RENEWAL OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE FOR THE OPERATION OF THE EXISTING TREK SERVICE STATION, TSUMEB, OSHIKOTO REGION.

ENGEN Namibia (Pty) Ltd is a leading marketer of liquid fuels and lubricants in the country. The company has invested in a number of retail fuel facilities across the country. In terms of the Environmental Management Act 7 of 2007 (Government Notice No. 29), certain activities may not be undertaken without an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC). This activity is included in the above-mentioned list.

An ECC was applied for and obtained for this facility. The ECC is valid for a period of three (3) years and has subsequently expired. Engen appointed Environam Consultants Trading (ECT) to apply for the renewal of the ECC on its behalf.

The Environmental Clearance Certificate System requires that a copy of the previously issued ECC be uploaded. We have been informed by our client that the consultant who was contracted to apply for the initial ECC could not provide all of the documentation to our client, including the ECC one for this site.

It is however our understanding that your office would still have records of those previously issued ECCs and that you will proceed to consider this application for renewal without the uploaded certificate.
