SUBJECT: ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE FOR THE PROPOSED MUZINE FUEL RETAIL FACILITY ON PORTION A / 72 OF THE FARM TOWNLANDS NO.114, GOBABIS, OMAHEKE REGION.

The Environmental Impact Assessment and Environmental Management Plan submitted are sufficient as these have made an adequate provision of the environmental management for the proposed activities. From this perspective regular environmental monitoring and evaluations on environmental performance should be conducted. Targets for improvements should be established and monitored throughout the process.

This Ministry reserves the right to attach further legislative and regulatory conditions during the construction and operational phase of the project. I issue this Clearance with the following condition: All relevant permitting authority must be properly consulted and written consent obtained prior to the commencement of the proposed development. Moreover, the Gobabis Municipality should oversee the implementation of the project. The Empty oil cans, oil tins, oil containers and other automotive products be discarded at a designated hazardous dumping /land fill sites and a proof be kept.

On the basis of the above, this letter serves as an environmental clearance for the project to commence. However, this clearance letter does not in anyway hold the Ministry of Environment and Tourism accountable for misleading information, nor any adverse effects that may arise from this project's activities. Instead, full accountability rests with the proponent and his/her consultants.

This environmental clearance is valid for a period of 3 (three) years, from the date of issue unless withdrawn by this office.
