INTRODUCTION

Onaminda Investment cc has identified the dire need for continued mineral exploration and mining for economic development in Namibia. In this respect the proponent has taken on a venture to explore for **Base and Rare Metals, Industrial Minerals, Nuclear Fuel Minerals, Precious Metals, Precious Stones Groups of minerals and Dimension stones on EPLs 7986 in Arandis Constituency, Erongo Region**. This is set to promote resource extraction and economic development in the constituency. The proposed venture is also in line with the Fourth National Development Plan-Namibia, by creating employment and targeting value additions of local resources before export to other countries.

In this respect **Junior Baiano Industrial Consultants (JBIC) cc** has been appointed to carry out an Environmental Assessment study and to obtain an environmental clearance certificate as per the requirements of the Ministry of Environment and Tourism and Ministry of Mines and Energy. The study will incorporate biophysical, ecological and socio-economic baseline investigations relating to the proposed project.

In terms of the Namibian Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations of 2012, an Environmental Clearance Certificate is to be obtained for;

3.2 Other forms of mining or extraction of any natural resources whether regulated by law or not.

3.3 Resource extraction, manipulation, conservation and related activities.

AIMS & OBJECTIVES OF THIS EIA PROCESS

The aims of this EIA:

- To comply with Namibia's Environmental Assessment Policy, Environmental Management Act (No. 7 of 2007) with its 2012 EIA Regulations and the;
- Consult all interested and affected to ensure that their inputs are considered;
- To assess the significance of issues and concerns raised;
- Review the legal and policy framework and its relevance to this project;
- Describe general and socio-economic environment of the project to determine impacts and suitability to the project site.
- Identify and assess impacts related to the continued operations.
- Compile an Assessment Report and Management Plan (EMP) which includes recommendations and methods to minimize the identified negative environmental impacts of the proposed project.
- To identify existing environmental conditions and associated environmental sensitivities within and adjacent to the project area that may potentially be affected, i.e. Environmental sensitivity and monitoring procedures.

THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS

The Public Participation Process (PPP) is an integral part of the EIA process whereby it allows the public to obtain information about the proposed project, to view documentation, to provide input and voice any concerns concerning the project. The Public Participation Processes that will be undertaken will include consultation with the local authority, line ministries, government extension offices, owners of neighboring properties and other I&AP's living around the proposed area.

During the meeting participants will be availed an opportunity to comment, ask questions and raise any concerns be it environmental or social regarding the proposed Environmental Assessment on the area covered by EPL 7986 and exploration activities on the same EPL. Comments will be recorded and considered in the Environmental Assessment report that will be submitted to the Ministry of Environment for review.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Mineral exploration is a stage of investigating or examining about the geological condition of an area. The main aim at this stage is to find high quality minerals. During the exploration stage geological maps, published and unpublished geological data is used.

The desktop information is used to generate a geological model on which all the future exploration activities will be based.

It is vital to note that exploration work for the EPL 7986 is still to be commenced. Drilling and open pits will be used is also going to be one of the major activities done at this stage.

