PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING MINUTES:

ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING ASSESSMENT (ESA) FOR THE PROPOSED MINING CLAIMS (MCs) No. 68156 - 68166 NEAR KHORIXAS IN THE KUNENE REGION, NAMIBIA

The Public Consultation Meeting was attended by local farmers and community members, as well as two Environmental Consultants, and 1 Archaeologist from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd (EDS). - **Please refer to the attached attendance register.**

INTRODUCTION AND WELCOMING REMARKS

The meeting was officially opened by Ms. Iyaloo Nakale in English and translated by Mr. Tsabe to Damara/Nama. Ms. Iyaloo Nakale is an Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) from Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd, while Mr. Tsabe is a traditional leader and a member of the community. Ms. Nakale expressed gratitude to everyone in attendance for making time to attend the meeting.

The meeting attendance register was circulated for attendees to sign so that they could be added to the list of Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) and receive further information on the ESA process.

MEETING AGENDA AND PRESENTATION

The agenda of the meeting included the following main points:

2.1 Brief Description of the Project

Ms.Nakale provided a short description of the planned project and its associated activities, the Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) process, and the reason why the proponent appointed EDS, as an independent environmental consultant to carry out the EIA and Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC).

2.1 Presentation of Potential Project Impacts:

To ensure transparency and provide clarity to the attendees, the Environmental Consultants also presented the potential pre-identified positive, negative environmental, and social impacts.

2.2 Public Open Discussion (Interactive Session):

Ms. Nakale provided the meeting attendees the opportunity to raise their concerns or issues and or comment on the proposed project activities. The issues and comments are presented in **Table 1** below.

Mr.ML: The EPLs and MCs are granted by the Ministry of Mines and Energy according to the commodities a person or company is applying for. Therefore, they are granted in the area with the Geology of the commodities applied for.
4.	Commenter 3: There are small miners here that have obtained samples, can you assist us with the direction to the laboratory, where we can analyze our mineral samples?	Mr.SD: Our office is not in a position of such information for the moment, but if you contact The Ministry of Mines and Energy (MME) , they might help you with such information.
5.	Commenter 4: It is very important for the people at the grassroot level to know what is happening, the traditional authorities must know what activities are taking place and what minerals	Mr. ML: Noted.

We want development in the area.	Mr. ML: This all depends on the mineral deposit, if it is in large quantity the mine can grow bigger.
7.	Commenter 6: Are the neighboring farms and other affected land users going to be relocated due to disturbances, or will there be an form of compensations to this affected people?	Mr. ML: The affected land users and the proponents will have to reach an agreement, after the proponent is granted the ECC, on whether the farmers will be relocated or compensated.
8.	Commenter 1: Will there be a direct communication between the councilor's office and the proponent, based on the waste management and all mining activities?	Mr. ML: This will be the agreement between the proponent and councilor's office after an ECC is obtained.

As from previous experience, most skilled people are accommodated on site. Will they also be accommodated in Khorixas?</p>	<p>Mr. ML: This will depend on their working schedule. If they will be knocking off late, they had better not drive long distances at night, but rather just stay in campsites.</p>
10.	<p>Commenter 8: There are black Rhinos relocated in the area where these activities might take place. Therefore, maximum care must be taken in regards to these animals.</p>	<p>Mr. ML: Noted and thank you for alerting us.</p>

Mr. Leonard thanked the attendees for their crucial input through comments and for raising their concerns. He indicated to the attendees that all their comments, concerns and inputs had been noted down for consideration and addressing in the Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) Report as well as incorporating their recommendations into the draft EMP.

Furthermore, Mr. Mandume informed the attendees that the draft meeting minutes, Environmental Assessment Report t, and Environmental Management Plan (EMP) will be shared with them for review and further comments. These documents will be made available through emails provided on the attendance register.

Once the review of the documents is complete, they will be finalized and submitted to the Environmental Commissioner at the Department of Environmental Affairs and Forestry (DEAF) for evaluation and consideration of an ECC.

The meeting was adjourned at 15h00.
