This was partly due to lower fuel prices, after petrol and diesel prices were lowered at the start of September. STAFF REPORTER

er price inflation cooled to 7.5% in Septem-ber from 7.6% in August, which was slightly better than economists

Still, it's clear that South Africans ue to suffer from eye watering price increases.

Annual food and non-alcoholic bev erage inflation increased to 11.9% from 11.3% in August, with bread and cereal prices up 19.3% from a year before – the biggest increase in 13 years. Still, Statistics South Africa says that food prices are showing

signs of cooling down.
The 0.5% monthly increase in food nd beverage prices was lower than the 1.8% monthly rise recorded in



August. Prices for sunflower oil slumped by 8.0% in a single month, with the average price of a 750ml
