- The ground level gradient is too steep from the sewerage line north to the flood plain area. This results in a yearly ground erosion that occurs overnight in the rainy seasons - and can be seen as a very serious point when it comes to erven being put in these areas, as this will affect the safety of people staying in these areas.
- These floodplains levels are a stone throw away from Ngandu Safari lodge and to consolidate any erven here will have a huge impact on the fauna and flora flourishing in these areas. HOW RUNDU IS LOSING ITS TOURISTS LED POTENTIAL

(by Patrick Hilger co-author with DECOSA on the Kavango regions LED study)

In 2016 over 1.3 MIO visited Namibia ! of which 40-50 % are **Holiday tourists** of an age group where **52 % are above 40+** (for those from overseas 20 % are around 40 to 49 and 30 % 50 to 60 +)

Only 12.2% of holiday tourist visiting Namibia come to Kavango (2013 MCA Tourist Exit Survey). This was around **50 000 per year** (in 2013 KRC LED study) (I assuming this to be at least 65 000 in 2016).

On top of this, those coming, they only stay one night and those coming to Rundu are only half of those. **Meaning only 6 % stop in Rundu for a day, or 94 % of all visitors to Namibia NEVER spend time in Rundu !** .In comparison Lüderitz (which is far and on a one-way road get's 16.6% of the tourist visiting Namibia and Etosha gets 53% of all visitors !)

Meaning 87.8% never come to Kavango. We could easily increase visitors for Kavango to 24.2 % or 100 000 **and** make them stay two days instead of one day through better advertisement, tourism route development and making our town culturally attractive and "green" . As per the latest exit survey, tourist visitors **spend in average N\$ 1840 per day** (food, accommodation, car rentals, activities etc) and **stay 12 -18 nights in Namibia**, so targeting 2 days out of this is possible, by branding the region better.

From the 12.2 % coming to Kavango only around 6 % actually stop and overnight and spend money in Rundu town (based on the fact that only 50 % of tourist lodges are here and the rest, around 12 are far outside town...not taking into account the occupancy rates from leisure tourism as most are in fact business overnights). So the reality is that the tourists currently **spend a maximum of 92 MIO** per year in Kavango (number x average spending) **but could spend 180 MIO** (based on a better achievable 22.4 %) and **360 MIO if they would stay 2 nights** (and represent 22.4%). **Rundu as a whole only gets a maximum of 46 MIO of this share**, which is not reaching the general public or youth as there are no craft markets in town or incentives to stay a day longer for visiting, no tour guides can make a living if residing in a dirty town floodplain, **occupancy rates for leisure tourism are low (below 22% in average !)** and employment in the tourist sector few and unsecure as a result.

The neglect of a Rundu to become an attractive town and have a protected wetland waterfront, costs the sector and town 314 MIO per year of potential income which is

As per the Mapp received we are directly affected by environmental and social impacts of the planned consolidation. Currently as per the Status quo report of the Wetland send in previous communications **the current environmental destruction of all sites along the earmarked wetland portions are a major concern** and the locations of most earmarked Ervens, especially those as marked under "Hospitality" need *guidance on what and at which scale*.so they add value and not more problems in terms of noise pollution, alcohol abuse, sewage, or erosion. We strongly advice to FIRST protect the area BEFORE allocating plots as RUNDU has one of the lowest national occupy rate and the attraction as a town is very poor to justify more rooms. Currently of all visitors (and that is even prior to COVID) only 6 % stop in Rundu meaning 94 % DON'T BOTHER (those are statistics from MCA and MTE Surveys and the Kavango LED study) see my attached summary send in the previous communications. We thus need to FIRST get the figures right and have the wetland cleaned and secured and reduce motorized access as per the initial RTC strategic plan) Occupany rates prior to 2020 was already less than 22 % well below the national 45% . More beds or rooms with less to offer and a destroyed environment, cut trees, dumping of waste and noise pollution will chase the last visitors and destroy the industry completely. Lets keep the Rundu beach to the Ekongoro lake well maintained like the Swakopmund promenade beach side. Only allowing low density residential development and if for hospitality, with a maximum of 12 rooms to reduce the impact. The Wetland can also not become an uncontrolled bar/shebeen and dumping place creating a national embarrassment reducing visitors figures even below 2020-21.

