**In accordance with:** Review of Heritage Impact Assessment conducted on Exclusive Prospecting Licence (EPL) 6959 for the exploration of Nuclear Fuel minerals. It is located approximately 20km south-west of Usakos, Erongo Region.

*The following conditions (imposed in terms of Section 55(9) of the Act.) apply to this permit:*

- a) Consent should only be granted for farm Namibfontein no.91 in EPL 6959.
- b) Farms Vergenoeg no.92, Namib Plaas no.93, Wolfkoppe no.105, Bergrus no.94, Tswasis no.16, Stinkbank no.62, and Gross Aukas no.68 should be excluded from any exploration activities until a full survey is carried out on these farms.
- c) A buffer zone of 100m radius is to be created and maintained around the historical mine.
- d) As per Section 55 (9) (a) the activity authorised by this consent is to be supervised by a person with appropriate professional qualifications or experience in the identification and conservation of heritage.
- e) The consent holder is to report back to the National Heritage Council every six (6) months on compliance with the conditions of this consent.
- f) This Consent does not exempt the holder from any conditions that may be imposed by owners, hosts or any other relevant authorities in consultation with NHC who have a stake in the project area.

- g) NHC shall not be liable for any losses, damages or injuries to persons or properties as a result of any activities related to this permit.
- h) This Consent is subject to the provisions of the National Heritage Act (Act 27 of 2004). Should any of the conditions contained herein conflict with the Act; the provisions of the Act as per Section 55 (10) shall prevail.
- i) Adoption of the Chance Find Procedures are mandatory.
- j) This consent is renewable, upon submission of an application at least two months before the current permit lapses