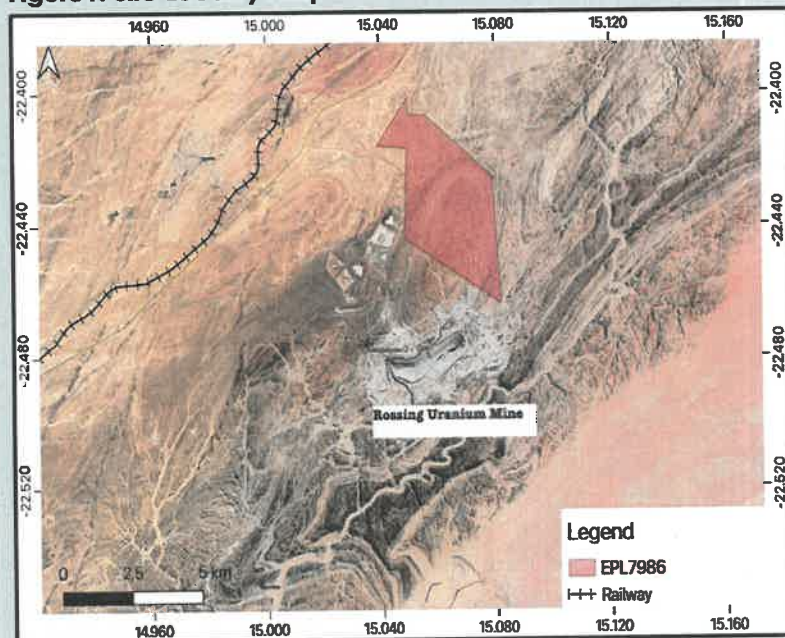
Existing access roads within the farms will be used during the exploration phase and an exploration camp will be established or alternatively make use of Rossing facilities upon agreement.

Rowe goal: 'Never seen anything like it' - but should it have stood?

Mikel Arteta said he had never seen a goal like it. Michael Carrick was glad he didn't have to address it for too long. So should Emile Smith Rowe's opener for Arsenal at Old Trafford have stood or not?

On a night of excitement, drama, controversy - and the landmark of Cristiano Ronaldo passing 800 career goals - Smith Rowe's finish in Arsenal's 3-2 defeat at Manchester United on Thursday remained a big talking point afterwards.

It was fired in with United goalkeeper David de Gea down injured after team-mate Fred had stood on his heel following a corner.

The video assistant referee would eventually award the goal, with widespread confusion in the ground giving way to Arsenal joy and Manchester United fury.

Before we hear what the managers, players and pundits think of it all, let's clear up exactly what happened.

How the incident played out...

With 13 minutes on the clock, Martin Odegaard swung in an Arsenal corner that Harry Maguire headed clear, but only as far as Mohamed Elneny, who steered the ball to Smith Rowe 20 yards out.

Around the time of the initial clearance, De Gea had his heel trodden on accidentally by Fred, causing him to go down on his goaline, where he stayed with his back to play. It meant he was unable to react when Smith Rowe's otherwise saveable shot was fired on target.

From the corner kick being taken to the shot finding the net, seven seconds elapsed, during which time referee Martin Atkinson did not blow his whistle to halt play.

Television pictures suggested Atkinson did not spot De Gea on the floor until the moment Smith Rowe struck the ball, as the official was facing away from goal in those moments to follow the ball.

Atkinson did blow his whistle shortly after the ball hit the net, wagging his finger to suggest he had ruled the goal out.

It would be another three minutes and 15 seconds before a definitive decision was made, with the goal awarded after advice from VAR.

Ultimately, since it was Fred who impeded De Gea, there was nothing in the laws to suggest the goal should

be ruled out.

"We could have been here all night"

"I've never seen anything like that," said Arsenal boss Arteta to Amazon Prime afterwards. "But that is the decision from the referee and VAR checked it and it was a goal."

His United counterpart Michael Carrick announced his departure from Old Trafford immediately after the match and that, coupled with the fact United won, meant he did not spend much time discussing the incident.

"At least I don't have to talk about it too much now - we could have been here all night," said the 40-year-old, who will be replaced in the dugout by the incoming interim manager Ralf Rangnick.

United midfielder Bruno Fernandes added: "Normally when the keeper goes down, we should stop the game but mistakes happen. Players make mistakes."

"I don't know if it is a mistake from the referee. If it is, that can happen."

"I've never seen anything as extraordinary as that"

Former England goalkeeper Rob Green experienced something similar to De Gea when playing for his country's B side against Belarus, who scored when he was down injured in 2006.

As part of his co-commentary duty at Old Trafford for BBC Radio 5 Live on Thursday, he also evoked a similar incident involving Paulo di Canio in the game between West Ham and Everton in 2000. In that instance the Hammers forward could clearly see opposing goalkeeper Paul Gerrard was down before opting to catch the ball and halt the game.

