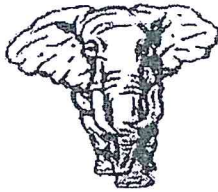

2. Registration of Participants

The people who attended the Consultation meeting came from the various organizations, project area surrounding residents, traditional authority and headmen from Liselo communal area

3. Introduction of Participants

The Consultant chaired and the facilitator was Mrs Mulyeho Iren, a community member from Liselo area (was nominated by the general public at the meeting to facilitate the meeting). Participants to the Public Consultation of the Scoping Phase introduced themselves indicating the organization that they were representing. Most of the participants indicated that they were aware of the proposed dry truck port development but were not familiar with the project site. They stated that it was a new developmental initiative and were of the view that the project was welcome as it will and would bring more socio-economic development to the people of Liselo and zambezi region.

Support to the community

The business investor for Trans-Zambezi truckport & Investment cc representatives were present at the meeting to speak and respond to comments and questions raised by the community members and other stakeholders. The proponent informed the audience or stakeholders that attended the meeting of the socio-economic benefits the project is giving and/or providing to the community and the region at large. He gave examples of employment creation, road and traffic congestion solution, infrastructure development, effective and efficient food or product distribution health products, training and financial contributions as some of the benefits that communities will benefit to the development.

Project Location & Land use

The proponent of Trans Zambezi Truckport & Investment cc (Mr Bernard Mutelo) further informed the public of the locality of the project, where he explained that the project is situated on the outskirts or periphery of the town of Katima Mulilo in the Liselo communal land on a 9.8 hectares. He informed the public that the land was not used for anything as it was earmarked for truckport development and was partly cleared to pave way for truckport project. He explained that the land was allocated to this development by the Liselo Sub-khuta as the custodians of the land. He informed the public that the Liselo sub-khuta gave consent for the use of this land for the proposed development

and the proponent was then taken to the Mafwe traditional authority where they were issued with a consent letter signed by the Chief.

Questions and views from members of the Kasheshe Community & line ministries

Mr Bollen Muhemba – informed the public that attended the meeting that, the initiative of a truckport development was an important and important initiative as there was high demand of intranit trucks and truckers from the rest of the Country Namibia travelling via Katima to Zambia, Botswana and Congo through the trans-caprivi winella boarder situated some 15kilometers from the project area. He thanked and welcomed the proposed development to continue as it will uplift the livelihood of people in the zambezi region

Mr Andreas Fillupus – contributed to the meeting by informing the public that, the dry truck port at Liselo will have no negative effect to the people or the environment of Liselo, as it will only have contributed positively to the economic upliftment of the area and the Zambezi region i.e. through employment creation, infrastructure development. He explained that the land use for the proposed development was good because it will not affect the people and the environment. He added saying that the proposed development was important for the as it would relieve traffic congestion of heavy weight trucks transporting cargo to Zambia, Botswana and Zimbabwe through the trans-caprivi highway.

Mr Obrien Sinkolela – (secretary for Liselo sub-khuta - explained and thanked the public for attending an important meeting which concerned the development of Liselo area under Liselo sub-khuta jurisdiction. He confirmed that the business owner Mr Bernard Mutelo followed the right procedure when they were allocated the land to conduct this project. He explained that proponent approached the Liselo sub-khuta and a recommendation was awarded to him and later taken to Mafwe traditional authority where they were issued with a consent letter to do business at the site. He further expected that the business should only employ local residents of Liselo area which is of

importance as it contributed to poverty reduction, hence the reason why the Liselo sub-khuta accepted this business proposal in the area.

Mr D Lupalezwi (Ministry of Trade & Industry) –was glad to be part of the meeting proceedings but encouraged or called on the business investors to start with the development as soon as their papers were in order. He was however concerned with the impact of noise pollution that might come with the proposed truckport and emphasized that local communities around the project area be informed and be made aware of the project to get their buyin to accept the project to avoid future land dispute. He stated that a lot of people were allocated land to do business in the Liselo area but only few of these people had started with their business projects, hence cautioned that Trans Zambezi Investment cc should develop and set an example to others.

Mrs Benitha Kwala- Ministry of Land Reform, explained and explained to the members at the meeting that the project area as per the records of the Ministry of Land Reform was not overlapping with any other land uses and she also stated that there was no community forest or designated special land use mark in the area, hence the ministry of land reform will not have Any objections to the proposed land use as the project did not possess any danger or cause any adverse impact to the surrounding areas.

COMMENTS FROM HEAD LISELO AREA HEADMEN OF LISELO SUB-KHUTA AUTHORITY: MR JOY Kingsley

The HEAD of all headmen of Liselo area who was present at the meeting explained that the mafwe traditional authority was in full support of the project as the traditional authority had consented to the commencement of the project. He further stated that the project will support both the Liselo sub-khuta & the Mafwe traditional authority annual through financial assistance and social assistance, as well as the community contributions. He was also happy to know that there were no land disputes over the area that was allocated to the project.

Based on the above, there were no negative impact raised, and no objections or questions that were asked from the public during the meeting and there were no environmental, social, economic, biodiversity and political problems raised by the public over the proposed light industrial development. However a few changes were identified which relate to: Socio economic, Noise, Traffic, Visual, Air quality, Archaeology, Groundwater, Wastewater and waste material.
