Namibia Wildlife Resorts (NWR) is a state-owned enterprise, mandated to run the tourism facilities within the protected areas of Namibia. NWR has several operations across the country which are owned and managed by NWR. Title of Activity:

Nature of Activity:

Mile 108 is located approximately 108 km north of Hentiesbaai, along the western coast of Namibia. The campsite is located on the beach within the Dorob National Park.

Mile 108 is a camping recreational facility that offers leisure facilities such as fishing, sun-bathing etc. There are tourist attractions in the surrounding areas such as Seal watching at Cape Cross or visiting the Dead Sea and the dunes. The resort includes 5 Fisherman Chalets and campsites in terms of accommodation facilities. The facility is only operational from 1st December to 31 January of each year.

The facility was constructed prior to the commencement of the Environmental Management Act (EMA) (7 of 2007). As such, an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) was never conducted for the facility. However, the facility is still required to comply with the provisions of the EMA and its regulations and is a listed activity as per Activity 6.