"I don't think Smith Rowe knew," said Green. "The guy who scored past me for Belarus was laughing as he put it in. Smith Rowe wasn't, that's for sure."

"It is the kind of thing that can happen from time to time. Di Canio caught the ball very sportingly but nobody really had the opportunity to do that this time. The ball was in the air, everyone was looking at it and Martin Atkinson was trying to get out of the way."

"Everyone else in the stadium could see De Gea was on the floor, with his back to the game and he had his ankle stamped on by his own team-mate. It

is unfortunate.

"As an ex-goalkeeper, I am sitting here thinking 'bit of common sense, guys, you can't save the ball if you're down injured with your back to the game'."

"I understand the clinical nature of refereeing and the argument that says there is nothing to stop it being a goal. But in the cold light of day, you look at it and think 'what is the sporting decision?' I think it shouldn't have been allowed."

If Green was speaking for the goalkeeper's union, former England captain Alan Shearer was on hand on Amazon Prime Video to offer a striker's take.

"My immediate thought was goal," he said. "I didn't hear the referee blow and I didn't see a foul on the keeper. I think that happens in every game. The keeper goes down without a care to where the ball is and I don't think he should be going down like that."

"If it had been a serious injury then there's an argument that maybe Arsenal should have let United score - but a minute later, De Gea's walking around and not limping."

Former Premier League referee Mark Clattenburg was alongside Shearer to offer the view from an official's point of view.

"I've never seen anything quite as extraordinary as this," he said. "Martin Atkinson was powerless. His feeling would have been that there was a foul but you can't blow your whistle until the ball goes in the goal."

"There would have been more controversy if he blew the whistle first. If Jadon Sancho had won the ball [and cleared], I'm sure he'd have stopped play then."

"He didn't see De Gea down. Martin isn't looking at the keeper and it's only when Smith Rowe is striking the ball that he looks and thinks 'why is De Gea down?' Then he will have thought there was a foul."

The controversy at Old Trafford also evokes memories of an incident that happened at Elland Road in 2019 when Leeds carried on playing and scored through Mateusz Klich against Aston Villa, who had a man down injured throughout.

On that occasion, Leeds boss Marcelo Bielsa decided his side should allow Villa to score an uncontested equaliser - a gesture that earned him a Fifa Fair Play award.

Chelsea-United tie headlines Premier League action

The 12-point gap between Premier League leaders Chelsea and Manchester United after just 12 games finally cost Ole Gunnar Solskjaer his job as the Red Devils manager, but the Blues provide the inspiration for what United could still achieve this season.

Less than a year ago, Chelsea also sacked a former legendary player turned manager when Frank Lampard was dismissed from Stamford Bridge.

Four months later, the same squad were crowned champions of Europe thanks to a rapid transformation by Thomas Tuchel.

That progress has continued on this season as Chelsea look to break the grip Manchester City and Liverpool have had on the title race for the past four seasons.

Tuchel's men hold a three-point lead over City at the top of the table with Liverpool one further back.

Despite still missing the presence of record signing Romelu Lukaku through injury, Chelsea have hit top form since returning from the November international break.

Leicester were swept aside 3-0 at the King Power last weekend before Juventus suffered their biggest ever Champions League defeat in a 4-0 drubbing on Tuesday.

"It's a pleasure to be at the club every single day and to be a part of this team," said Tuchel after his 50th match in charge in midweek.

"They have a fantastic attitude,

determined and hungry, so we want to keep this energy and atmosphere in the group.

"The challenges are coming and it's good because it keeps us going."

One of Tuchel's biggest coaching influences could soon be lining up against him in the Premier League with United reportedly set to hire Ralf Rangnick as the club's interim manager until the end of the season.

