PERMISSION FOR THE REMOVAL OF SAND FROM THE FISH RIVER AT MARIENTAL. KACHAS INDUSTRIAL T/A SUPERSAND

- 1. Your letter dated 18 October 2021, in the above-mentioned regard, refers.
- 2. Kindly be informed that Kachas Industrial T/A Supersand was issued with a permission for the removal of sand from the Fish River at Mariental by this Ministry.
- 3. Please take note that the Water Resources Management Act 11 of 2013 and related Regulations makes provision for the removal of sand from rivers and this legislation will commence soon.
- 4. As soon as the above-mentioned comes into effect, the permission that was issued to Kachas Industrial T/A Supersand will be renewed and therefore there will be no interference from our side with the current operations of the said company.
- 5. The operations are however still subjected to the following conditions:
 - 5.1 No sand mining is conducted or permitted between the dam wall and the cement weir 4.2 km downstream from the dam wall.
 - 5.2 Removal of islands and sand banks within the riverbed/channel only. No sand mining on the banks of the river, or in a manner which may divert or slow down the flow of water in the Fish River during floods or water releases from the Hardap Dam.
 - 5.3 Mining of sand islands which pose the greatest flood risk first.

All official correspondence must be addressed to the Executive Director

- 5.4 Mining to be conducted in a systematic approach at a specific depth and width to prevent new blockages being formed or holes being made. The improved flow of water in the river remains the main consideration.
- 5.5 No mining deeper than the original depth of the river (prior to the building of the Hardap Dam) will be conducted. Consideration is given to a 1972 riverbed survey.
