- h. A desktop research may be sufficient for EPL's, however NHC reserve the right to request for detailed Scoping including field survey should need arise that areas are to be sampled as well as for all mining claims.


- i. Once significant findings of minerals are found, a full field survey should be conducted as per the proposed specialist report
