INTRODUCTION

Atlantic Logistix has identified the need for mine chemicals and supplies in mines around Walvisbay and Swakopmund, and the rest of the Erongo region. This has thus necessitated transportation of hazardous of chemicals over long distances more frequently because of the nexus between & the growing number of mining operation within the area and well as the need for chemicals in the mining Industry, especially Uranium mining. In this respect, the proponent has taken on a venture to operate a chemicals storage facility in Walvisbay town to ease logistical and financial costs in supply and demand for mining chemicals nearby.

In this respect Junior Baiano Industrial Consultants (JBIC) cc is to carry out an Environmental Assessment study to obtain an environmental clearance certificate as per the requirements of the Ministry of Mines and Energy and the Ministry of Environment and Tourism in terms of hazardous substances storage facilities.

The study will incorporate biophysical, ecological and socio-economic baseline investigations relating to the proposed project. In terms of the Namibian environmental Impact Assessment Regulations of 2012, an Environmental Clearance Certificate is to be obtained before the project can proceed.

- Review the legal and policy framework and its relevance to this project;
- Describe general and socio-economic environment of the project to determine impacts and suitability to the project site.
- Identify and assess impacts related to the continued operations.
- Compile an Assessment Report and Management Plan (EMP) which includes recommendations and methods to minimize the identified negative environmental impacts of the proposed project.
- To identify existing environmental conditions and associated environmental sensitivities within and adjacent to the project area that may potentially be affected, i.e. Environmental sensitivity and monitoring procedures.

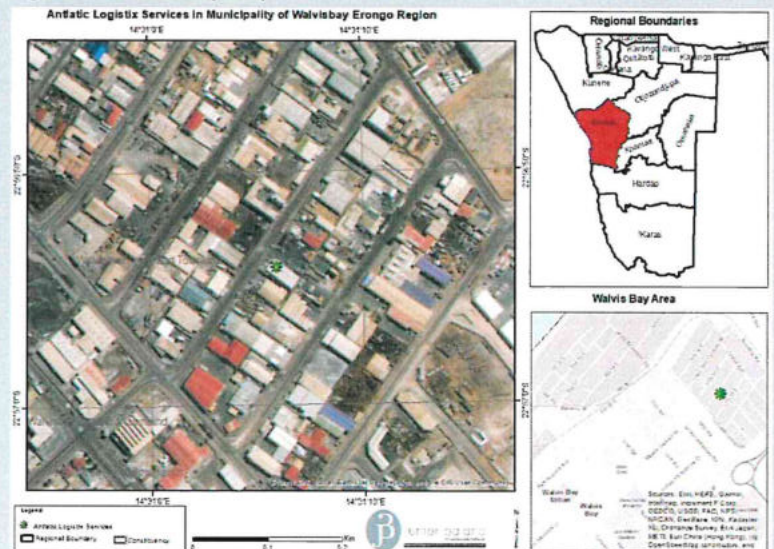
