



Proposed demonstration site: Wini Demonstration plot

The proposed demo plot was assessed by the MAWF and the project staff on the 23 March 2020. The finding indicates that that the sites is suitable for demonstration purposes. The TA provided your letter of endorsement and proposed the site to be to utilize the site for agriculture production and demonstration of technology for their community. The proposed demo plot has 15 direct beneficiaries that will be linked to the proposed demonstration sites. The site is one of the three (3) demonstration sites established in Kavango West. The regional steering committee endorsed the site during the RSC Meeting of 04 February 2020.

Site description:

The Wini site is located in Kakua Village, under Mpungu constituency in Kavango West Region. It is governed under the Ukwangali Traditional authority. The Area is about 35Km Southwest of Nkurenkuru Town from the B1 road from Nkurenkuru to Mpungu.

The area is covered by Kalahari Woodland with a dominant of Camelthorn, *Philmoptera violacea* (Ghukororo tree), reeds and *Combretum collinam* trees. There are also small wildlife dominating the area such a birds, Squirrels, Rabbits and Hare.

Location:

The site has two Drilled Boreholes, the availability of water, is confirmed by the Directorate of Water Supply Sanitation and Coordination (DWSSC). The estimated area is 20 ha provided by the Traditional Authority.

Current Usage:

The area was previously used for agriculture production; however, it is currently not under any agriculture production, and it is bare.

Planned usage:

The demonstration sites will provide a platform to introduce new ideas and allow small scale horticulture and rain fed farmers to experience innovative practices that promote 3 CA principles which are minimum tillage, mulching and crop rotation firsthand while demonstrating how production can be effective at different climate hotspots.
