2.1 Harvesting activities for sustainable bush control:

- > Determining bush density per hectare through proper bush count methods;
- Determining stem thickness of harvestable bush species, including the best choice of harvesting methods and equipment – measured against productivity throughput requirements;

- ➤ Application of production efficiency methods for maximum outputs, as well as ensuring quality assurance of bush-based products;
- Application of approaches and methods that ensure effective environmental management.

2.3 Training of wood harvesters

> Training of wood harvesters in all aspects ranging from sustainable bush harvesting, processing of wood biomass, wood pyrolysis, efficiency in charcoal production, product quality assurance and effective environmental management.

2.4 Marketing of biofuels and other bush-based products

Marketing of biofuels (*lump charcoal, compressed wood pellets and charcoal briquettes*) to international markets through export, as well as wood chips and animal feed on the domestic market.