Any deal is not expected to be completed before the sides meet at Stamford Bridge on Sunday with Michael Carrick to take caretaker charge, as he did for a 2-0 win over Villarreal on Tuesday that secured United's place in the last 16 of the Champions League.

"All my energy and my mind at the moment is on Sunday," said Carrick.

"Everything else is not for me to worry about and get involved with because I need to win a game of football and that is what I am looking forward to doing."

HOWE HOPING TO LEAD NEWCASTLE

Newcastle sank to the bottom of the table last weekend after a 3-3 draw with Brentford in their first match since Eddie Howe was appointed as manager.

Howe had to watch the game from a hotel room in isolation after testing positive for coronavirus.

The former Bournemouth boss is hoping to lead his new side for the first time at Arsenal on Saturday as long as he returns a negative test.

Sold to the Saudi sovereign

wealth fund in October, Newcastle's new wealth has counted for little so far as they remain without a win all season.

The Magpies are fortunate to just be five points adrift of safety, but can't rely on waiting for the January transfer window to solve their problems with eight league games to come before the new year.

PATIENCE WITH BENITEZ WEARING THIN

Everton are the only side in the league in worse form than Newcastle as the Toffees have taken just two points from their last six games.

Many in the Everton support were opposed to the appointment of Rafael Benitez as manager before a ball was kicked this season due to his close connections with rivals Liverpool.

A promising start quietened Benitez's critics, but they are quickly resurfacing.

Benitez badly needs a win away at Brentford to avoid a frosty reception when Liverpool come to Goodison for the Merseyside derby on Wednesday.

