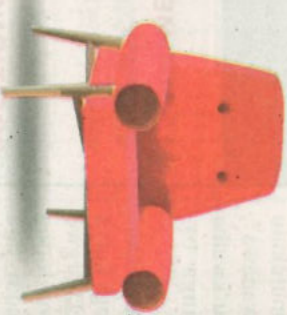

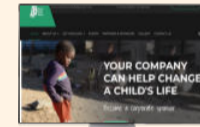

ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING ASSESSMENT (ESA) FOR THE PROPOSED SMALL-SCALE MINING ACTIVITIES ON MINING CLAIMS NO.75078 - 75087, LOCATED WEST OF FRANSPONTEIN, KUNENE REGION.

Date: Thursday, 08 February 2024

Time: 10H00-11H00

The public consultation meeting was attended by 16 people, including an Environmental Consultant and an Archaeologist from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS) - **Please refer to the attached attendance register.**

1. INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

Mr. Mandume Leonard (Environmental Consultant) opened the meeting with an introduction of the team, who they are, and the purpose as to why they are consulting affected parties for the proposed small-scale mining activities on Mining Claims No.75078 - 75087. The meeting attendance register was then circulated for the attendees to write down their names, contact details and to sign so that they can be added to the list of Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) and to receive further information on the ESA process.

2. MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

2.1 Brief Description of the Project

Mr. Mandume Leonard explained the Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) and the reason why the Proponent appointed Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS), an independent Environmental Consultant to carry out the ESA and apply for the Environmental Clearance certificate (ECC).

2.2 Explanation of what an ESA is, its Process, and the Public Role in the Process

Mr. Leonard explained to the attendees what the meeting was all about and why they were invited (with reference to the Environmental Management Act (EMA) No. 7 of 2007 and its 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations on Public Consultation). Mr. Leonard further explained what an ESA is, and that the proposed small-scale mining activities are one of the listed activities in the 2012 EIA Regulations of the EMA that cannot be undertaken without an ECC from the Environmental Commissioner.

2.3 Presentation of Potential Project Impacts

To ensure transparency and that the attendees understand both sides of the proposed project activities, the Environmental Consultant also presented the potential pre-identified potential positive & negative environmental and social impacts.

2.4 Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session)

Mr. Leonard provided the meeting attendees the opportunity to raise their concerns/issues and or comment on the proposed project activities. The issues and comments recorded are presented in **Table 1** below.

Table 1: Comments and issues raised during the public consultation meeting, 08th February 2024.

Comment/ issue No.	Commenter name & issue/comment/question	Response and name of responder:
1.	Commenter 1: At what phase is the mining process on the MCs?	Mr. Mandume Leonard (ML): Currently, there are no mining activities taking place on the tenement. The proponent, appointed EDS as an independent Consultant to apply for an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) from the Ministry of Environment, Forestry, and Tourism (MEFT) on behalf of the Proponent. Once an ECC is granted for this project, the Proponent can commence work on the MCs.
2.	Commenter 1: The reason for asking the current phase of the project, is because people were mining in our area, and they did not employ the locals, instead they took people from Khorixas and some other places.	Mr. ML: Noted, Sir. We will recommend to the Proponent that employment of the unskilled and semi-skilled workers in the vicinity of the project should be prioritized.
3.	Commenter 2: How many years is an ECC valid?	Mr. ML: An ECC is valid for three (3) years and after that, it will need to be renewed.
4.	Commenter 3: The area covered by the MCs as shown on the map, is located within our animal's grazing area. What will happen to our animals as they will be affected, will we be compensation for that?	Mr. ML: Thank you, for the comment and question sir. The disturbance to the grazing area will be measured and mitigated to ensure that the mining activities have little impact on the grazing area. For example, the Proponent is not allowed to remove grass or trees from the area of no interest. Also after excavating the area of interest, the Proponent must backfill the trenches and any drilling holes to allow the grass to grow back.

Comment/ issue No.	Commenter name & issue/comment/question	Response and name of responder:
		In terms of compensation, if the proponent is granted an ECC, the Proponent will consult with the affected communities, for a land access agreement, where the Proponent will play part in the Corporate Social Responsibility (CRS) duties. Either, to compensate directly or to do something for the community; for example, building or upgrading the road in the area, or drilling water boreholes for the community.
5.	Commenter 4: Will the Proponent use dynamites?	Mr. ML: Depending on what they are going to mine and the type of mining methods they will employ, they may or may not use the dynamites.
6.	Commenter 5: Meaning that an agreement between the Proponent and the land users can only be drawn when the Proponent acquires an ECC?	Mr. ML: Yes, however, the process does not always guarantee that the Proponent will acquire an ECC, the Ministry may reject the granting of the ECC for the proposed project, due to various reasons.

FINAL REMARKS AND CONCLUSION OF THE MEETING

Mr. Mandume Leonard thanked the attendees for their crucial input by giving comments and raising their concerns. He indicated to the attendees that all their comments, concerns, and inputs have been noted down for consideration and will be addressed in the Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) Report and respective their recommendations/ mitigation measures will be incorporated in the EMP draft.

Furthermore, Mr. Mandume Leonard informed the attendees that the meeting minutes draft, Environmental Assessment Report, and Environmental Management Plan (EMP) will be shared with the stakeholders to review and to give comments. These documents will be made shared through the emails provided on the attendance register.

Once the review of the drafts (ESA Report and EMP) is done, the documents will be finalized and submitted to the Environmental Commissioner, Department of Environmental Affairs and Forestry (DEAF) for evaluation and consideration of an ECC.

The meeting adjourned at 11h00.
