Opening

- Discussion on the proposed project about the establishment and operation of a fuel storage and truck port facility that is proposed to be established on farm 139 in Walvis Bay.

Meeting agenda points and discussions

1. Zoning of the area

- The Municipality of Walvis Bay has an issue on the fact that the area is not yet zoned.
- The proponent is therefore encouraged to follow the necessary procedures to have the area zoned.

2. Lease agreement

- The lease agreement between the proponent and NIDA is not giving satisfying information about the ownership of the portion on farm 139 that is intended to be developed.
- Title deeds in the lease agreement does not have a number.

3. Building plans

- The proponent is yet to sort out the building plans approval with Roads, Building and Construction department.

Conclusion and recommendations

- The Municipality of Walvis Bay has no issues with the development/establishment being undertaken. They however, only encouraged the proponent to solve all the relevant issues raised regarding the proposed project before carrying out the establishment activities.