PART 1 - GENERAL

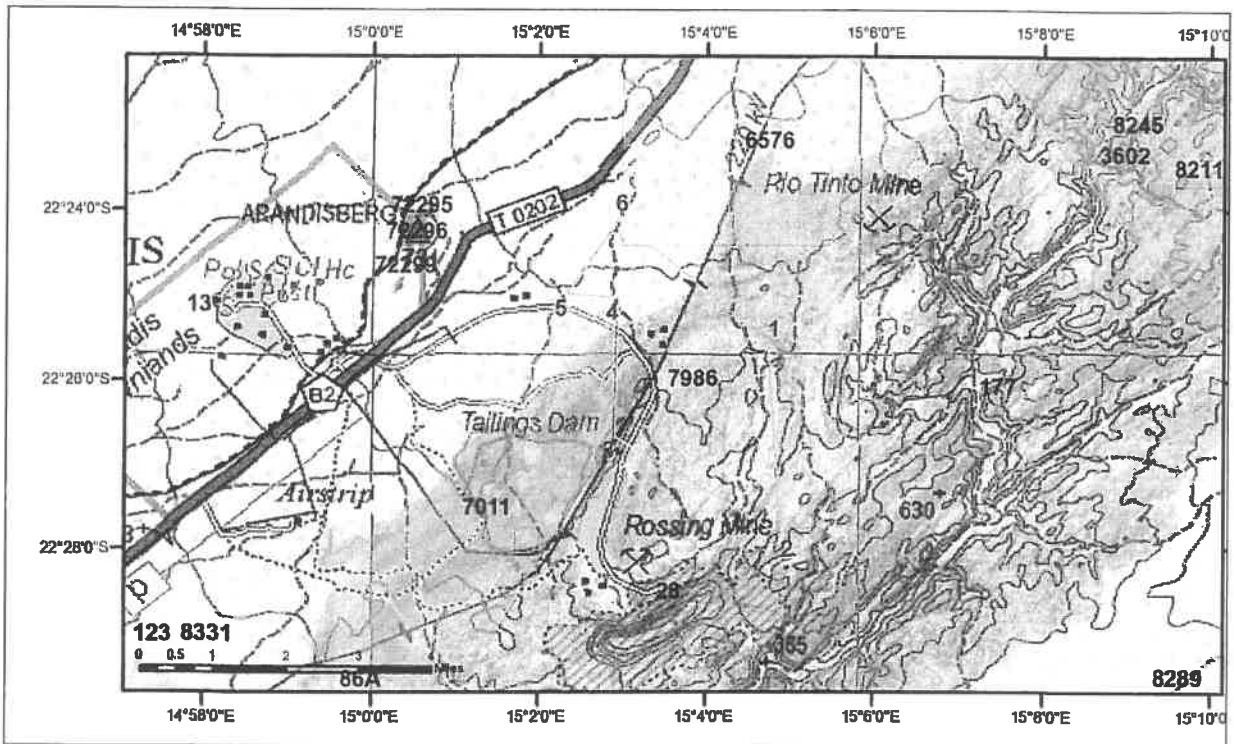

The exclusive prospecting licence shall endure for a period of **three (3) years** reckoned from the date of issue of the Environmental Clearance Certificate unless it is abandoned in terms of Section 54 of the Minerals (Prospecting and Mining) Act, 1992, (hereinafter "the Act") or cancelled in terms of Section 55 of the Act or on application made to the Minister in terms of section 72 of the Act, it is renewed by the Minister for any further period or periods.
2. 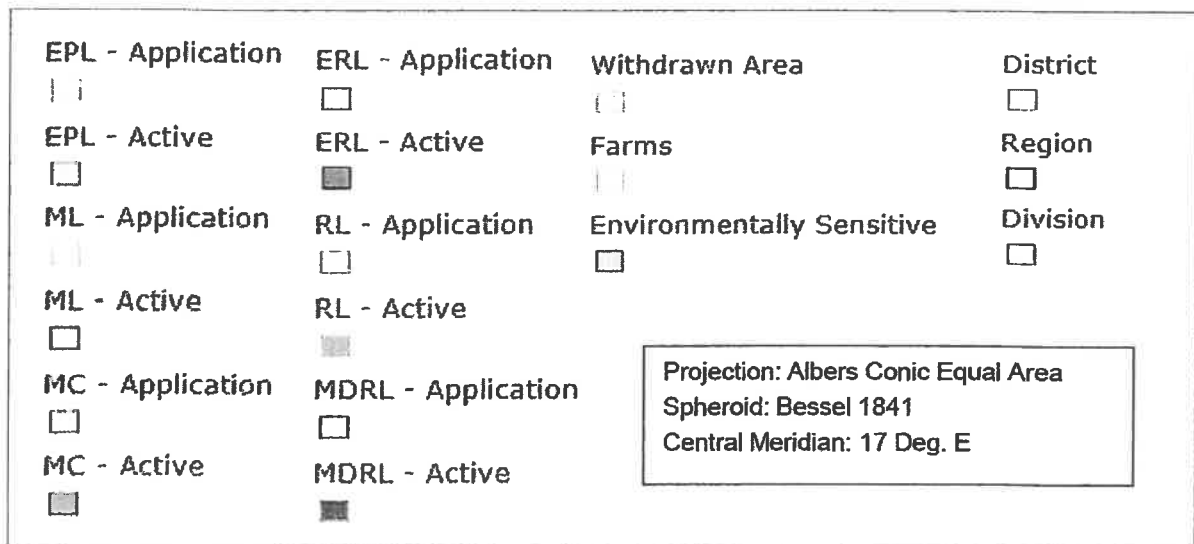

 - 6.2 where any material deviation of such work programme, schedule and budget is in the opinion of the holder of the licence, necessitated by the nature of the results of prospecting operations (but specifically excluding any circumstances of Vis Major provided for in terms of Section 56 of the Act), apply in writing to the Minister for approval of the revision of such work programme, schedule and budget in terms of Section 75 of the Act; and
 - 6.3 execute such additional work programme and expend such additional expenditure within a specified period of time as may be imposed by the Minister from time to time.
 - 6.4 ensure that, all funds raised anywhere and exclusively in respect of this licence shall be expended on the licence and all/any activities relating thereto and, to the
