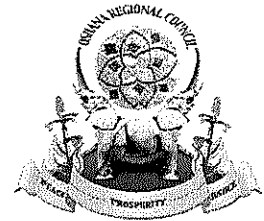

3.	Introduction	Attendants introduced themselves by Name, Village and Capacity at stakeholder's level.	
4.	Background of the <i>Access Road</i>	<p>Briefing of the Community in attendance of the meeting on the historical background of the <i>Access Road</i> based on the following issues:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Flooding of the community access points to & from essential services during rainy season. b) Severally, the community continually suffered due to flooding at the cross points, in 2011, some community members were even air lifted by the helicopter to be able to access necessities such as hospitals, etc. c) In the mid-70s during the colonial regime, there has been an idea to construct Okatana-Omungwelume Road. d) After independence, the Okatana-Omulathitu-Omungwelume road was spear headed by the former Governor Klemens Kashuupulwa and Community members. e) The access road was put on priority list during the reign of the former Governor Klemens Kashuupulwa and Chief Regional Officer (CRO) Mr. J. Kandombo f) Although Okatana - Amutanga access road was on priority list, according to hearsay, the road was no longer on the priority list because it was replaced by Ongwediva via Okatana- Ompumbu road. This led us to follow up with the CRO's office. The previous CRO, Mr. Martin Elago advised us to write an official community letter signed by all affected stakeholders (Villages, Schools, Churches and Businesses). However due to the limited time before submission, this message was not widely communicated. Hence, the reluctance to sign by some stakeholders. The letter was submitted only with the available signature (one person) at the said time. g) The efforts to follow up on this matter were made to the Oshana Governor, Oshana Regional Planning Directorate, RCC Ongwediva and RCC Windhoek. The RCC official visited the affected areas by the Cuvelai Basin, and he offered 12 culverts to create temporal access bridges. However, these culverts were not delivered at the right sites. She advised the community to come up with a similar letter signed by affected stakeholders.</p> <p>i) Lastly, the Councillor of Okatana constituency availed the Access Road Map from the map of all proclaimed roads.</p>

Open discussion	<p>The Councillor (Mr. Ilishuwa) was afforded with the floor to air his views on the matter pertaining to the proposed access road.</p> <p>Firstly, he presented the previously proposed road reference number (DR3647) as appearing on the Access Road Map from the Master plan.</p> <p>Notwithstanding the above, the Councillor was not able to trace nor retrieve the Council resolution that pertained to the proposed access road.</p> <p>In light of the above, the Councillor proposed that the letter be addressed to the relevant authorities beyond regional level.</p> <p>In addition to the above, the meeting attendees proposed and agreed that the road must be accessible at Amutanga, likelo, Omulathitu and Onanime villages.</p> <p>Moreover, it was agreed that all future correspondences be addressed to the Chief Regional Officer.</p> <p>Lastly, it has been decided that the follow up letter regarding the access road be addressed directly to the Minister of Works and Transport, Honourable John Mutorwa.</p>	All attendees

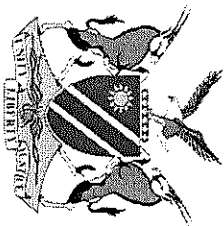

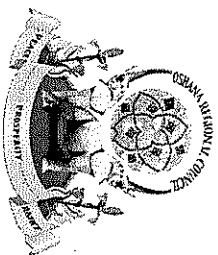
