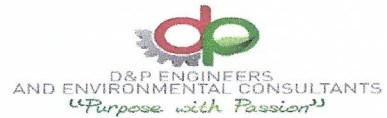

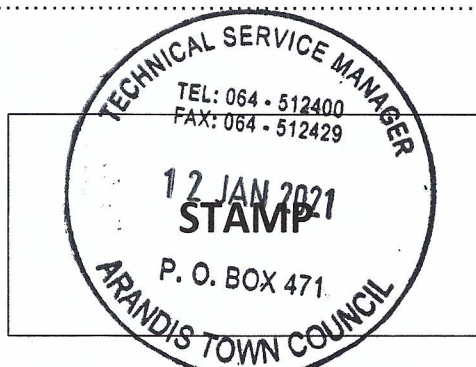

Because endemic and protected species already impacted by mines etc. in the central Namib occur there, I believe that a field survey should be done for those species over that leg once the proposed pylon sites are known; **I do concur with you, and there is already existing reptile and vegetation study and an Avian Impact Assessment commissioned for this area in 2018 for the 22KV and the new 44KV is just running adjacent to this site. I do however note your concern that once the pylon sites are identified and in case of specie relocations, a field study should be commissioned for this and this will be highlighted in the EMP for implementation as part of Pre-Construction Environmental Control and Compliance.**

As you have not indicated who the engineers are on the project, I think that I should point out that if it is your company, then there is a conflict of interest, and this EIA should have been done by someone else. **D&P Engineers and Environmental Consultants are not the appointed Design engineer for the powerline, Erongored Engineers are responsible for this development and if they appoint an Engineer it will be at a later stage. 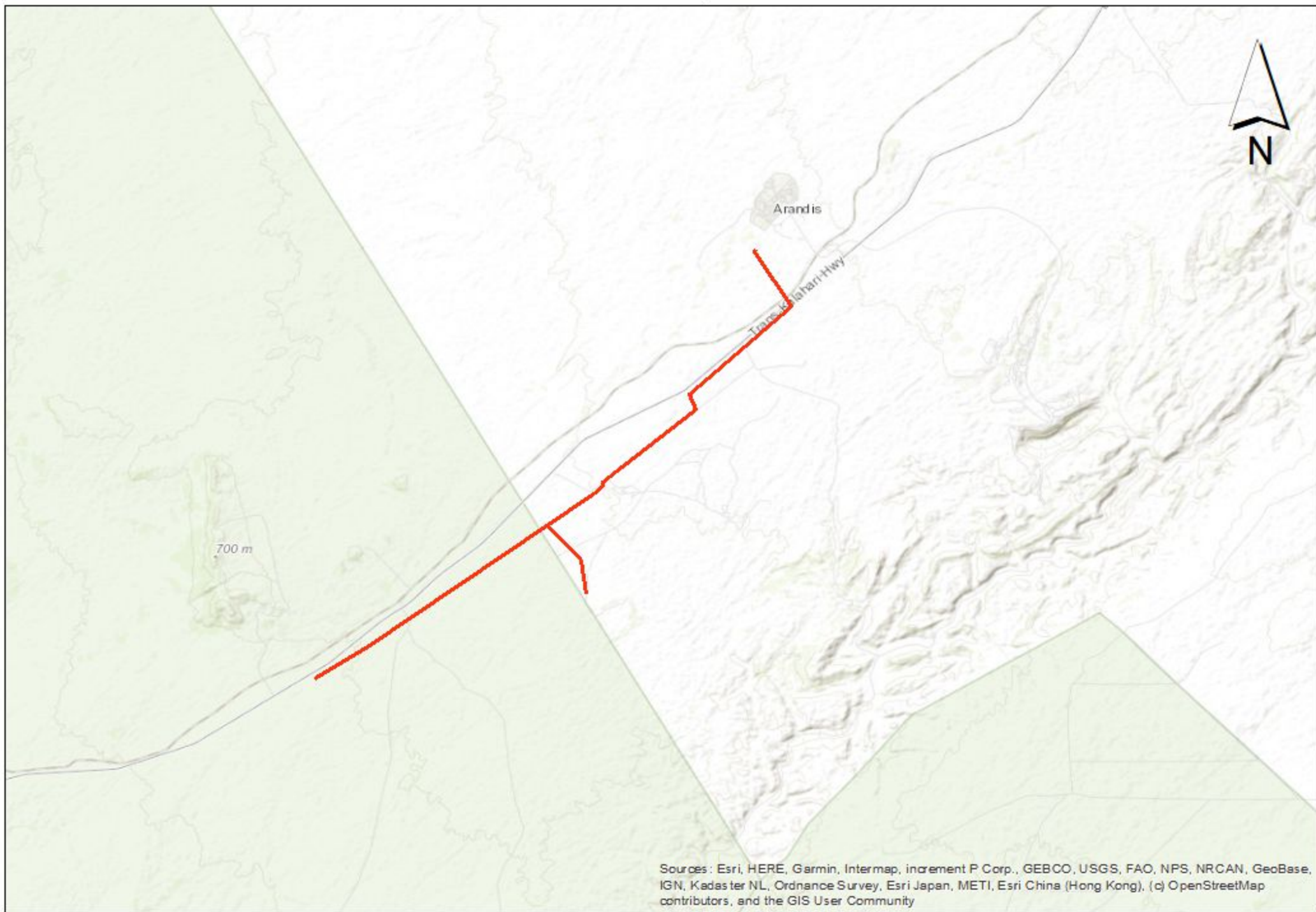
