Kuku Ngombe momalyenge okwa kala mo uule woomvula dhi li po20 molwashoka aakalimo oya kala ye wete kutya oku na uupyakadhi 'uukumithi' mboka ye wete wu na ekwatathano lyuulodhi.

"Omolwomaitaalo, okwaanakonasha osho wo okukala kaaye shi kutya opu na uupyakadhi hawu vulu okukwata omuntu pamadhiladhilo osho wo okukala kaaye shi omandhindhiliko guupyakadhi mboka, meme Ngombe okwa kala a talika ko ongomuntu a nika oshiponga nonkene okwa li ye mu tula momalyenge," osho Holtzhausen a popi ngaaka mOmaandaha pethimbo lye tyapulo lyoomvula omulongo dhemanguluko lya kuku Ngombe.

INTRODUCTION

In terms of Section 21 of the EIA Regulations a call for open consultation with all I&APs at defined stages of the EIA process is required. This entails participatory consultation with members of the public by providing an opportunity to comment on the proposed project. A public consultation meeting was convened on 13 January 2023 for this purpose, it was subsequently felt that another meeting be held directly with the Topnaar community as the directly affected community. This meeting was arranged through the Office of the Governor of Erongo Region and took place on 08 November 2023.

WELCOMING

The Acting Chief Stoffel Anamab welcomed everyone to the meeting.
Mr. Gaingob opened the meeting and introduced the purpose of the meeting.
Introductions were made.

SUMMARY OF WELCOMING REMARKS BY CHIEF ANAMAB

- Welcome to everyone especially the Governor's office, as well as the proponent.
- The leadership of Topnaar Traditional Authority serves as the eyes of the community. Their goal is the upliftment and development of the community.
- These types of visits by investors create a lot of expectations. When someone brings business into your area you expect something. You want to know how the community will benefit.
- We therefore hope the message will come out clear on how we will benefit and the way forward.
- We await with anticipation the outcome of the meeting.
- Feel free to express yourself.

ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT

Mr. Shippiki provided a background on the Proposed Hope & Gorob Mining Project for ML 246 on EPL 5796 in the Namib Naukluft National Park, and that an environmental clearance is required before such a development can proceed. He further explained the environmental assessment (EA) process and the reasons why EAs are carried out.

The attendees were also informed about the public participation process that has taken place so far, including newspaper advertisements, public notices on site, and individual communication to adjacent property owners and other pre-identified Interested and Affected Parties. Information was given on the components of the development touching on aspects such as the locality, design, engineering services and access.

Potential environmental concerns were provided to the attendees, while urging them to contribute any other impacts that they foresee this development will have on the environment. 
