RE: Environmental Scoping and Development of Environmental Management Plans for Tubussis and Xoxobos Small-Scale Mining (SSM) Hotspots in Erongo Region

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in collaboration with the Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) has appointed **Mr. Joseph Kondja Amushila** to carry out a collective Environmental scoping study for the Tubussis and Xoxobos Small-Scale Mining (SSM) hotspots in Erongo Region.
