We have pleasure to inform you that approval has been granted for the lease of a portion of various erven, recommended as follows:

That for the purpose to construct telecommunication towers and equipment rooms, the (a) lease of 100m2 portions of land, at the following erven, to Demshi Investment Holdings (Pty) Ltd, for a period of one year only, be approved;

- That a rental of N\$ 3 015.00 (N\$ 30.15 m²) plus N\$ 452.25 (15% VAT) per site per (b) month, be charged.
- That, prior to the signing of lease agreements in this regard, the Applicant obtain an (c) Environmental Clearance Certificate in terms of section 56 of the Environmental

- Management Act (Act 7 of 2007), from the Ministry of Environment and Tourism, Directorate: Environmental Affairs.
- (d) That a refundable, non-interest bearing deposit, equal to the monthly rental, be paid by the Applicant on date of signing the lease agreement, to cover the last month rent if not paid or to cover possible rehabilitation cost.
- (e) That the Applicant advertises the lease, by private transaction, for objections in terms of the provisions of section 63(2)(b) of the Local Authorities Act, 1992 (Act 23 of 1992), within 14 days after having received the letter of approval.
- (f) That the Applicant complies at all times with the National safety Regulations as well as to all relevant requirements of Council's Standard Building, Health, Fire and any other Municipal Regulations.
- (g) That the Applicant guarantees and indemnifies the Municipality of Walvis Bay against any action, claim or loss, injury or damage which the applicant or any third party may suffer as a direct or indirect result of storage facility covered by the Lease Agreement.
- (h) That the Applicant, in conjunction with the Department of Roads & Building Control, have the required 100 m² portions of land at the various sites as per recommendation (a) above, surveyed at the applicants' costs and submit the surveyed map to Council.
- (i) That the design of the structure of the telecommunication towers and equipment rooms be subject to the final approval and conditions of the Aesthetics Committee.
- (j) That, after the lease has been advertised, the applicant be granted three (3) months' time as from date of letter of notice, to enter into a Lease Agreements with the Municipality of Walvis Bay and to accept conditions for the payment of monthly rental.
- (k) That the applicant, at its own cost, provides all services and adheres to the guidelines/standard requirements for all services, i.e. water connection, water/sewerage/electricity reticulation.
- (I) That electrical requirements/services and/or any other information in this regard be taken up with Erongo RED.
- (m) That the applicant shall, prior to the erection of any structures on the site, obtain the approval from the General Manager: Roads and Building Control.
- (n) That the applicant be informed that the business relationship and transaction can only be concluded and become effective once Section 21 of the Financial Intelligence Act, 2012 (Act No.13 of 2012) read with Section 26 of the said Act, is complied with, and that it is required from the applicant to provide such information at such time and in



such format as instructed by the Anti-Money Laundering Compliance Officer of the Municipality of Walvis Bay.

- (o) That conditional approval be granted for the lease of these sites on a long-term basis. Such approval be subject to the following conditions;
  - Formal application be submitted to Council for the lease of the sites for specific long-term lease periods, during the one-year lease period.
  - The advertisement of such long term lease periods for objections.
  - The application be submitted to the Ministry of Urban and Rural Development for approval.

Seeing that the land is to be leased by private transaction, section 63(2)(b) of the Local Authorities Act, 1992 (Act 23/1992), requires that a notice be published in at least two newspapers circulating in Walvis Bay on one occasion in a week for two consecutive weeks.

[For example publication in newspapers A and B on Friday 02 September 2022 and again on Friday 9 September 2022.]

Full particulars pertaining to the lease will lie for inspection at our offices for a period of not less than seven (7) days (Saturdays and Sundays excluded) after the last date of the second publication.

#### [For example until Tuesday 20 September 2022.]

Interested persons are called upon to lodge any objections to such lease with the Municipality in writing within a period of not less than ten (10) days after the last date of the second publication.

### [For example before or at 12:00 Friday 23 September 2022.]

An example of the notice to be published is attached for your convenience. You must arrange the notices and copies of the publications thereof must be furnished to this office. It is of the utmost importance that you bring to the attention of the relevant newspapers to send their accounts to you for settlement and not to the Municipality of Walvis Bay.

If there are no objections and all other conditions have been met, we will forward to you the Lease Agreement.

You are requested to acknowledge receipt and accept the conditions of this letter within fourteen (14) days from date of this letter and to advertise within 14 days from date of this letter.

The Authority has reviewed your submission dated 27 September 2022 together with the supporting documentation received on 19 October 2022 on the above subject matter. The Authority fully understood that Demshi Investment Holdings is only responsible for installation of the telecommunication tower for leasing to other mobile operators.

We have noted that the telecommunication towers will be installed in the Public parks / Open Spaces located in densely populated residential areas in Walvis Bay, whereby your submission indicates that parks have been inactive. Your submission, further, indicates that a public meeting was conducted on the 26<sup>th</sup> September 2022 with the residents to inform them of the intended development in the area. The submission is however silent on the views of the residents on the proposed development and there is no proof of evidence that the public consultation had taken place.

In principle, the Authority does not have any objection in granting Demshi Investment Holdings a letter of consent. Should, however, the radiation measurement results at the commissioning of

sites and / or during regulatory inspection exceeds the recommended limits at any locality with potential for public exposure, the authority will not be held accountable for any eventualities.

Please, consider this communication as a formal consent of this Authority on the above-cited subject matter. You are therefore required to update this office regularly on any development that might have impacts on radiation exposure.

## Persons who will potentially be exposed to the presence of non-ionised radiation source:

As indicated in our submission, Demshi Investment Holdings is an independent network infrastructure. Demshi Investment Holdings is only responsible for installation and operation of the telecommunication tower. The telecommunication tower does not emit any radiation and neither is any equipment used which causes ration during the installation of the telecommunication tower.

Demshi Investment Holdings will provide co-location on the tower to other operators e.g Telecom Namibia, Paratus etc to mount their network antennas on the telecommunication tower. The network antennas have the potential to cause radiation. Therefore, before any network antenna is mounted on the telecommunication by an operator, Demshi Investment Holdings will request that the operator obtain a license from the Radiation Authority in re the specific network antennas that the operator wishes to mount on the tower. The operator will furthermore be responsible for taking annual radiation measurement to be submitted to the Radiation Authority.



As the owners of the telecommunications towers we equally bear a responsibility to ensure that harmful radiation is not emitted from the telecommunication towers. In the light, we will also take annual radiation measurement that we will submit to the Radiation Authority for verification at each individual site.

The telecommunication towers will be installed in Public Open Spaces located in densely populated residential areas in Walvis Bay. Demshi Investment Holding has conducted a public meeting on the 26<sup>th</sup> September with residents of the identified areas to inform them of the intended development to install telecommunication towers. The Public Open Space where the telecommunication towers will be constructed are designated as parks. Majority of them are regarded as "Dead" parks as they have been abandoned and do not receive any visitors. Therefore, while the towers are in residential areas they are being installed in public parks which are located a few meters aways from the nearest houses.

Residents will only be potentially exposed to non-ionised radiation source once the mobile operators and internet service providers starts installing their network antennas on the telecommunication towers and during installation of the telecommunication towers.

We sincerely hope the above provides the requested information and we look forward to receiving the consent for the installation of the telecommunication towers. Once the telecommunication towers are installed, we will inform the Radiation Authority before any network antennas are placed on the towers by third party mobile operators and internet service provider.