The tourist and visitors have the following reasons to visit as per the Namibian Tourist exit survey for 2013. **1. Wildlife, 2. Scenery, 3. Culture, 4. Sense of Space, 4. Diversity and 5 Tranquility** Those are the income generating targets Rundu needs to find and combine in harmony.



If we don't get those top 5 reasons right we will have more unemployment than before

As per the Rundu Structure plan, **Development in the Wetland fringes can only take place in an extremely controlled way**, that accounts for flooding, safe disposal of sewage water (thus the limited number of new rooms) and does not detract from the natural beauty of the area.

The portion 1 and 2 are too close to the main Namwater pipe lines **and will block the planned expansion of namwater pipes**. The first proponent started illegal cutting of trees in 2016 (he was blocked after in 2019 as no EIA was done), as a result erosion became a serious issue. The process of allocating Erven was also not transparent and open. The area was initially earmarked as a park, or could be used as a permaculture training center teaching the youth on sustainable gardening techniques.

There is MAJOR Danger of Erosion if more cutting of trees is allowed here



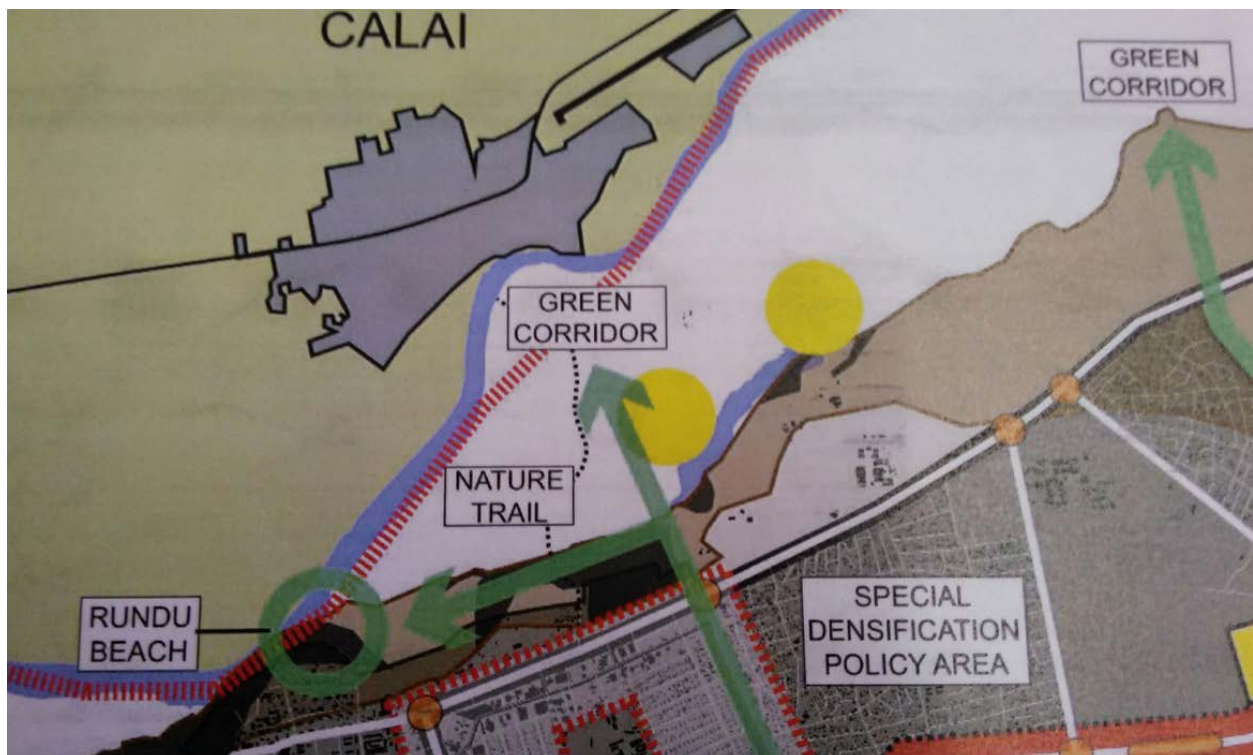

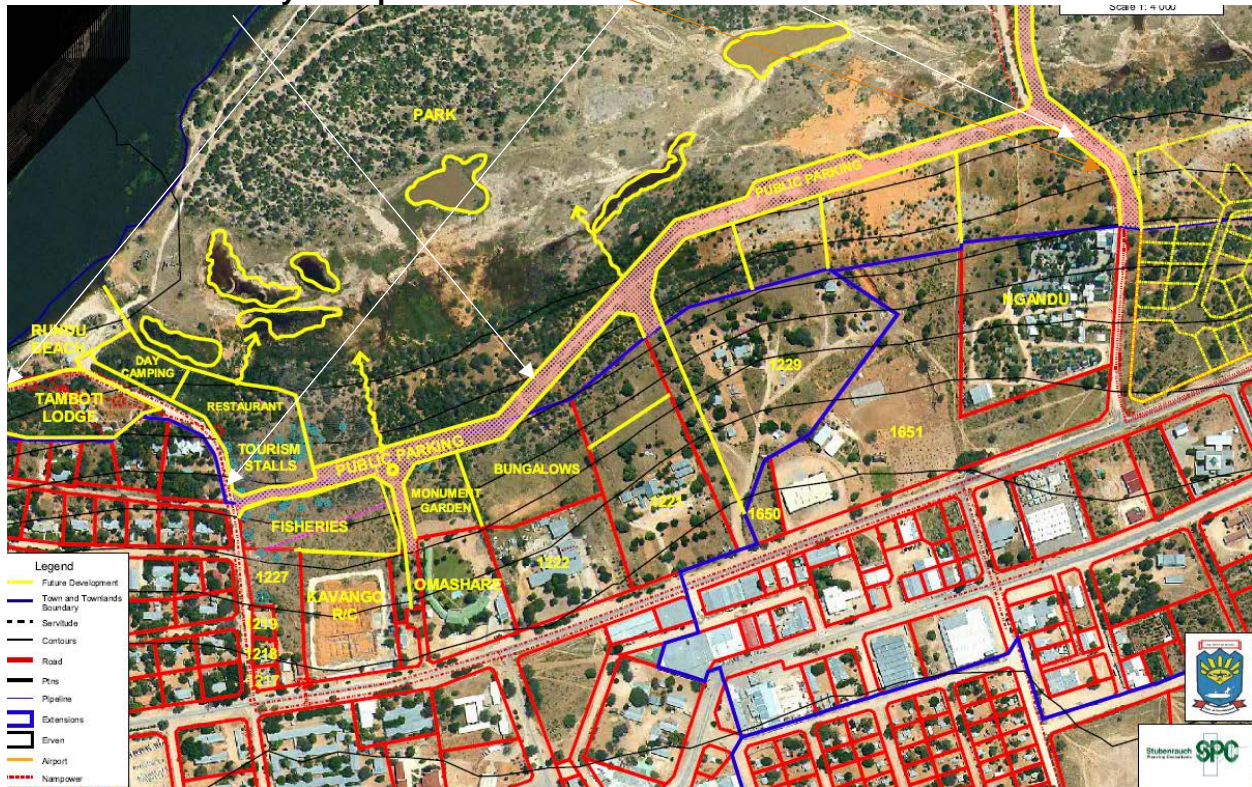
- The only attraction of Rundu which is the tranquillity and charm of the Kavango wetland will be destroyed forever if Not well planned (only low density residential development should be promoted with soft areas such as camping, tourist craft markets, training center in urban agriculture/permaculture, Aquaculture, fish breeding, tourguiding, boating, horse riding etc)
- Sewage is a main problem as the proposed 1 and 2 Ervens are below the sewage line and as such new development need to make provision not to have more negative impacts on the flood plains. The area is BELOW the sewage line, thus putting more pressure in the system and putting into danger the whole area.
- The process was not open and transparent as selected individuals got hands on ervens from the previous council without following any guidelines. It is recommended that the EIA report must be followed and shared first and any development is to be monitored.by a steering committee



