Similarly, potential thieves are equally warned that stealing copper wire from the national telecommunication network is an illegal exercise and can land perpetrators in jail.

Dr Stanley Shanapinda, Telecom Namibia's Chief Executive Officer, has noted that thieves are stealing not only copper cables but also batteries and solar panels and, in the process, damaging fences and locks and in some instances even engaging in destruction of facilities at base stations. “Telecom has reported high number of incidents of criminals targeting Telecom Namibia's infrastructure. This clearly shows that criminals are causing serious damage to the Telecom Namibia networks through copper theft and sheer vandalism, resulting in downtime for customers and costing the

company millions. This directly affects our quality of service and customer experience in the affected areas”, Shanapinda expressed.

The CEO further stated that this theft hits customers hard, as network damage results in service unavailability, impacts on emergency services as well as on businesses using the affected networks. He therefore urges communities to be vigilant as the ramifications of theft and/or vandalism are felt by all of us. “We urge communities to be vigilant and report any suspicious activities or malpractices around the Telecom Namibia infrastructure to the nearest Police Station.”

With hundreds of kilometers of cable running underground and on poles to provide telecommunication service in Namibia, it is impracticable and impossible for Telecom Namibia to provide security to protect them. We therefore call on all Namibians to exercise patriotism and be a watchdog to safeguard our national telecommunications backbone in their best interest of retaining reliable and efficient communication in the country, especially during a time when voice and internet connectivity is an essential service, due to pandemic and other critical communication needs.

## Alleged suicide couple identified

**The Swakopmund couple that was found dead in their house in Goshawk Street in Vogelstrand, Swakopmund last Sunday, has been identified as Dean and Luella Olley.**

It is suspected that the couple, originally from South Africa and Britain was operating a company called Afroses & Trinidad (Pty) Ltd by the time they committed suicide.

According to a reliable source, Luella Olley allegedly informed a co-worker on Saturday that if she does not show up at work, the co-worker should come to her house. On arrival at the house on Sunday, a note with the words, “Do not come to our bedroom. Call the paramedics” was discovered stuck to the floor. According to this reliable source, the couple most likely planned taking their own lives as Mr. Olley was allegedly suffering from an incurable blood disorder and that his wife Luella Olley was not prepared to live without her husband.

It was also mentioned that a financial predicament, exacerbated by the Covid-19 pandemic and a pending civil lawsuit in the Gauteng High Court against them and their company, was apparently also a reason why Mr. Dean Olley, 73, and his wife, Luella, 63, spent a lot of time planning their last hours of life on Saturday. The Namibian Police Institute for Forensic Science confiscated all of the couple's documents and computers to be analysed as part of the investigation. The couple's remains were taken to Windhoek for the post-mortem examinations.

The police do not suspect foul play, and the investigating is ongoing. The public will be informed on what may have led to the suicides. The Olley couple leaves behind a son who lives in the Cayman Islands. The couple's cat and dog were also found dead at the scene.

## Lichtenstrasser denied bail

**The alleged NIMT-shooter, 60-year-old Ernst Lichtenstrasser's third attempt to be released on bail was dismissed in the Windhoek High Court on Wednesday, 2 February. Lichtenstrasser has been in custody since his accusation of the shooting of NIMT Director, Eckhart Mueller and his Deputy, Heimo Hellwig at the NIMT offices at Arandis on three years ago, and it seems like the odds are not in his favour.**

Lichtenstrasser's trial started in the Windhoek High Court in February last year after being transferred from the Swakopmund Magistrate Court, and his formal bail application hearing started on 21 January this year in the Windhoek High Court. During his formal bail application hearing, the Deputy Prosecutor General, Antonio Verhoef, who is representing the state, informed the accused that the state has a strong case against the accused that may point to the possibility of him (Lichtenstrasser) being convicted. This increases the risk of him absconding if released on bail.

Lichtenstrasser is accused of having gunned down in cold blood NIMT Director, Eckhart Mueller (72), and his Deputy, Heimo Hellwig (60), at the NIMT offices at Arandis early on the morning of 15 April 2019. That morning, Mueller and Hellwig arrived at the Arandis campus of NIMT early, little did they know when they emerged from their vehicle, they had



only seconds to live. The shooter appeared as Mueller and Hellwig took their last steps towards the front door of the Campus' administration block.

A total of eight shots was fired from a 9mm handgun. Mueller and Hellwig died in pools of blood with fatal gunshots delivered to both victims' lower abdomen and to the head. Lichtenstrasser denied guilt on all charges levelled against him. The trial is scheduled to continue from 14- 18 March this year.
