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1. INTRODUCTION

Public Participation Process (PPP) is an integral part of the EIA process as outlined in Section of 27(1) (h) of the Environmental Management Act and Section 32 of the Environmental Assessment Regulations. One of the objectives of the Scoping Assessment for this development was to identify key stakeholders so as to involve them in the EIA process.

Generally, the PPP is a platform which affords an opportunity to stakeholders, statutory stakeholders and interested and affected parties (IAPs) to participate in the EIA process for the envisaged development. During the PPP, such stakeholders are given an opportunity to express their views, provide comments and/or to voice any concerns which they might have with regard to the proposed development. In broader terms, the objectives of the PPP are the following:

- To increase awareness and public confidence and in so doing to maximize benefits and minimise risks.
- To ensure transparence and accountability in decision-making hence less conflict, since decisions are deemed to have been made through consensus.
- To secure approval from stakeholders which gives some form of assurance and a sense of partnership with the promoters of the proposed development and prevents unnecessary disputes and costs associated with litigations

2. PROJECT DESCRIPTION & LOCATION

Erongo Petroleum CC (or '**EPC'**, for short) is proposing to develop a bulk liquid fuel storage and handling facility on Erf 5022 situated on Ben Amathila Street, in the industrial section of Walvis Bay. The proposed facility will have a designed capacity of 24 000 m³ and will handle one single product - automotive diesel oil (ADO) stored in six aboveground storage tanks.

Over two hundred fishing vessels of different sizes and capacities are operating in the local fishing sector, catching marine products and docking at factory jetties to offload. During the offloading, the fishing boat is refuelled and replenished with supplies. Refuelling involves road tankers carting fuel from the depot to the factory jetty terminal where the boat is anchored. Depending on the boat size, multiple trips are often made by road tankers to complete refuelling. This activity alone has several undesirable environmental impacts – traffic congestion on Ben Amathila Street, noise pollution and increased exhaust emissions leading to the already elevated ambient atmospheric emission levels in the harbour town.

The proposed development will function as a one-stop refuelling point for fishing vessels. Instead of road tankers carting fuel into the factory, the fishing boat simply docks at the fuel jetty terminal where it is refuelled and replenished with fresh supplies. This can be done before the fishing boat docks at its home jetty to offload its catch or soon after offloading. The project is therefore needed and indeed, desirable.

The development will be made on the premises of a fishing factory which has been in operation for many years. It is therefore a brownfield development involving demolition of an old wooden jetty and replacing it with a concrete one. Several redundant building structures will also be demolished to make way for the bulk liquid fuel storage and handling facility.




Figure 1: Project Location Map

The project site is depicted in Fig. 1.

INTRODUCTION

Erongo Petroleum CC (the promotor) is proposing to develop a Bulk Liquid Fuel Storage and Handling Facility and has appointed **Ekwao Consulting** (Ekwao) to attend to the environmental services of the project, while **Seal Consulting Engineers** (SCE) handles all engineering facets of the project, from design to management of all related construction activities.

PROJECT LOCATION




Figure 1: Project Site

The project will be developed on Erf 5022, Ben Amathila Street, Walvis Bay, Erongo Region as more or less depicted in **Fig. 1**

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project entails the development of a Bulk Liquid Fuel Storage and Handling Facility with a designed capacity of 24 million litres. These construction activities will be involved:

- Demolition of an existing timber jetty and replacing it with a concrete jetty able to dock tanker vessels.
- A product conveying pipeline from the quay to the tank farm with a total length of about 200 m. Across the jetty section, the conveying pipeline will run in a sleeve buried in concrete while the rest of the pipeline will be partly underground (road crossings) and partly overland.
- Construction of a tank farm consisting of six tanks, each tank with a diameter of 17.5 m and a height of 16.8 m. The tank farm will have a footprint of ±3 330 m² which is about 65% of the total land area making up Erf 5022.
- Upon completion of the construction activities, day-to-day operation and routine maintenance of the bulk liquid fuel storage and handling facility in line with industry practices and standards.

EIA OBJECTIVE

The objective of the EIA is to identify potential negative and positive impacts associated with the envisaged development. Where negative impacts are identified, to provide management measure on how such impacts may be eliminated, avoided or minimised to acceptable levels. Where positive impacts are anticipated, to provide measures to enhance such positive benefits to accrue to the broader society.

The EIA will be conducted in full compliance of the provisions of the Environmental Management Act (Act No. 7 of 2007) and EIA regulations as gazetted.

PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT

This BID is intended to provide information related to the proposed development to stakeholders – government agencies as well as Interested and Affected Parties (IAPs). In this regard, an invitation is extended to IAPs to register for the EIA in order to receive information on the project and to participate in the EIA process by providing inputs, comments or to voice any concerns which they might have with respect to the development.







