'As you are aware, the economic conditions of today are very difficult for any company and business in the public and private sectors, but we, as a board, remain committed to ensuring formalisation of employment wages as per the salary processing in terms of the human resource policy as well as to attend to our fixed overhead obligations,' Gaomab said.

Gaomab was appointed interim chairperson last year, along with Social Security Commission CEO Milka Mungunda, lawyer Ruth Herunga and academic Penny Hiwilepo-Hal, who are also serving as interim board members.

Gaomab explained the Fishcor board is busy with a turnaround strategy, which is in line with the public enterprise ministry's directive of developing an integrated strategic business plan for the current financial year.

According to Gaomab, they have effective governance in place and are now in the process of recruiting a substantive CEO and management, as well as to provide continuous strategic oversight to Fishcor as mandated by the line ministry.

Last year, the company advertised the position of CEO following the sacking of Mike Nghipunya, who is awaiting trial.

Nghipunya is charged alongside former fisheries minister Bernhard Esau, ex-

minister of justice Sackey Shanghala, former Investec Asset Management Namibia managing director James Hataikulipi, Esau's son-in-law Tamson Hataikulipi and Pius 'Taxa' Mwatelulo for allegedly channelling payments totalling N\$75.6 million to themselves or entities of their choice from Fishcor.

The money allegedly went through Celax Investment Number One and the law firm De Klerk, Horn & Coetzee Inc.

The funds were allegedly laundered between August 2014 and December 2019.

Nghipunya and his co-accused are facing three counts, including fraud, contravening the Anti-Corruption Act and corruptly using office for gratification, as well as money

laundering. Gaomab could not give the number of candidates who have applied for Nghipunya's position.

'We are not able to divulge fully the list and number of those employed, as we are busy compiling the long list of all those who are employed. We can only state that there was an immense interest in the CEO position and we shall communicate earnestly as the recruitment and selection process unfolds in line with the human resource policy of Fishcor and its subsidiaries,' he said.

He added the board met on 14 January and is in process of shortlisting potential candidates for interviews, psychometric assessment and vetting that will take place next month. - edeklerk@nepc.com.na

According to State prosecutor Precious Matali, the prosecutor general requested prosecution to compile three of Babi's cases currently on the court's roll for her to consider making a joint decision.

Ananias, alongside Babi, were facing bribery charges for allegedly offering investigating officers N\$13 000.

The investigating officers were tasked to investigate Babi's first case, where he is facing charges of being in possession of two rhino horns, a firearm and ammunition without a licence.

During court proceedings yesterday, magistrate Linus Samunzala withdrew the charges against Ananias and ordered his release from police custody. Babi, in his second case, is charged alongside Frizans Naululu Dumeni.

They were arrested in May and form part of the group that was found to be in possession of rhino horns.

According to police reports at the time, the group of eight men includes a police officer from the VIP protection directorate.

The prosecution is charging the accused with counts of possessing or dealing in two rhino horns, hunting a rhinoceros that is protected by law and possessing a hunting rifle and

ammunition without a licence.

Prosecution claims Babi and Dumeni were in possession or dealt in two rhino horns at Babi's residence in Kleine Kuppe in Windhoek on 26 and 27 May. It is alleged the much-sought horns are linked to the poaching of two rhinos found dead and with their horns removed in the area of Gobabis in May.

According to court records, Babi has a third case in Gobabis Magistrate's Court, where he faces charges of illegal hunting of specially protected game in the Gobabis district.

Babi is scheduled to appear in court on 16 April for the prosecutor general's decision.

She appealed to parents and guardians to do the enrolments as early as possible to avoid such challenges.

'I had to send more than 300 parents away, as they came way too late while enrolment is usually announced during May,' she said.

Gawises also explained they have 90 grade 8 learners on their waiting list.

'Apart from that, all our schools at the town are ready to start the new

school year today, apart from JP Brandt at Utuseb. This is due to renovation of the school's hostel that is currently ongoing,' she said.

She added 90% of the learners are accommodated in the hostel; hence, it did not make sense to open the school when learners do not have accommodation.

Alternatives

Meanwhile, education director for Erongo Erenfriede Stephanus yesterday said they are looking at

an alternative venue to accommodate the 143 learners.

'I am meeting with Gawises today (yesterday) to look at our options, as some of the venues are too pricey,' she said.

She added this will be a temporary arrangement, as they are currently constructing classrooms that will be completed by April this year.

'Then we will be able to move all the learners back to the respective schools,' she said.
