Meanwhile, AmaZulu stretched their winless run to four matches in the league when they were held to a 1-1 draw by SuperSport United away on Wednesday.

The result left Umtshu placed 10th on the league standings - three points behind eighth-placed Baroka.

Renee McCarthy, the AmaZulu head coach, was disappointed to see his side dominate the game against SuperSport without taking their chances, but he said they will continue to fight.

"I think it's too easy that when you throw away points like these no one will take accountability for it," McCarthy

said. "So yeah and your job becomes as difficult. In the Bloemfontein Celtic [game] it was the same situation, Kater Chib, Maitama United, and today [against SuperSport] same problem. "I don't want AmaZulu to be known for this, but we dominate games but we get one point. I think we have to keep fighting."

Playerns Who's Baroka FC Gerard Phiri Jr: The attacking midfielder netted his second score goal of the season in the win over Saldanha in what was his third start in the league this term. Phiri will be confident of leading his side to their second successive win.

Bidane Malingoza: The promising centre forward was in good scoring form against Saldanha as he grabbed a brace, before providing an assist when he set up Phiri Jr. Malingoza will be eager to maintain his good form at home.

AmaZulu FC Luvuyo Memele: The influential playmaker grabbed his maiden assist of the season when he set up Siphile Mibemba for AmaZulu's goal against SuperSport. Memele has the ability to single-handedly inspire AmaZulu to a win.

Siphile Mibemba: The experienced centre forward is returning with confidence after scoring his first-ever goal for AmaZulu in the draw with SuperSport. Mibemba will be hungry for goals when he faces Baroka in Polokwane.

Al Ahly, Sundowns set for heavyweight Caf Champions League tussle

Al Ahly and Mamelodi Sundowns will meet in what promises to be an enthralling 2020-21 Caf Champions League quarterfinal first-leg tie at Al-Salam Stadium in Cairo on Saturday evening.

Kick-off is at 9pm CAT (SA, GMT+2).

The Champions League holders will be slight favourites despite finishing second behind Simba in Group A, while they currently sit four points adrift of Egyptian Premier League leaders Zamalek, albeit having played two games less. This has put pressure on Pitso Mosimane who will be eager not to lose against his former employers.

Al Ahly won a record-extending ninth Champions League crown last season a mere month after South Africa's Mosimane took over the reins in the Egyptian capital and as fate will have it, he will now come to blows against Sundowns for a place in the final four.

Mosimane spent eight successful years at Sundowns during which he led them to 2016 Champions League glory. He was also in charge of the only Brazilian team to beat Al Ahly, a famous 5-0 win at Lucas Moripe



Stadium which helped pave the way for a move to Africa's most successful club.

"Sundowns is a good team, I created a monster and it's coming to bite me but it's okay, that's football. I saw Pep [Guardiola] playing against Barcelona when he was at Bayern Munich and he lost to Barcelona - I hope I don't lose to

Sundowns," said Mosimane.

Sundowns eased into the quarterfinals as Group B winners and made the trip to Cairo having moved ever closer to a another league title.

That said, the Brazilians' coaching trident of Rullani Molweni, Mangoba Mngqithi and Steve Khephela face their toughest assignment yet in the

shape of Al Ahly.

"Al Ahly are a very good side. Well-coached, and you can see there is a lot of investment from the technical team," Sundowns co-coach Molweni said. "In particular, of course, coach Pitso. We know the amount of work he puts in behind the scenes.

"You can see because it's reflected

in the team, they also have a clear identity and look to start from the back using their centre-halfs.

"It is clear to see that maybe in comparison to the profile of some teams that we face in the PSL, they average about 40 crosses into the box per 90 minutes, so they're very dominant in their wing play.

"It will be an interesting game, and of course, we've got the responsibility to come to Egypt (and) just dominate on the pitch," he added.

This will be the ninth clash between the Egyptian and South African clubs with the Red Devils winning four, drawing three and being one of the previous encounters.

Al Ahly are set to be without the influential Ali Mashaal for the first leg but he will reportedly be fit for the re-encounter in Atteridgeville on 22 May.

Sundowns are expected to welcome back Themba Zwane and Siphele Mthembu after they missed the club's most recent league fixture due to injury and suspension respectively.

The aggregate winner of the match between Al Ahly and Sundowns will face either CR Belouezzouar or Espérance de Tunis for a place in the final. SUPERSPORTS