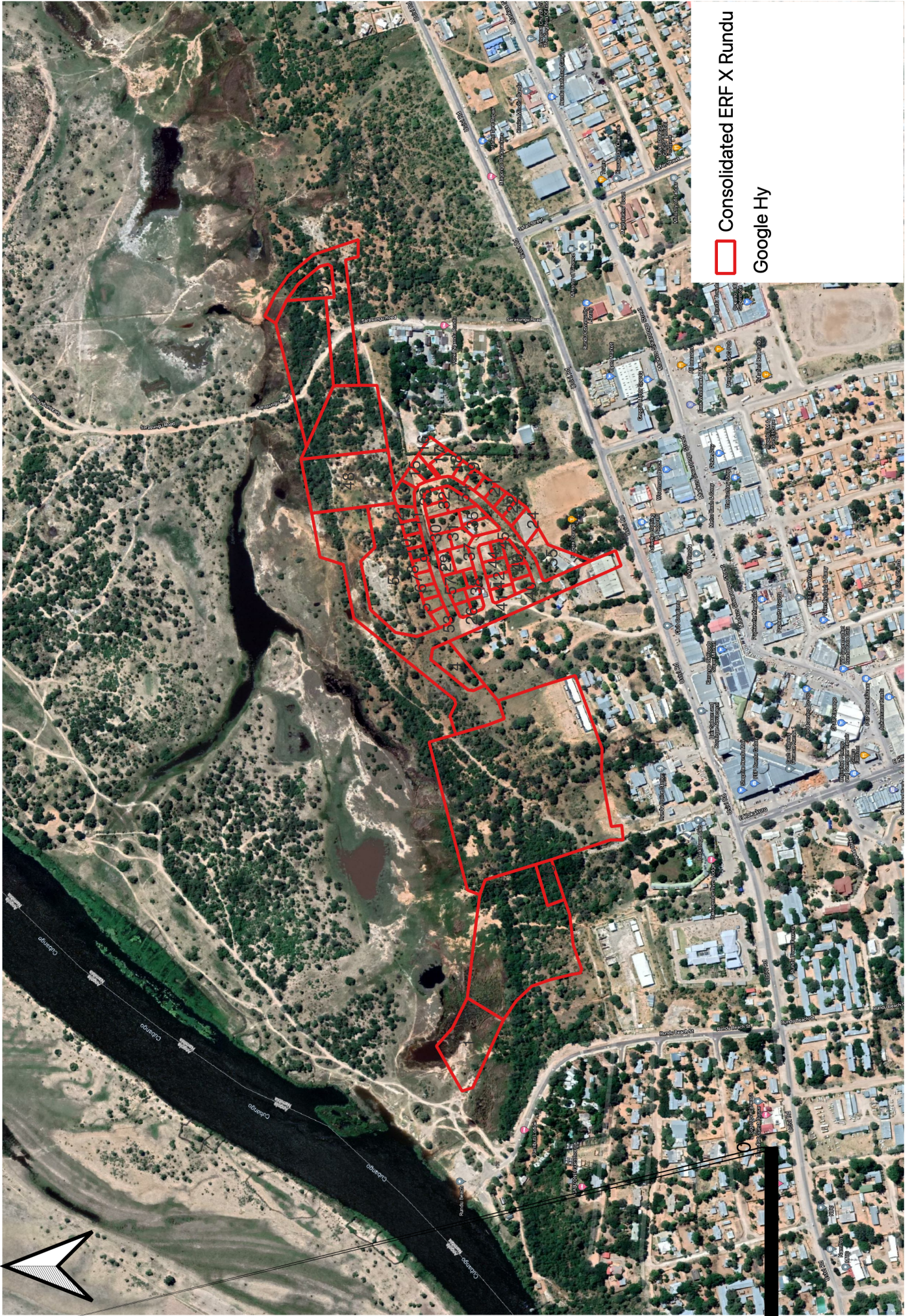

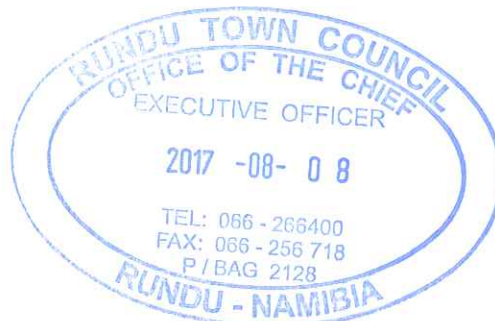
