Firstly, I would like to thank you all for showing interest in this study. We have received all your comments and concerns.

This email serves to give feedback to comments and concerns raised by interested and affected parties regarding the proposed construction and operations of an abattoir for a piggery on Farm Oribib 33A by Chakula Foods CC at Otjikondo, Kunene region. The answers to your comments and concerns are as follow:

#### **Disposal of wastewater and solid waste**

The abattoir will have a large bio-digester to treat effluent. The treated effluent will be channelled into the irrigation system.

The piggery will be free range and fenced off. The pigs are not going to be kept in confinement where manure needs to be managed. There will be no solid waste from pigs as it will naturally be produced in pasture. The farrowing pigs will be kept in enclosures to prevent predation for the first two weeks and these small enclosures will be designed to capture waste and recycle as fertilizer. Solid waste from the abattoir is a valuable input in organic farming operation, hence it will be heat treated to remove pathogens and then used as compost on crops.

#### **Swine flu**

Swine flu is an operation hazard in any pig operation. The farm is isolated and insular. The breeding operation will involve self breeding parent stock through artificial insemination and then naturally breeding terminal stock from the in-farm genetic pool. Firstly, I would like to thank you all for showing interest in this study. We have received all your comments and concerns.

This email serves to give feedback to comments and concerns raised by interested and affected parties regarding the proposed construction and operations of an abattoir for a piggery on Farm Oribib 33A by Chakula Foods CC at Otjikondo, Kunene region. The answers to your comments and concerns are as follow:

### **Disposal of wastewater and solid waste**

The abattoir will have a large bio-digester to treat effluent. The treated effluent will be channelled into the irrigation system.

The piggery will be free range and fenced off. The pigs are not going to be kept in confinement where manure needs to be managed. There will be no solid waste from pigs as it will naturally be produced in pasture. The farrowing pigs will be kept in enclosures to prevent predation for the first

two weeks and these small enclosures will be designed to capture waste and recycle as fertilizer. Solid waste from the abattoir is a valuable input in organic farming operation, hence it will be heat treated to remove pathogens and then used as compost on crops.

### **Swine flu**

Swine flu is an operation hazard in any pig operation. The farm is isolated and insular. The breeding operation will involve self breeding parent stock through artificial insemination and then naturally breeding terminal stock from the in-farm genetic pool. No external animals will be brought in, except at the onset of the operation.

### **Groundwater**

The proponent will comply with the Namibian water regulations and all required permits and right will be acquired from relevant authorities. This development will be Global gap and organic certified, meaning it will have European Union external inspection and audits on water use sustainability. This will ensure and promote sustainable farming practices.

As an integral part of the environmental assessment an Environmental Management plan (EMP) has been developed with mitigation measures to manage all potential project impacts.

According to the Environmental Management Act (no.7 of 2007) and its Regulations (2012), registered, and affected parties should be granted an opportunity to comment in writing on the draft reports (Scoping Assessment report and Environmental Management Plan) before submission to the Environmental commissioner.
